They also feature High-Intensity Discharge (HID) technology, which means that at night and in other low-light situations, you enjoy superior illumination both straight ahead and to the sides. These headlights can also be equipped with the available IntelliBeam system, which switches automatically between high and low beams during night driving, to ensure maximum visibility at all times.

It starts with a bold, athletic stance – the product of significant increases in Escalade's front and rear track dimensions. The look promises dynamic capabilities well beyond those of ordinary SUVs, and Escalade delivers, with uncanny overall stability, responsive handling and a controlled and comfortable ride.

Similarly, Escalade's all-new body is both beautiful and functional. In wind tunnel testing, this bold, iconic shape is revealed to have a coefficient of friction of just 0.36. Achieving this extraordinary level of efficiency required Cadillac's designers to review and refine every exterior detail, from the angle of the steeply raked windshield to the curvature of the sculpted rear-view mirrors and the precision fit of the exterior panels. Even the seals around the grille have a practical purpose. They help direct more cooling air to Escalade's radiator, enabling a higher level of performance.

Crowning it all, of course, are Escalade's stunning chrome accents. Starting with the available 22-inch wheels and rising up to the brilliant aero roof rack, the new Escalade offers no fewer than seven distinct levels of chrome. No wonder it's such a magnet for spotlights.







THE EVOLUTION OF LUXURY

Sumptuous seating comfort has long been an Escalade hallmark. The 2007 model goes even further, with luxurious seats boasting a streamlined, European-inspired look and feel and aggressive bolsters to hold you firmly in place. The front buckets offer integrated heaters, 12-way power adjustments and a driver's two-position memory function. For an even higher level of comfort during warm-weather driving, cooled front bucket seats are also available.

The new Escalade provides first-class accommodations for your second-row passengers, with increased leg, shoulder and knee room, and a more relaxed seatback angle that contributes to a sense of spaciousness and ease. The standard second-row buckets are heated for increased comfort on cold winter mornings.

Perhaps the most appealing aspect of Escalade's rich interior, though, is the premium quality of its appointments. Supple leathers with double-stitched French seams and finely textured fabrics are perfectly highlighted by brushed aluminum and bright chrome accents. The design, materials and craftsmanship all exceed your highest expectations.





ESCALADE AND THE ART OF CONTROL.

DRIVING IS JOY.



Fittingly, no one experiences Escalade's unique blending of fashion and function more vividly than its driver.

The driving environment is a pure pleasure to view, with a unique wood and leather-wrapped steering wheel, a premium soft-touch instrument panel and finely styled analogue gauges trimmed in chrome. Look beyond the surface, though, and it quickly becomes clear that every element has also been carefully designed to optimize your comfort and control.

Those stylish gauges, for example, are continuously backlit by white LEDs to help you see them clearly, even in varying light conditions. The Driver Information Centre includes a four-row display that's capable of alerting you to a wide range of conditions that deserve your attention. Every control has been crafted to allow easy, intuitive use. The exterior lighting, sound system and automatic climate control system are all controlled via rotary switches, an elegant design touch that contributes to a harmonious look and feel.

Then there's Escalade's beautiful steering wheel. It's equipped with numerous switches which allow you to control a range of secondary functions without ever taking your eyes off the road, or your hands off the wheel. Also available is a heated steering wheel that can add a higher level of comfort on cold winter days.



ABANDON THE STATUS QUO.

ENJOY AN ARRAY OF REFINED DETAILS.

In creating the new Escalade, Cadillac's engineers and designers lavished attention on perfecting interior elements both large and small. The result is a vehicle that excels on every front.

Take passenger comfort, for example. The Escalade's tri-zone automatic climate control does an outstanding job of keeping every occupant comfortable, regardless of the weather outside. It warms and cools the interior quietly and efficiently and delivers superior airflow to the rear seats. For individualized comfort, the Escalade driver can select a temperature up to 17°C different from that chosen by the front

passenger. Rear passengers enjoy a rare degree of autonomy, too, thanks to separate controls that enable them to select their own preferred settings.

Escalade lets you pamper your rear passengers with a choice of three different seating arrangements. The standard configuration includes a pair of heated, reclining second-row bucket seats and a three-passenger 50/50 split-folding third-row bench. If you wish to carry an additional passenger, a 3-passenger 60/40 split-folding second-row bench seat is also available. And for those who wish to provide extra room and luxury for their rearmost occupants, Escalade also offers a third-row two-passenger 50/50 split-folding bench seat.



