
Spirit of travel


With home comforts in a practical vehicle, the journey suddenly became as exciting as the destination. It unleashed a new spirit of travel – as strong today as it was in those early days.

Sixties icon

A big success throughout the 1950s, Volkswagen's camper van achieved iconic status throughout the 1960s and 1970s when it became synonymous with the anti-establishment, hippie lifestyle. n the road, the California's neat dimensions and independent rear suspension make it feel car-like compared to some of its rivals. The bracing under the floor of the vehicle gives it a composed ride, perfect for sweeping country roads.

Powerful, efficient engines

The choice of efficient 2.0-litre TDI engines provide plenty of pulling power for low-speed manoeuvres and strong, refined performance at motorway speeds. They're efficient, too, with the 140PS 2.0TDI – available on the California SE and California Beach – returning up to 39.2mpg (combined).

Go-anywhere driving

Those MPV-like dimensions and torquey engines also mean that the California makes sense around town. It's easy to drive and you can go about your business as normal. There's no need to avoid narrow roads in historic towns, or spend time hunting for extra-large parking spaces. 



BlueMotion Technology is available on the California Beach and is made up of four clever elements. Together, they make significant reductions in fuel consumption and CO₂ emissions, which keeps money in your pocket and reduces the impact on the world around us. Here, you can learn more about these elements and what they do.



Start/stop

Start/stop allows you to save fuel at traffic lights. When you stop, put vour California Beach in neutral, release the clutch and the engine automatically switches off, saving fuel and reducing emissions. When you're ready to go, depress the clutch and the engine starts up again.

Regenerative braking

When braking, energy during deceleration is wasted. Our energy recuperation system uses some of that momentum to turn the alternator and charge the battery. If the battery is well-charged, the engine has to do less work turning the alternator to keep it topped up. This cuts fuel use and emissions.

Simple, tasty meals prepared in your California SE, in your own time. Indoors or out, food will never taste so good

hether it's a delicious breakfast for two, or a family feast at the end of a fun-packed day, the California SE's fully fitted kitchen is equipped to create memorable meal times.

Purpose-built design

Thanks to the thoughtful, purpose-built design, the California SE has plenty of storage space for pans, dishes and food. There's useful preparation space, too. Either use the sliding table or, if you need more room, the glass worktop covering the hob.

For items that need to be kept cool, there's a 42-litre fridge – perfect for milk, salad, fruit and juice – while fresh water is also on tap from the 30-litre water tank with electric pump. The digital control panel situated above the rear-view mirror allows you to keep an eye on the fridge temperature and water levels. Around the cabin there's also four useful 12V sockets.

All that's left is to fire up the two-burner gas hob and you'll soon have a delicious meal on the go.

Indoors – or out

The California SE's practical efficiency extends to the table and chairs that are stowed neatly into the tailgate and sliding door. Simply extend the awning to create an outdoor area for alfresco dining.

And, if it's a bit chilly, swivel the front seats and slide back the rear bench to create a warm, inviting and sociable setting. There you have it: the recipe for a perfect, self-sufficient adventure in the great outdoors.

Eating out

Thanks to the California's folding furniture you can eat inside or out. The large table is stored in the side door, while the chairs stow neatly in the tailgate. Yet another illustration of how the California's purpose-built design has resulted in practical and efficient features.

Stylish storage

Inside, the California boasts a range of clever space-saving solutions. These storage cupboards feature attractive rounded edges and smooth curves rather than sharp edges. They're well-built, too, so they won't rattle or squeak when you're on the road.

Downstairs, the innovative rail system means that the bench seat can be smoothly moved to the rear, where it can be folded and converted into a bed measuring 1.14m x 2.0m in the California SE, or 1.55m x 2.1m in the two-seat bench version of the California Beach.

...and upstairs

In the California SE, the electrically operated aluminium roof rises at the push of a button, while the California Beach has a manual pop-up system.

The spacious upper berth has a double bed on sprung slats measuring 1.2m x 2.0m. There's plenty of room to sit up in bed, and a reading light on the California SE.

Thanks to the programmable heater – fitted as standard on the California SE, available as an option on the California Beach – you can sleep in your California all year round. And, at night, you can gaze at the stars through the windows in the spacious upper sleeping area, or zip up the blinds to stay private and snug.
