But the Rabbit's extra-rigid chassis lets it handle almost any punishment in its path. And because it's German engineered, the Rabbit is nimble and quick, so it can deftly maneuver through heavy traffic or dive into parking spots that other drivers would never even think about. But don't let its size fool you. You'll be amazed at how much space it has inside, and how tough it is on the outside. The NHTSA awarded it a 4 star frontal and a 5 star side impact crash test rating.<sup>3</sup> Make no mistake, city-dwellers. The Rabbit is back.

- 1 Under the hood, the Rabbit has a 5-cylinder, 2.5 litre, 150 hp engine. With 4 valves per cylinder it's not only powerful enough to leave lumbering buses in its dust, it also gets from 10.5L/100km in the city and 7.1L/100km on the highway.<sup>2</sup>
- 2 The Rabbit comes in both 2-door and 4-door versions. It's taller, longer and wider than its predecessor,<sup>4</sup> so it can fit almost anything you throw at it. But don't worry. It's a Rabbit. Which means it drives like a big car but parks and avoids pigeon poop like a small one.
- 3 Inside the Rabbit's trunk, you'll find a power outlet that turns your Rabbit into a mobile battery. Hey, it never hurts to be prepared.
- 4 The Rabbit's simplest and most useful feature is its hatchback. It turns it from a "regular" car into a master of space. Back here you'll find a removable storage divider, a hook you can use for your grocery bags and 4 tie-down hooks for cargo.
- 5 The Rabbit comes with an available satellite radio-ready 10-speaker CD stereo system that's so smart, it can raise the volume based on the level of outside noise. Which pretty much means you'll never hear the gasps of wide-eyed bike messengers as you blow by them.