Or take the rear DVD entertainment system. In the 2007 Escalade, the DVD player is integrated into the instrument panel for convenient operation. The flip-down, roof-mounted 203 mm (8 in.) LCD screen is the same 16:9 aspect ratio preferred for modern home theatres. Or, if you prefer, dual screens mounted in the front-seat head restraints are available as a dealer-installed accessory. Rear-seat audio is provided via infrared wireless headphones capable of receiving two channels, a feature that allows one rear-seat occupant to listen to music while the other watches a movie. The system also includes two auxiliary input jacks for MP3 players, CD players, video games and other devices. The entertainment options are virtually endless.

Finally, consider cargo-carrying convenience. Here again, the 2007 Escalade sets a new and higher standard. The second-row seats are controlled via a single lever. Lift it once and the seatbacks fold forward to free up additional cargo space. Lift it a second time and the seats flip all the way forward and out of the way. There's also a power release fold-and-tumble system that allows you to fold the rear seats forward at the touch of a button, without ever leaving the comfort of your driver's seat. Additional switches can be found on each rear door pillar proving their worth when you are carrying packages or a child.

WHEREVER YOU TRAVEL, TAKE THE LEAD.

Another highly evolved Escalade feature is the available DVD-based Navigation System.* Using the GPS unit included with the standard OnStar System, it is capable of pinpointing your location and instantly mapping your route in either 2- or 3-D on its large, integrated 203 mm (8 in.) touch-screen display. It can provide audible turn-by-turn directions over the sound system speaker, and its off-road mode is handy for retracing your steps when you're negotiating uncharted roads or trails. The system also includes a voice recognition capability that allows you to access destinations, change the radio station and even change the track when you're listening to an audio disc.




TRANSFORMATION BEYOND EXPECTATION.

The key to Escalade EXT's near-magical reconfigurability is the Midgate located behind the EXT's rear seat. Any time you need maximum secure cargo space, simply fold the rear seats and the Midgate panel forward and you have a 2690-litre covered cargo hold. Or remove the tonneau cover, stow the window and fold the Midgate to create an eight-foot pickup bed with two-tier loading.










CLEAR THINKING.

Escalade devotes ingenious technology to keeping your privileged view pristine — despite the elements. The standard Rainsense wiper system constantly monitors buildup on the windshield and triggers the wipers whenever it's appropriate. When conditions require it, a push of a button on the instrument panel causes Escalade's windshield washer fluid to be quickly super-heated to approximately 70°C, making short work of frost, light ice buildup, insect spatter, even tree sap.



AUTO REAR LEVELLING SYSTEM

The new Escalade's heavy-duty automatic rear levelling system assures proper headlight aiming by constantly adjusting

the rear shock absorbers to maintain a consistent vehicle attitude, regardless of cargo and passenger loading.



ULTRASONIC PARK ASSIST AND REARVIEW CAMERA

Escalade's ultrasonic rear parking assist system provides an earlier audible warning when it detects an object in your path when your Escalade is in Reverse. It can be supplemented with an available

Rearview Camera that displays a wide-angle image of the area behind your Escalade on the DVD Navigation System's screen. It assists in safety when parking and is indispensable when you need to hook up a trailer.



Whenever you wish to escape the uproar of the world outside, Escalade is there for you with outstanding cabin quietness in the full-size luxury SUV class. It's there for you, too, when it's time to enjoy your favourite music. The standard Bose 5.1 Discrete Digital Surround Sound system provides six distinct channels of concert-quality sound, for a listening experience comparable to that of a high-end home theatre system. Jointly developed by engineers from Cadillac and Bose, this system is exceptional in its power, clarity, spaciousness and detail.

WHERE EVERY SEAT IS THE BEST SEAT IN THE HOUSE.

Escalade's Bose 5.1 Discrete Digital Surround Sound system achieves something previously thought to be impossible: it delivers a fully balanced surround sound experience for every listener, regardless of where they happen to be sitting. The secret is Bose's proprietary SurroundStage® technology. It sends each audio channel to the right combination of speakers to create a perfect listening environment at every seat.



