Design

Perhaps one of the most striking improvements on the New Fabia is the redesigned front bumper. Combined with the reshaped front fog lights, the face of the Fabia has changed and takes on a distinctive new appearance. The characteristic front grille displaying the renowned Škoda badge has also undergone a slight facelift but remains as instantly recognisable as ever. The new distinctive rear lights ensure that drivers behind you are in no doubt that this is the New Fabia.

Taking hold of the new four-spoke steering wheel, you will feel how easily and naturally it fits within your grasp. You will notice how all the instruments are cleverly positioned for fingertip

control. Finally, you will appreciate how the interior and dashboard colours blend perfectly to create a harmonious ambience.

Safety

Safety

Safety is our first concern at Škoda and starts early in the design development stage. The safety standards of the Fabia have been developed using an extensive programme of crash testing and are among the highest in its class.

The Fabia has a rigid body shell to protect you and your passengers, and computer designed crumple zones help to soak up any impact. ABS (Anti-lock Braking System) is now fitted as standard across the Fabia range. EDL (Electronic Differential Lock) and ASR (Anti-Slip Regulation) are also fitted on all Elegance models and on

the Ambiente 1.4 16v 100bhp and 1.9 TDI models. Airbags are fitted for the driver and front passenger on all models. When activated, the fuel supply to the engine is also cut off.

- 1 Your kids stay safe and sound in the back thanks to the special safety fixing points for two ISOFIX system child seats. Because this type of child seat can be fixed directly to the body of the car, it's ultra secure and almost becomes an integral part of the car itself. So you have the peace of mind that comes with ensuring that your children are as safe as possible.
- 2 The Fabia can seat 5 in comfort. The rear seat is fitted with a third headrest (Optional across the range) and three-point seatbelt for the middle passenger (as standard). When not in use, simply retract the headrest and fold it down so that your view in the rear mirror is unimpeded.



Comfort

1 Cruise control, once you reach the speed that suits you, simply use the switch to set it. The cruise control then automatically keeps to your chosen speed. Optional on all models excluding 1.2 54bhp.



2 In the Elegance, Ambiente and vRS models remote central locking comes as standard (optional on Classic). Key shown for Elegance and vRS only. Please note: the second key is supplied without remote.



3 The automatic air conditioning system provides the interior with cool or warm air at just the right temperature. The ventilator regulates the circulation of air at different levels. Optional for Classic and Ambiente and comes as standard for the Elegance and vRS.

4 Heated and electrically adjustable door mirrors. Standard on Ambiente, Elegance and vRS.



5 Front electric windows standard on Ambiente, Elegance and vRS.



6 Electrically operated slide and tilt sunroof. Optional on Classic, Ambiente, Elegance and vRS.

7 Acoustic rear parking sensors, integrated into the rear bumper. Optional on Ambiente and Elegance.



1 The Fabia Estate features a practical storage space for an umbrella situated on the retractable luggage compartment roller cover behind the rear headrests.

2 A drink's holder sits within easy reach on the driver's side. In air conditioned cars, drinks stored in the glove compartment are also refreshingly chilled.

3 Glove compartment with pen holder (including light on Elegance models)

4 The longitudinal roof runners featured on the Fabia Estate emphasise the sleek lines of the car. On a more practical basis, they also serve as a secure base for fitting all types of roof-rack such as ski and bicycle racks.



With a Fabia Hatch you'll be getting an exceptionally spacious interior and an impressive 260 litre boot capacity, with the rear seats folded down there's 1,016 litres of luggage space available. Beneath the rear cover of the elegant Fabia Saloon lies 438 litres of storage space which can be increased to 789 litres by folding down the

rear seats. The Fabia Estate boasts 426 litres or 1,225 litres with the rear seats down. With all models, the rear seats can be split.



Technology

There is a wide range of Fabia engines available to suit your needs. The 1.2 HTP (High Torque Performance) petrol engines are perfect choices for urban driving due to their outstanding flexibility and low fuel consumption. If your tastes tend towards the more dynamic then 1.4 16V 100bhp engine will be more to your liking or the 2.0 115bhp for those who savour the feeling of power! The diesel engines that are on offer combine the advantages of performance with

fuel efficiency. For the economically-minded, the 1.9 64bhp is sure to appeal. The responsive three cylinder 1.4 TDI PD 75bhp shares up-to-the-minute Pumpe Düse technology with the impressive 1.9 TDI PD 100bhp.



