





Head restraints are optional at extra cost.






There's a rugged power unit at work under the bonnet of the Midget—a four-cylinder, 1491-cc, twin carburetter engine with all the power you need for any situation. Backed by a responsive four-speed all-synchromesh gearbox, this outstanding performer is capable of sustained high speed—yet it's virtually maintenance-free and unbelievably miserly on petrol. And there's a full range of read-at-a-glance instrumentation to let you know what's going on under the bonnet, including an impulse tachometer to help with crisp gear changes.

Power like this demands precision controls to match, and MGs have always been renowned for their handling ability. That stylish Vynide covered steering-wheel (it's mounted on an energy absorbing column for extra safety) controls a rack-and-pinion steering assembly second to none. The Midget goes where you point it, and low-slung suspension will get you out of tight corners.

Just as important as power and stability is the ability to come to a very prompt halt when you need to, and here the Midget shines again. Big, competent discs up front and drums at the rear mean confident, fade-free stops.

Practical instrument grouping lets you size up the situation at a glance.








Those full-width polyurethane bumpers have a more important b to do than merely bolstering the Midget's appearance -although they do that handsomely! They're designed to foil the car-park 'nudger' by soaking up low-speed impact, so helping your Midget to keep its good looks.

The bumpers are designed to frame the lights, too, giving protection against flying stones. And speaking of lights, the Midget's electrical system is powered by an alternator, which means goodbye to many winter problems.






Swap weather-proof comfort for fresh air and sunshine whenever you like-the Midget's hood is designed for fast, easy action—up or down.





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A handsome, waterproof tonneau cover is standard equipment on the Midget, but if you really want to set the pace, invest in these stylish options—painted wire wheels for the sporting look, a pair of deeply-padded head restraints and an elegant black hard top to set off any colour scheme.

Specification

ENGINE: Four cylinders, overhead valves; bore 2.90 in (73.7 mm); stroke 3.44 in (87.4 mm); cubic capacity 1491 cc; compression ratio 9.0 : 1.

FUEL SYSTEM: Twin SU type HS4 carburetters; mechanical fuel pump; fuel capacity 7 gallons (31.8 litres).

CLUTCH: Diaphragm-spring type; 7.25 in (0.18 m) diameter.

GEARBOX: Four speed, synchromesh; remote-control gear lever centrally mounted on floor.

REAR AXLE: Three-quarter-floating with hypoid bevel crown wheel and pinion; ratio 3.9:1; overall gear ratios—first 13.34, second 8.26, third 5.6, top 3.9, reverse 14.67:1.

STEERING: Rack and pinion.

SUSPENSIO Front—independent with coil springs, wishbones and anti-roll bar; rear—semi-elliptic leaf springs. Hydraulic shock absorbers front and rear.

BRAKES: Hydraulic, operated by pendant pedal. Dimensions: front 8.25 in (209 mm) diameter disc; rear 7 in (178 mm) diameter drum with leading and trailing shoes.

WHEELS AND TYRES: Pressed-steel, Rostyle wheels with 145—13 radial-ply tyres.

ELECTRICAL: 12-volt, 40-amp-hr. capacity battery at 20-hour rate; twin rear number-plate lamps; warning lamps to indicate flashers working, no charge and headlamps high-beam position; twin horns; single lever on steering-column controls headlamp flasher, dip-switch and self-cancelling flashers; hazard warning lamps; twin reversing lamps; combined ignition/starter switch incorporates steering-column lock.

INSTRUMENTS: Speedometer with trip and total mileage recorder; fuel gauge; combined oil pressure and water temperature gauges; electric tachometer.

BODYWORK: Tw. door, two-seater sports car of all-steel mono-construction. Curved, zone-toughened glass windscreen. Wind-down door windows with hinged ventilators. Adjustable seats with rakeadjusting squabs. Seat wearing surfaces upholstered in knit-backed expanded vinyl. Factory-fitted static seat belts. Each door is fitted with a recessed internal release lever and has external push-button handles and locks. Integral vinyl-coated fabric hood with cover. Interior rear-view anti-dazzle mirror. Twin door mirrors. Tonneau cover. Polyurethane bumpers front and rear. Windscreen washer. Fresh-air heater.