At every seat, Escalade's standard Bose audio system creates the feeling of being in the middle of the music. Components in the Escalade sound system include 1-inch tweeters in each A-pillar, a 3.5-inch Twiddler™ mid/high range centre-fill speaker in the middle of the instrument panel; 6.5-inch wide-range neodymium speaker in the front doors; 5.25-inch wide-range speakers in the rear doors; 2.5-inch Twiddler speakers in each D-pillar, a 5.25-inch Richbass® woofer in a customized 8.5-litre ported, tuned enclosure in the front centre console. Other essential elements include a Bose digital amplifier, Centerpoint® signal processing circuitry, AudioPilot® noise compensation technology and an AudioPilot® microphone.

WRAPAROUND SAFETY.

PROTECTION IN EVERY DIRECTION.


When it comes to safety, the new Escalade works all the angles. Its excellent allaround visibility, intuitive controls, responsive handling and powerful brakes all assist you in avoiding dangerous situations. And that's merely the beginning.

Escalade employs state-of-the-art technologies to help keep you out of harm's way. The standard StabiliTrak vehicle stability enhancement system not only assists you in regaining control in a lateral skid, it now also monitors for potential rollover situations and applies the brakes, selectively and automatically, to help put you back in control.

Other Escalade technologies are engineered to come to your aid when a collision can't be avoided. A 360-degree sensing system monitors for impacts at the front, sides and rear of the vehicle and sends appropriate signals to the front seat safety belt pre-tensioners and all six standard air bags.* Should air bag deployment take place, OnStar's Advanced Automatic Crash Notification feature immediately alerts advisors at the OnStar Centre, who can then dispatch emergency services to your precise location.


The new Escalade's protective nature even benefits the occupants of other vehicles. Its new frame incorporates compatibility brackets that meet 100 percent of all car and truck bumper heights on the road today.





Escalade guards against injury with a strong new frame and body structure and no fewer than six air bags. Dual-stage frontal air bags* (D and FP) help protect the driver and front passenger in moderate to severe impacts at the front of the vehicle. In a side impact, head protection for the first and second-row occupants is delivered by new roof-mounted head curtain side air bags (SC 1/2). Another pair of roof-mounted air bags (SC 3) provides the same protection for your third-row passengers. All Escalade models also include three-point lap/shoulder safety belts at all seating positions. In addition, the second- and third-row seats feature LATCH attachments, which make it easier to secure child seats properly and securely.

*A NOTE ON CHILD SAFETY: Always use safety belts and proper child restraints, even in vehicles with air bags. Even with the Automatic Occupant Sensing system, children are safer when properly secured in a rear seat. Never place a rear-facing infant restraint in the front seat of any vehicle equipped with an active air bag. Refer to the vehicle Owner's Manual and child safety seat instructions for more information.



STRONG, SILENT TYPE

The backbone of the Escalade engine is a forged steel crankshaft with six-bolt main bearing caps and more than enough strength to handle all the power and torque the Vortec 6200 V8 can dish out. It's a major contributor to the engine's smooth performance, as are sophisticated hydraulic engine mounts. These take the place of conventional hard rubber units and are specifically tuned to dampen out vibrations at low engine speeds. Benefits include a quiet idle and a highly refined engine character during low-speed cruising.



POWER PUNCH

To accommodate the Escalade engine's high 10.5:1 compression ratio and WT-controlled high-lift camshaft, each piston top is etched with special notches. They keep the pistons from contacting the valves at top dead centre and are a common feature of high-performance, high-compression engines. Another performance-oriented feature is the Vortec 6200 V8's vented crankcase, which keeps air pressure on the underside of the pistons from impeding their downstroke and thereby robbing efficiency and power.

ADVANCED AWD

Every Escalade sold in Canada is equipped with a sophisticated all-wheel-drive (AWD) system that's fully integrated with the standard StabiliTrak and anti-lock braking systems. In normal conditions, Escalade's AWD system sends 60 percent of engine torque to the rear wheels and 40 percent to the front wheels, for excellent vehicle stability. The BorgWarner transfer case's key internal components have been upgraded to handle the Vortec 6200 V8 engine's prodigious horsepower and torque.

PERFORMANCE BRAKING

Larger, vented front and rear brake rotors and an all-new Bosch 8.0 4-channel anti-lock system assure predictable, linear brake response and reduced stopping distances. The system also includes stiffer dual-piston calipers and longer-life brake pads.