1 The new dials and instrument panel fulfil both form and function. The subtle green illumination neither distracts nor tires the eyes on those long, dark trips.

2 Manual transmission will be the choice for many. The gear stick is subtly shaped and moves smoothly and precisely for optimum car control. The five-speed manual transmission is fitted as standard in all Fabia models (six speed manual on vRS).

3 Automatic transmission can prove to be the more comfortable option for some. In the stopping and starting of heavy traffic, there's no need for repeated gear changes. Available with 16V 75bhp engine Fabias.



- 1 One of life's pleasures is listening to music when you're on the move. A six-disk CD auto-changer situated beneath the front passenger seat means you can select your favourites in advance and reserve your concentration for the road. Optional on Classic, Ambiente, Elegance and vRS.
- 2 There's no losing the permanently fixed flexible aerial - even in car washes. It simply folds over.



- 3 The MS 202 radio comprises cassette player, AM/FM radio with RDS system, automatic switch-off, security code and a removable front panel. So whether it's checking up on the latest traffic news, catching one of up to six pre-programmable radio stations or playing a cassette, it's all at your fingertips. Standard on 1.2 54bhp.
- 4 The top of the range is the Symphony radio/CD player. Standard on all models excluding 1.2 54bhp.
- 5 The navigation system can prove to be invaluable. To direct you to your chosen destination, it gives both voice and visual information including directions, remaining length of trip, estimated time of arrival and more. The data appears both on the navigation screen and on the Maxi-DOT display. The system also includes a radio/CD player.
NB - When Navigation is being used, integrated CD player cannot be used. 6 CD autochanger is recommended. Optional on Ambiente, Elegance and vRS.
- 6 The Maxi-DOT screen gives you constantly updated information including number of kilometres driven and external temperature. Available with Satellite Navigation system (optional on Ambiente, Elegance and vRS).

Fabia Classic

Even with the entry level Classic, you get a fine car in the Fabia. All engineering and build quality is to the same high standard. You have a choice of frugal petrol or diesel engines to keep costs low* and the option of an automatic transmission (1.4 16v 75bhp petrol only). Safety features include ABS, driver and front passenger airbags, height adjustable headrests and child safety locks. Driving is made easy and pleasurable with power steering,

fully adjustable steering wheel and height adjustable driver's seat. *See Price list and technical specification for full details.

Fabia Ambiente

Extra comfort is the key to this Fabia trim level. Škoda engineering excellence is standard but there are a few extras to add to your driving pleasure such as front electric windows, remote central locking (with deadlocks) and a trip computer to show you just how economical your Fabia is to drive.

The Ambiente comes with ABS, driver and front passenger airbags as standard. It also has a more advanced braking system with ABS, EDL

and ASR (on selected models) which add additional control to braking and handling. To the outside world exclusive wheel trims, tinted glass and bodyside protective mouldings ensure that the Ambiente will really turn heads.

Fabia Elegance

The Elegance is the ultimate in Fabia luxury. In the summer months you will enjoy the comfort of air conditioning with its chilled glove box and drinks compartment.

All models come with ABS, EDL and ASR as standard. Also unique to the Elegance are heated front seats and alloy wheels. The final extra touches to the interior are a chrome gear knob and door handles. There is also a full alarm system.

Fabia vRS

Once in a while even the mildest mannered driver needs to have fun.

Now you can enjoy all the practicality of the Škoda Fabia with even more pulling power. 128mph* and 0-60mph in 9.5 seconds – is this the Fabia we know and love? The Fabia vRS – inspired by the official Škoda world rally car, competing in the highly competitive World Rally Championship.

The Fabia vRS has a highly developed 1.9 turbo-diesel engine delivering an outrageous 130bhp through a six speed gearbox with a combined fuel consumption of 52.3mpg. In addition to the striking vRS badge there is a sassy rear spoiler, sports exhaust, green brake callipers, stylish 16" alloys and lowered suspension that tell the world the Fabia vRS means business!

And inside, the cloth trimmed sports seats complement the chrome dials and aluminium foot pedals adding to the sports status of the Fabia vRS.

Technical glossary

ABS: the Anti-lock Braking System prevents the wheels from locking during heavy or emergency braking, enabling the vehicle to remain steerable. When braking, wheel speed sensors measure the road wheel speed and should one or more wheels start to lock the system reduces brake pressure to that wheel.

