



KEY ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES

THE ALL-NEW TRAILBLAZER WAS DESIGNED WITH RECYCLABILITY IN MIND. SOME OF THE MOST IMPORTANT EXAMPLES INCLUDE:

- THE ELIMINATION OF MERCURY FROM UNDERHOOD SWITCHES.
- PLASTIC PARTS THAT ARE MARKED SPECIFICALLY FOR RECYCLING TO MAKE REMOVAL AND RECOVERY OF THOSE PARTS EASIER.
- HYDROFORMING THE FRAME SIDE RAILS RESULTING IN A MORE EFFICIENT USE OF STEEL, REDUCING SCRAP STEEL BY 2,000 TONS ANNUALLY.
- A STANDARD LOW EMISSIONS VORTEC 4200 SIX-CYLINDER ENGINE.

STEEL HOOD

The hood is made from bake-hardened steel, which is stronger, more dent-resistant and lighter in weight than conventional steel.

RAINSENSE WINDSHIELD WIPERS

When engaged, this segment-exclusive feature,* standard on LTZ models, detects the amount of moisture coming in contact with the windshield. It then automatically adjusts wiper speed based on one of five intermittent settings.

ASYMMETRICAL DURABLE WINDSHIELD

The windshield of the all-new TrailBlazer is made with exterior glass that's thicker than the inner pane of glass. This helps improve the windshield's resistance to cracks from small stones.

FOUR-SPEED AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION

Every TrailBlazer comes with a four-speed electronically controlled transmission that provides precise shifting and smooth performance across a full torque curve.

POWER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

To help prevent the possibility of battery drain, a Power Management System is standard in every TrailBlazer. Battery-rundown protection is included in this system to eliminate battery drain if the interior lights, headlamps (or both) are left on inadvertently.

NEXT-GENERATION TRUCK BODY CONTROLLER

This onboard computer module governs systems, such as battery-rundown protection and PASSlock, with speed and precision to help reduce the potential of electrical problems.

AUTOTRAC 4x4 SYSTEM

With the selector in AUTO 4WD, Autotrac automatically transfers power between front and rear wheels whenever rear-wheel slippage is detected. It's standard on all TrailBlazer 4x4 models.

FOUR-WHEEL ABS DISC BRAKES

The discs at all four wheels are ventilated to help achieve good heat dissipation. Weight-saving aluminum brake calipers and non-asbestos organic brake linings are also used.

FULL-LENGTH HYDROFORMED STEEL FRAME SIDE RAILS

The TrailBlazer chassis uses full-length hydroformed steel frame side rails — a first in the midsize SUV segment.* Hydroforming the frame side rails reduces the stretching of steel during the manufacturing process, which allows the steel to retain more of its strength.

NEW SUSPENSION DESIGN

A front suspension that incorporates a coil-over-shock modular design with upper and lower control arms contributes to the overall ride quality of TrailBlazer. The front suspension design is complemented by a new five-link rear suspension designed to enhance load-carrying capability.

TRACTION ASSIST

Traction Assist is available on Chevy TrailBlazer LT and LTZ 2WD models. This feature helps provide controlled acceleration and enhanced vehicle traction on most slippery surfaces.

LATCHES AND HINGES

Special attention was paid to achieving smooth, quiet operation of all side doors and liftgate hinges. This was accomplished through the use of Teflon®-coated hinge bushings. Acoustic designed seals for all door and liftgate openings help reduce noise.

CORROSION PROTECTION

Two-sided galvanized steel is used for all exterior body panels (except the roof, where it is not needed) to help protect against corrosion. And the entire steel body is electrically charged during the painting process to help corrosion-fighting materials reach critical areas.

TIRE JACK AND TOOL STORAGE

The tire jack and tools are stored underneath the rear seat. They can be accessed from the rear side doors without having to remove cargo. And the spare tire release control is located behind the liftgate for an extra measure of convenience.

TUNED BODY MOUNTS

Specially tuned body mounts are strategically located to help dampen noise and vibration from rough road surfaces before they reach the interior.

LASER-WELDED DOOR FRAMES

Instead of traditional steel stampings, TrailBlazer door frames are constructed using a laser-welding process. This method is designed to enhance occupant protection in the event of a collision and contributes to the overall strong body structure.



BROAD TORQUE CURVE

A broad torque curve through the majority of the TrailBlazer Vortec 4200 six-cylinder engine's speed range helps deliver 90 percent of peak torque from 1600 to 5600 rpm.

VARIABLE EXHAUST VALVE TIMING


Valve timing is electronically controlled and solenoid-actuated. Advancing the exhaust relative to the intake means very little exhaust gas is allowed into the intake charge. The result is smooth combustion that enables good torque and power throughout the speed range.

RIGID STRUCTURE DESIGN

The rigid inline structure of the Vortec 4200 engine contributes to low noise, vibration and harshness (NVH) levels. The engine is designed to perform smoothly through the entire operating range.

SMOOTH SHIFTING PERFORMANCE

All TrailBlazer models feature an electronically controlled four-speed automatic overdrive transmission. It is well known for its smooth and durable operation, performance across the full torque curve and precise shifting.

POWERTRAIN CONTROL MODULE (PCM)

The PCM incorporates computer technology to merge a continuous measurement of inputs to achieve optimization of engine performance and transmission shifts.

ELECTRONIC THROTTLE CONTROL (ETC)

The ETC relays acceleration information to the PCM. The PCM then positions the cylinder air valve in the best position to help achieve optimum vehicle drivability.