CAPABILITY, COMFORT, CONTROL

At the rear, the 2007 Escalade features a new and more robust axle design that offers increased payload capacity. An enhanced five-link rear suspension contributes to excellent ride comfort and body control.







SOPHISTICATION UP FRONT

Escalade's new power rack-and-pinion steering, new coil-over-shock front suspension and redesigned front axle result in much more than just responsive handling. They're also specifically designed to help isolate the cabin from noise and vibration.

6 SPEEDS FORWARD

Escalade sends its 403 horsepower to the road via a new 6-speed automatic transmission with electronic controls. Standard Driver Shift Control allows manual-style shifting and the ability to hold a gear during spirited driving situations, such as on twisting roads. The new transmission also includes a Tow/Haul mode, which holds gears longer for increased performance and helps eliminate "hunting" between gears on long uphill grades. A heavy-duty external air-to-oil transmission cooler is included for added protection during towing.

P-METRIC CONVERSION

Instead of rough-riding light truck tires, the new Escalade rides on P-metric tires which incorporate a special nylon cap ply for added strength and durability. The primary benefit is a smooth, comfortable ride. These P-metric tires also contribute to Escalade's fuel economy, thanks to their reduced weight and rolling resistance, and their low tread noise adds to the calm, relaxing atmosphere in the Escalade cabin.



A NEW FRAME OF REFERENCE.

START FROM STRENGTH.

Under the leather and chrome, the 2007 Escalade is a paragon of strength. Its core is a fully boxed steel frame with precision-engineered hydroformed components at the front and rear. All this technology results in a frame that's a full 49 percent stiffer torsionally than its predecessor, for improved quality and crashworthiness. It also allows a wider stance than before, and it provides a solid foundation for a wide range of advanced chassis technologies. The standard Road-Sensing Suspension system adjusts automatically to ensure a comfortable ride, even on poor surfaces. StabiliTrak vehicle stability enhancement system helps you regain control in lateral skids and incorporates new rollover mitigation capability. Other sophisticated systems that enhance your control and safety include traction control and a tire pressure monitoring system.





A DISTINGUISHED BODY OF WORK

Thoughtful engineering of the new Escalade body structure has resulted in improved rollover and side-impact performance. High-strength steel reinforces the pillars that frame the windshield as well as the ones between the front and rear doors. Each door is framed with an all-new, single-piece "D" ring that offers increased dimensional accuracy for improved exterior and interior fit and finish.





One of the new Escalade's most appealing attributes is the extraordinary silence of its cabin. This achievement required a comprehensive effort that began with the design of the frame and body and extended to the powertrain, tire selection and beyond. The final touches include spray-on dash and floor panel damping applied with computer-controlled precision and a special acoustic barrier over the drive tunnel. Even the interior carpeting was selected with its sound-deadening properties in mind.

STRONG TO THE CORE

Escalade's fully boxed frame achieves a high degree of rigidity through its strategic use of inherently robust rectangular sections and high-strength steel. This extraordinary strength allows Escalade to combine the capabilities of a full-size SUV with levels of smoothness and responsiveness rarely found in this class of vehicle. The front and rear frame components address another top priority, crashworthiness, with elements designed first to deflect, and in more severe collisions, to absorb impacts.





On the new Escalade, every suspension (shown at far left) and engine cradle attachment is reinforced, contributing to markedly increased frame stiffness. This enabled Cadillac's engineers to tune Escalade's springs, bushings and other components with great precision and played a major role in delivering the vehicle's refined ride and handling characteristics. The body mounts (shown at near left) are specially designed to help isolate the cabin and its occupants from noise and vibration.

ADVANCED SUSPENSION AND STEERING

Escalade's new front suspension features a coilover-shock layout with a forged aluminum lower control arm. It's a design more commonly found on fine performance sedans, and it enables the new Escalade to deliver linear, responsive ride and handling characteristics that are uncommon, to say the least, in this class of vehicle. Another sedan-like feature is a rack-and-pinion steering system that delivers an immediate, precise response and a positive on-centre feel.





The highly refined five-link rear suspension makes use of strong yet lightweight micro-alloy steel to handle heavy loads and consistently delivers a smooth ride and excellent road isolation. Escalade's Road-Sensing Suspension system of computer-controlled monotube shock absorbers provides instant and apt suspension responses to a wide range of driving conditions, triggering specific damping settings to enhance your control during higher-speed turns and over uneven surfaces.


