The new SL-Class engines boast prodigious performance.


Mercedes-Benz has been making motor racing history with the SL-Class since the legendary Gullwing model of 1954. However, the SL-Class has never been as dynamic as it is today: new eight and twelve cylinder engines with spine-tingling acceleration.

The SL-Class experience opens with a V-8 engine under the hood of the SL 550. Its 382 hp catapult it to 100 km/h in a mere 5.4 seconds and the 391 lb-ft of maximum torque is available between 2800 and 4800 rpm. The cylinder heads have been redesigned from scratch: timing of the two intake and two exhaust valves is taken care of by continuously variable camshaft adjustment


to optimize combustion of the fuel. Not only does this increase the engine's power output, it reduces its consumption and emissions too.

V-12 engines have always been synonymous with supreme confidence and reassurance in any situation on the road. The SL 600 stays true to this tradition with performance data that truly takes your breath away: with a blistering 510 hp and 612 lb-ft maximum torque, the SL 600 sears 0 to 100 km/h in 4.5 seconds. The V-12 engine combines twin-turbochargers with an intercooler to offer more spontaneous response, deliver its torque peak at extremely low revs and yet still reduce fuel consumption.





The SL600, SL55 AMG and SL65 AMG feature 5-speed automatic transmissions. Both AMG models come with AMG-enhanced capabilities and manual shift paddles come standard. AMG SPEEDSHIFT programming makes gear changes up to 35% faster, with automatic downshifts during braking and one-touch selection for optimal acceleration.

If you are looking for even more lateral support when cornering, you may opt for the multicontour seats with air cushions that adjust themselves to the contours of your body. These motoring thrones also include a massage function: at the push of a button, air pads gently pulsate to relax the back muscles. Alternatively, optional climatic comfort seats feature heat at the touch of a button for chilly mornings and active ventilation for cooling down quickly in the summer. The COMAND APS control and display system with DVD navigation guides you swiftly and surely to your destination. And for added peace of mind

en route, you can have DISTRONIC proximity control fitted as an option. At speeds from 30 – 180 km/h, DISTRONIC will automatically keep you at a safe distance from the vehicle in front.

Enjoy perfect climatic comfort with the standard automatic climate control for each occupant, which includes dust filters. With the vivid sound of the standard BOSE® Surround Sound System, you'll enjoy music like your very own concert on wheels.

With the KEYLESS-GO electronic key in your pocket, you merely have to pull the door handle to open the door and push the start button on the selector lever to start and switch off the engine (optional on SL 550).


Whichever route you choose, you'll always be taking the safe road with the SL-Class thanks to the pioneering safety technology on board. It allows you to indulge in the roadster experience while enjoying the feeling of safety associated with a sedan.

Mercedes-Benz led the way in roadster safety as long ago as 1989 when it fitted the first ever sensor-controlled rollover bar as standard in the SL-Class. Normally concealed out of sight, it can extend fully in just 0.3 seconds the instant danger is sensed. At the heart of this technology is a tilting-cone sensor which combines with an electronic control unit to detect when the SL-Class is at a critical tilt angle. Plus, an acceleration sensor keeps an eye on the roadster's current status so that the rollover

bar can also be deployed automatically if the vehicle is involved in a collision from the front, side or rear. A preloaded spring makes sure the rollover bar is ready for action at any time, but it can also be raised and lowered manually at the push of a button.

Bi-Xenon headlamps come standard on all models with cornering lights and headlamp washers; they guarantee optimum visibility when driving on dark roads. And if the worst should happen, rest assured that the SL-Class offers you the best possible protection. The driver's and front passenger air bags trigger in a matter of milliseconds in the event of a collision, and the large-capacity head/thorax air bags on both sides inflate in response to a side impact to form a protective cushion between you and the door.

See it before it sees you
The cornering light function allows you to see better in night-time driving by illuminating the road in the direction you are turning with a wider fog lamp beam. Seeing potential obstacles earlier gives you time to respond accordingly.



Active Body Control (ABC)

The Active Body Control system continuously adjusts each wheel's suspension to counteract vibration, roll, pitch and cornering. It automatically lowers the suspension at higher speeds and provides a sport mode option.



AMG and SL – two sets of letters that are synonymous with motoring passion and exclusivity. When fused together, the result is two sensational sport cars: propelled by a 5.5-litre supercharged V-8 AMG engine, the SL 55 AMG has 510 hp and up to 531 lb-ft of torque at its disposal.

The most powerful model in the SL-Class range also holds the title of the most powerful series-produced roadster in the world: the SL 65 AMG. A twin-turbocharged 6.0-litre V-12 engine with 604 hp and wielding a torque peak of 738 lb-ft makes it something of a rarity. The speedometer needle passes the 100-km/h mark in a breathtaking 4.2 seconds. The decelerating power is as reassuring as the accelerating power is exhilarating, thanks to the high-performance AMG composite braking system fitted for both models. The calling card for the AMG models is new AMG body styling with aggressively matched front apron, side sills

and rear apron. The SL 55 AMG is shod with new 19-inch AMG light-alloy wheels and the SL 65 AMG sport multi-piece 19-inch AMG light-alloy wheels finished in titanium grey as standard.

Awaiting you inside are exclusive Nappa leather appointments, an AMG instrument cluster with RACETIMER function plus a new AMG sport steering wheel with gearshift paddles. The carbon fibre trim offers the ultimate in dynamic look and feel.






