- 1. DUAL AIR BAGS.† Every Talon features standard driver and front passenger air bags to help absorb the force of a severe frontal impact.
- 2. ANALOG GAUGES. Instruments are easy to read, day or night.
- SPORT STEERING WHEEL.
 Leather-wrapped on TSi and
 TSi AWD.
- 4. SEATING FOR FOUR.

 Contoured seating includes fully adjustable front bucket seats and a folding rear seat for added versatility (rear seat split-folding on TSi and TSi AWD).
- 5. EXTERIOR DESIGN. Talon's sleek shape translates into a drag coefficient of just 0.29, one of the lowest in the world for a production vehicle. A low drag coefficient can help to reduce wind noise, improve fuel efficiency, and aid vehicle stability.
 6. CD PLAYER. Among the sound systems available on every Talon is an AM/FM stereo radio with a combination full logic cassette and CD player.

7. BODY RIGIDITY. You can't see it, but you can feel it. Talon has one of the best body rigidity ratings in the world for a production vehicle. The more rigid the body, the easier it is to tune the suspension to deliver a smooth ride and great handling.

8. POWER DOOR LOCKS. Talon's optional power door-locking system allows you to unlock both doors or just the driver's door for added security (standard on Talon TSi AWD).

9. SPEED-SENSITIVE STEERING.
To make the steering even more responsive, Talon's rack-and-pinion design is power-assisted and speed-sensitive for increased assist at low speeds and increased road feel at highway speeds.

10. SUSPENSION DESIGN. This multi-link double-wishbone design is fully independent at each wheel for riding comfort as well as handling prowess.

12. ALL-WHEEL DRIVE. Talon
TSi AWD features a full-time all-wheel drive system that maximizes handling and acceleration by automatically sending power to the wheels that need it most.
13. POWER 4-WHEEL DISC
BRAKES. Every Talon features standard four-wheel disc brakes (ventilated front) that are power-assisted for exceptional braking.
Anti-lock brakes are optional on every Talon.
