

Falcon 500 Sedan:

New styling, new interior, new features, new engines – making Falcon even more of a Road Car than before.

For better front and rear visibility Falcon has revised styling and a new, lower dash and crash pad design.

Road holding and handling is improved with the addition of a modified suspension system matched to radial tyres.

Front disc brakes are standard as before.

For added confidence when driving at night, Falcon now has the white-light brilliance of quartz-halogen headlights.

And for good visibility in all seasons, there's an improved wiper/washer system and a heated rear window demister.

In standards of comfort new Falcon 500 is even better, too – reclining front bucket seats, carpet and power ventilation are all included in the price you pay.

But perhaps the biggest news of all; new, cross-flow head engines that are designed to meet emission control regulations and run cleaner – yet improving Falcon's power and performance.



New Falcon engines:

Engines that run cleaner - whilst improving Falcon's performance. Overseas, the introduction of government regulations for emission-control engines hasn't always had pleasing results for car owners.

For, while it's been a great step forward in pollution control, it's nearly always been a step backwards in performance. But you'll be pleased with what we've done. We've developed new cross-flow head, 6-cylinder engines with significant benefits:

3.3 litre engine: Runs on lower octane standard fuel, yet provides improved power over the previous 3.3 litre engine.

gives you a power improvement of approximately 10% over its standard dard, resulting in an improvement of head predecessor.


A lot of time and money has gone



into the development of these engines, but the results have been worth it. And they'll certainly mean a lot to you.

V8 engines - 4 barrel carburettion: 4.1 litre engine: This new engine Both Falcon V8 engines now have 4 barrel carburettors fitted as stanapproximately 10% power over the

previous twin carburettor engines.



Improved Visibility.

Side and rear visibility has been improved on Falcon by lowering the rear door belt line. Forward visibility has been improved by lowering the dash/crash pad height.

Improved Ventilation System.

The air ventilation in Falcon has been substantially improved in three ways over the previous model. We've increased the air inlet ducts by approximately 30% to let more air in. Two independent air vents on the instrument panel are fed by a 3speed fan. And air leaves the cabin through extractors mounted on either side of the rear window.

The overall improvement in cabin air circulation without the benefit of "forced draught" is around 100% at face-level and 85% at foot-level.

Quartz-Halogen Headlights.

Falcon now has white-light brilliance of Quartz-Halogen headlights for improved visibility at night.

Improved Wiper/Wash System.

The wipers have a new linkage system and redesigned blades to increase rigidity and reduce shudder.













The sporty GS Rally Pack:

A standout option package for your Falcon, whether it be a sedan or a wagon. In the tradition of the Falcon GT, you get built-in 'NASA' bonnet air scoops. tasteful black paint treatment, styled steel road wheels with trim rings, Quartz-Halogen driving lights, colourkeyed bumpers, bumper over-riders, and left-hand exterior rear-view mirror.

Inside - comprehensive instrumentation tachometer; oil pressure, temperature and fuel gauges; speedometer with odometer plus a quartz-crystal electric clock, soft-feel, sports steering wheel, map reading lamp and padded dash and glove box door.



Falcon servicing and maintenance

In these days of rapid cost escalation, increasing emphasis is being placed on the need to reduce vehicle cost-of-ownership. At Ford we have recognised and met this need. Now, after the initial 1500 km servicing, your new Ford will only require routine servicing every 10,000 km.
