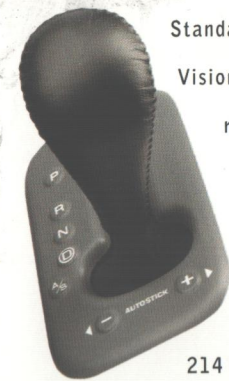

1. CAB-FORWARD DESIGN.

Vision's advanced cab-forward design brings the edge of the windshield down and forward and moves all four wheels to the corners to improve room, ride, and handling.

2. DUAL AIR BAGS.[†] Standard on every Vision to help protect the driver and front passenger in the event of a severe frontal collision.

3. ENGINE RESPONSE. A 214 horsepower overhead cam 3.5 litre 24-valve V6 is standard on Vision TSi. A 161 horsepower 3.3 litre V6 is standard on Vision ESi.

4. THE AUTOSTICK SYSTEM. Standard on Vision TSi to maximize performance and control. Includes a driver-interactive transmission that gives you the choice of shifting like a conventional automatic transmission or shifting manually with the flick of the wrist.

5. POWER STEERING. To make the steering even more responsive, this rack-and-pinion design features speed-sensitive

variable-assist power steering (standard TSi, optional ESi).

6. SUSPENSION DESIGN. This four-wheel fully independent suspension is a sophisticated design that ensures both a smooth ride and precise handling. The Performance Suspension that's included with the Performance Handling Package (optional on Vision TSi) includes uprated springs, strut dampeners, and suspension bushings.

7. FOUR-WHEEL POWER DISC BRAKES. Every Vision features standard four-wheel disc brakes that are power-assisted for exceptional braking. Anti-lock brakes are standard on TSi, optional on ESi.

8. INTERIOR DESIGN. Vision's cab-forward design ensures plenty of room for five adults, plus 16.6 cubic feet of trunk space for their luggage.

9. CHILD SAFETY SEAT. This optional integrated seat replaces the rear center armrest and is designed for children one year or older, weighing from 20 to 66 pounds.

10. DYNAMIC SIDE-IMPACT PROTECTION. Helps protect occupants in the event of a side-impact collision.

11. AUDIO SYSTEMS. A stereo AM/FM cassette player is standard on Vision ESi. An 11-speaker Spatial Imaging™ sound system with 150-watt amp, 5-band graphic equalizer, and a premium cassette player is optional, as is a similar system with a combination cassette/compact disc player (TSi only).

12. AIR CONDITIONING. ESi features standard manual air conditioning while TSi offers standard automatic temperature control. Every Vision features standard rear seat air vents.

13. WARRANTY PROTECTION. Every new Eagle Vision comes with Customer One Care, which includes 3-year/36,000-mile bumper-to-bumper vehicle protection and 24-Hour Roadside Assistance.*
