

# formfitting ▶ interior

The Accord Coupe's interior echoes the exterior's economy of lines and seriousness of purpose. The **deep-bolstered**, form-hugging seats are supportive, comfortable and help keep you securely in place. And given the Coupe's roadholding potential, remaining firmly in your seat takes on a vivid reality with the first decreasing radius corner you dial into. Befitting its mission as a **driver's car**, Accord Coupe's steering

wheel has a standard tilt/telescopic feature to calibrate the positioning perfectly to your liking. And since spirited driving can be thirsty work, you'll find six beverage holders located throughout the **spacious** cabin. Convenient door pockets hold take-along items you might need on the road or at your destination. 

The controls on 2005 models are illuminated to make them easy to see and operate. On models with the navigation system, the driver can also engage the voice recognition system.



## Zoned for dual occupancy.



**Strong, stable type.**

The standard anti-lock braking system (ABS) helps maintain steering control under hard braking. On the EX and V-6 models, the Electronic Brake Distribution system (EBD) balances the front/rear braking forces when the car is loaded.



**Factory tuned.**

The Coupe's available HFP Package includes a sport suspension, 17" alloy wheels, a rear spoiler and an aero kit with front, rear and side underbody spoilers.

**confidence** ▶ handling/stability

The Accord Coupe's suspension is inspired and informed by decades of involvement in fierce competition. There's a **double wishbone** front suspension and an amazingly precise five-link double wishbone rear design. Stabilizer bars front and rear. Precisely damped shock absorbers. Four-wheel disc brakes with ventilated front rotors on most models. Variable-assist power rack-and-pinion steering for **accuracy** in turns. And a vast array of refinements familiar to anyone who's ever spent any time in places like Monza, Brands Hatch or Spa. We're confident this qualifies the Accord Coupe for pole position in your garage.

# go power ▶ engines/transmissions

Honda engines are designed with three key principles in mind: power, efficiency and durability. For power, the V-6 and the 4-cylinder engines both benefit from 4-valve-per-cylinder heads to promote better breathing, plus tuned induction and the unique **VTEC** system. The i-VTEC system in the 2.4-liter four-cylinder adds variable timing control (VTC) to further boost its fuel economy<sup>3</sup> and power. A **balance shaft** system in the 2.4-liter engine reduces vibrations to create a smoother-running engine. Both engines feature a forged-steel crankshaft for increased durability. As an example of Honda's commitment to providing trouble-free driving, the V-6 has a 105,000-mile tune-up interval while the 4-cylinder has a **110,000-mile interval**.<sup>4</sup> As for our dedication to caring for Mother Earth, every 2005 Accord Coupe model meets or exceeds the requirements to be certified as a Low-Emission Vehicle (LEV) in all 50 states.






## Geared up for all occasions.

The V-6 models have a standard 5-speed automatic that integrates with the car's Drive-by-Wire Throttle System™ to provide precision control. For the ultimate in performance, the EX V-6 can be ordered with a precise 6-speed manual transmission that will let you make the most of the engine's pulse-quicken power and torque band.

## Breathe high and low.

The pioneering VTEC technology adjusts valve timing and lift to increase low-end torque and boost throttle response. At higher engine speeds, it promotes better breathing and increases power.



# forethought ▶ safety for everyone

Honda's concept of **safety for everyone** means providing front, front side and side curtain airbags as well as anti-lock braking (ABS) on all Accord Coupe models, and the Traction Control System (TCS) on V-6 models. At their core is a **tough body** structure that pays off in crash protection as well as enhancing suspension precision. The body is designed using the advanced NASTRAN stress analysis software. It allows engineers to "crash test" the body structures even before they're rendered in metal.

A steel prototype body is then constructed and tested. Real-world testing verifies the computer predictions. As a result of our focused attention to the safety of the driver and the occupants, five 2004 Honda models earned **5-star top crash-test ratings** from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) in frontal and side impact testing. That's more than any other brand tested. Needless to say, the Accord Coupe is one of the five to earn that most impressive 5-star rating.\*

## Protection front and rear.

Front and rear crush zones are designed to deform at a controlled rate during an impact, dissipating crash energy before it reaches the passenger compartment.

# 2

## It's a kid thing.

Children are best protected when seated in an approved child seat. The Accord Coupe features the LATCH (Lower Anchors and Tethers for Children) system. It's designed to help make it easier to properly install compatible child seats in the rear seat.

# 3

## Caged for your own good.

The Accord Coupe's rigid safety cell creates a protection zone around the occupants and helps resist the intrusion of impact forces. Substantial beams in the doors help keep side impacts from impinging on the cabin.

# 4

## This is good tension.

The automatic seat-belt tensioning system is triggered by the same impact sensors as the airbag system. In a collision, the tensioners help hold front-seat occupants securely.

# 5

## The science of airbags.

All 2005 Accord models feature dual-stage, dual-threshold front airbags† and front side airbags. The front passenger seat features an Occupant Position Detection System (OPDS) to prevent side-airbag deployment if a child or small-statured adult is out of position and in the side airbag's path of deployment.

## An added margin of safety.

To add an extra layer of head protection, all 2005 models come with side curtain airbags for window-adjacent occupants. They deploy on the affected side when sensors detect a sufficient collision.