COIL-ON PLUG IGNITION

This electronic engine sensing and spark control system delivers a high-energy spark, which leads to consistent combustion.

DRIVING RANGE

With its Vortec 4200 engine and 18.7-gallon fuel tank (approximate), TrailBlazer 2WD models provide a highway driving range of more than 400 miles.*

NO ENGINE RESTARTS

The Vortec 4200 engine is so quiet, engineers included a starter lock-out feature that will not allow the engine to be restarted if it is already running.

EXTENDED MAINTENANCE

Platinum-tip spark plugs help Vortec engines travel up to 100,000 miles before they need to be replaced.† The recommended engine coolant change interval is up to five years or 150,000 miles, whichever comes first.† And the accessory drive belt is designed to operate up to 150,000 miles before requiring replacement.†





USING GROSS COMBINATION WEIGHT RATINGS (GCWRs) TO DETERMINE ENGINE, TRANSMISSION AND REAR AXLE RATIOS: You can use your desired GCWR calculation to determine the powertrain you will require to tow a specific trailer with your TrailBlazer. The last column to the right in the chart above shows the maximum allowable GCWR based on all available TrailBlazer engine, transmission and rear axle combinations. The GCWR includes the total loaded weight of both TrailBlazer and the trailer.

TRAILERING BASICS

Towing a trailer involves all major vehicle systems of your Chevy Truck, including powertrain, steering, suspension and brake systems. Easy and safe trailering requires a properly equipped vehicle, additional trailering equipment and an appropriate trailer. It also requires loading both the vehicle and trailer properly, using safe driving techniques, meeting regional legal requirements and following break-in and maintenance schedules. You are responsible for being sure you have the appropriate equipment and hitch for your specific trailering situation. If you plan to tow a trailer, consult your Owner's Manual, speak to a trailering expert at your Chevrolet dealership or visit our web site at chevy.com

The following chart will assist in determining how to best equip your Chevy Truck for trailering. To help you understand the chart, consider these trailering factors:

Torque: Indicates the strength of the engine. Low-end torque reflects how much force is generated to get your vehicle moving.

Horsepower: Indicates how much work the engine does at a certain engine speed. At mid to high engine rpm, it's what keeps you moving at highway speeds.

Axle Ratio: Along with your vehicle's transmission gears, a higher rear axle ratio contributes to how much available torque and horsepower (mechanical leverage) can be applied to the drive wheels for launch and uphill performance. Higher rear axle ratios, however, sacrifice fuel economy when not trailering.

Ball Hitch Trailering: There are two types of ball hitches. A weight-carrying hitch consists of a ball and coupler with no means to distribute the hitch weight. It is used primarily for lightweight trailers. Heavier trailers, however, require a weight-distributing hitch which uses spring bars to transfer some of the hitch weight forward onto the tow vehicle's front axle and rearward onto the trailer's axle(s).

RGAWR and GVWR: The addition of trailer hitch weight cannot cause vehicle weights to exceed Rear Gross Axle Weight Rating (RGAWR) or Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR). These ratings can be found on the certification label located on the driver door or door frame.

GCWR: The Gross Combination Weight Rating (GCWR) is the total allowable weight of the completely loaded vehicle and trailer including any passengers, cargo, equipment and conversion. A properly equipped tow vehicle and trailer at the maximum GCWR should be able to accelerate and merge with traffic, climb typical interstate grades at highway speeds, handle the combination on most road surfaces, and stop adequately within a reasonable distance. The GCWR for your vehicle should not be exceeded.

TRAILERING CAUTIONS

NOTE: Please read the following trailering cautions/safety information before trailering with your new vehicle.

NOTE: The safety steps described here are by no means the only precautions to be taken when trailering. See the Owner's Manual for the Chevy Truck of your choice for additional guidelines and trailering tips.

■ If you don't use the correct equipment and drive properly, you can lose control of your vehicle when you pull a trailer. For example, if the trailer is too heavy, your vehicle brakes may be less effective. You and your passengers could be seriously injured. Pull a trailer only after taking the following steps:

TRAILER BRAKES

If your trailer weighs more than 1,000 lbs. loaded, then it must have its own adequate brakes. Be sure to read and follow the instructions for the trailer brake controller so that it is installed, adjusted and maintained properly.

■ Don't tap into your vehicle's brake system if the trailer's brake system will use more than 0.02 cu. in. of fluid from your vehicle's master cylinder. If it does, neither braking system will work well. You could even lose your vehicle's brakes.

■ The trailer brake parts must be able to take 3,000 psi of pressure. If not, the trailer brake system must not be used with your vehicle. If everything checks out thus far, then have a qualified individual make the brake fluid tap at the port on the master cylinder that sends fluid to the rear brakes. Don't use copper tubing because it will bend and ultimately break. Use only double-walled steel brake tubing.

HITCHES

It's important to have the correct hitch equipment. Crosswinds, large trucks going by and rough roads are just a few of the reasons why you'll need the right hitch. Here are some rules to follow:

■ If you'll be towing a trailer that, when loaded, will weigh more than 3,500 lbs., be sure to use a frame-mounted, weight-distributing hitch and sway control of the proper size. The equipment is very important for proper vehicle loading and good handling when you're driving.

■ If you have to make any holes in the body of your vehicle to install a trailer hitch, be sure to seal the holes if you ever remove the hitch. If they're not sealed, dirt, water and deadly carbon monoxide from the exhaust can get into your vehicle.


