Outside: You'll notice the new GL is wider, and it has sleek new stretched lines.

Similarly, the large wraparound rear window and sharply raked windscreen not only add to the sleekness, but also to driver visibility.

And with curved side glass and panels the Galant gets a contemporary rounded shape.

Notice that the parking lights are incorporated in the new round headlights, which themselves are integrated in a newly designed grille.

As is the custom with all luxury cars, a vinyl roof is available in a choice of either Parchment or Black and of course this year Galant gives you an entirely new range of colours to select from.

Reclining front bucket seats richly embossed, deep vinyl upholstery, full carpeting.
In the instrument cluster
you'll find an electric clock.

Easy located heater/ demister controls. And a push button radio. All backed by a woodgrain fascia. In the Galant tradition, the

new 3-spoke steering wheel is tilt adjustable. There is the choice of manual 4-speed floor shift or 3-speed T-Bar shift. And arm rests are standard on

ENGINEERING.

Galant's 100 bhp, (74.6 kw,) 1600 cc. 4-cylinder Saturn engine features overhead camshaft; lightweight head; minimum-surface combustion chambers; 5-bearing crankshaft; water-heated intake manifold. It's the strongest, most economical little brute ever lowered into a small car.

Galant's all-weather flow-through ventilation system changes the cabin air every 10 minutes. Keeps the atmosphere (and the driver's head) clear, even on rainy

days.
