

Locks to both doors and fuel filler cap. One-piece counterbalanced bonnet with lock-release control operated from inside body. Self-cancelling trafficators controlled from centre of steering wheel. Substantial bumpers at front, chromium plated, matt finish. Twin rear reflectors.

EQUIPMENT INCLUDES: Triplex toughened safety glass fitted to all windows. Instruments grouped in front of driver include: speedometer with trip, ammeter, fuel, water temperature and oil pressure gauges. Concealed facia lighting. Roof light, ignition warning light. 


The driver's cab is roomy and comfortable. The spare wheel is accessible beneath the hinged passenger seat.





ENGINE AND CHASSIS DETAILS

Four cylinders, 85 mm. bore—92 mm. stroke. Capacity 2088 c.c. (two litre). Compression ratio 7-1. Replaceable cylinder sleeves, fitted in direct contact with cooling water. Three-bearing crankshaft. Overhead valves, push rod operation. Thermostatically controlled pump cooling system. Mechanically operated fuel pump. Downdraught carburettor. Air cleaner and silencer (oil bath type for export). Thermostatically controlled hot spot for quick warming.

Clutch: Borg and Beck 9 in. diameter single dry plate. Hydraulically operated. Ball thrust bearing.

Gearbox: Three forward ratios and reverse. Remote control gear change on steering column; lever pointing towards centre of car in both right- and left-hand models.

Suspension: Coil springs for independent suspension at front, long semi-elliptic rear springs specially designed.

Brakes: Lockheed Hydraulic.

Steering: Can be had with either right- or left-hand drive.






ROOMY