EDL: the Electronic Differential Lock continually compares the rpm of the drive wheels, and if it identifies a difference between them which could lead to an individual wheel spinning, for example if the two wheels are on different types of surface or accelerating on wet leaves, the system brakes the wheel affected until uniform rpm of all drive wheels is restored.

ASR: ASR traction control ensures the Fabia's stability when pulling away or accelerating. If the engine power or torque being transmitted to the drive wheels is too great, e.g., on a

slippery road surface, engine torque is automatically reduced until optimum road holding returns, thus preventing wheelspin. A light indicates whether the ASR system is on. It can be manually switched off.

CAN Bus: the CAN bus is an electronic data bus which links the various different electronic control systems in the car. It ensures ideal co-ordination between systems and reduces the amount of wiring needed in the car.

Fuel cut-out: should one or more of the airbags inflate after an accident, this system automatically cuts off the fuel supply, thus helping prevent subsequent leakage of diesel or petrol.

Pump Injector Technology: the 100bhp 1.9 TDI runs on the accelerator pump principle. This involves the high-pressure injection of the

diesel fuel into the cylinder head via a pump fitted into the cylinder head itself. This ensures optimum filling of the combustion chamber, which means that the engine can achieve a high torque at low rpm, and is therefore particularly economical to run.

Trip Computer: the trip computer not only features an impressive range of data displays, operating it is simplicity itself. A multifunction touch key enables you to call up all relevant data on the easy-to-read display. Features include external temperature, time, current fuel consumption, average fuel consumption, miles driven and average speed.

EBD: Electronic Brake force Distribution. It prevents the rear wheels from over-braking before the ABS takes effect, or also in certain cases where the ABS is not operating because of possible faults.

Škoda Fabia and the environment

ŠkodaAuto views the development and manufacture of environmentally friendly products as one of its foremost priorities, and this in all phases of the products' life cycles. In order to fulfil this criterion we have taken the following steps in the manufacture of our Fabia:

We have placed the main emphasis on the use of recycled materials. The parts used in the Fabia are marked according to appropriate standards. This allows their fast identification during disassembly and any subsequent separation of various groups of parts. Construction design of these parts is optimised with regard to their easy and fast disassembly when the vehicle is being dismantled at the end of its life cycle.

We manufacture Škoda vehicles using progressive technologies in the most modern

production facilities which correspond to the highest and strictest criteria. For anti-corrosion protection of the painted part of the vehicle we always and without exception use leadless cathaphoresis (KTL) and waterbased colours.

Cutting the consumption of fuel and emissions is done within the framework of the concern strategy with both petrol and diesel engines. In the area of combustion we achieve lower consumption of fuel by minimising the frictional loss in wheel traction, optimising vehicle aerodynamics, reducing energetic consumption and decreasing the weight of parts and at the same time continuing to meet all of the required parameters. All engines we offer meet the current emission guidelines.

In construction of the vehicle we pay special attention to limiting the possibility of the

escape of service fluids, in the framework of manufacturing of the vehicle, its operation and service. All products of ŠkodaAuto meet the requirements of laws and guidelines for the protection of the environment, both earth and water.

In consequence of using the most modern analytical methods and the follow-up measures, we are also able to decrease noise levels and improve sound quality.

The result of all of these activities is that the Fabia fulfils not only the requirements in the technical area, in safety and quality, but also in the area of protection of the environment. ŠkodaAuto thereby contributes to the preservation of a clean, healthy environment while at the same time guaranteeing the mobility and satisfaction of their customers.

Your Fabia also benefits from a 3 year paint and a 10 year Anti-Perforation warranty. We recommend that the car is serviced and maintained at an authorised Škoda Retailer or Repairer to ensure the warranty cover is maintained. Ask your Škoda retailer for full details of this warranty.

Inclusive AA cover for 3 years

Accessed through a dedicated Freephone number, this free back-up service covers your Fabia for Roadside Assistance, Relay and Relay Plus, Home Start and includes European cover.

Škoda Security

In addition to being fitted with an engine immobiliser, your Fabia will be included in the International Security Register (ISR). This is a free 24 hour owner and mileage checking service available to the police and public. A single phone call can confirm if the person with the vehicle is the owner, deterring thieves. The ISR is registered under the Data Protection Act.
