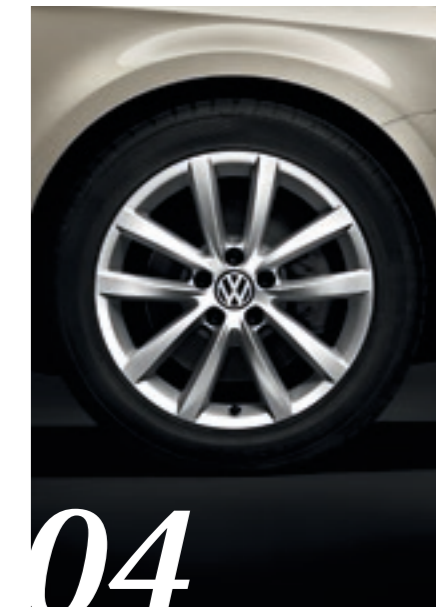

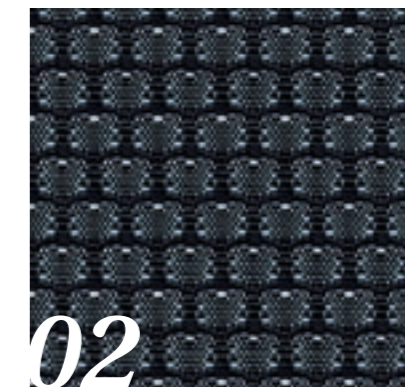

- 01** The **aerodynamic design** of the Passat BlueMotion helps reduce the vehicle's air resistance and, combined with Volkswagen's BlueMotion Technologies, low rolling resistance tyres and lowered suspension help produce exceptional economy. Image shown features optional 17 inch 'Buenos Aires' alloy wheels, front fog lights, Bi-xenon headlights and 'Island Grey' pearl effect paint.
- 02** The stylish interior of the Passat BlueMotion in '**Blue Merlin/Titan Black**' cloth upholstery adds that extra touch of individuality.
- 03** The unique '**BlueMotion**' badge at the rear symbolises its environmental credentials. For more information on BlueMotion and BlueMotion Technologies, please see pages 22-23.
- 04** The **multifunction computer** provides useful statistics about your journey, such as exterior temperature, average and current fuel consumption, average speed and estimated distance to refuelling. It also includes a visual gear change recommendation for improved fuel consumption.

The BlueMotion offers impressive environmental credentials by intelligently refining existing technology. Dynamic lines reduce the vehicle's air resistance and, combined with engineering refinements, rear boot spoiler on Saloon models, lowered suspension and battery regeneration (recuperation – energy recovery during braking) help produce exceptional economy. A Start/Stop function automatically stops the engine when the vehicle is stationary, in neutral and the clutch released and informs you by displaying a symbol on the multifunction computer, then cleverly restarts it when you depress the clutch to select first gear. The result is improved fuel savings and reduced emissions.

## The Passat BlueMotion.



The Passat Executive offers an impressive level of comfort and luxury, with many impressive features fitted as standard, including 'Vienna' leather upholstery\*, a Driver Alert system which detects and then warns, the driver of fatigue and Bluetooth telephone connection for HFP (Hands Free Profile) enabled phones.

**01** Luxurious 'Vienna' leather upholstery\* is not only sumptuous, it also has the practicality of being easy to clean, and is durable and hard wearing. The front seats are also heated for extra comfort during the cold weather.

**02** The RNS 315 touch-screen navigation/DAB radio system with MP3 compatible CD player features eight speakers, crystal clear digital audio broadcasts, a 5 inch colour display with clearly arranged map navigation, as well as an SD card reader and practical AUX-in socket for connecting external audio devices such as an iPod or MP3 player.

**03** Parking sensors make parking manoeuvres less challenging by emitting an audible warning, alerting the driver to any obstacles in the way: the closer you are to an obstacle the faster the sound frequency. ## The Passat Executive Style.



The Passat Executive Style builds over the impressive array of features of the Executive, with excellent exterior features such as 18 inch 'Kansas' alloy wheels, Bi-xenon headlights, front fog lights and heat insulating tinted glass, giving the Executive Style its own stylish identity.

**01** The robust **matt chrome effect underbody protection** gives the Passat Estate Alltrack's front and rear its distinctive, purist off-road design, and when you choose the 2.0 TDI 177 PS DSG engine, twin chrome exhaust tailpipes complete the rugged style. (Double tailpipes on 2.0 TDI 140 PS.) Uneven ground or urban parking space, parking sensors both front and rear provide driver confidence whatever the manoeuvre.

**02** The Passat Estate Alltrack with intelligent **4MOTION four wheel drive** as standard, distributes power to all four wheels as required and ensures optimum traction.

**03** **Anthracite wheel arch protection**, side sill protection in anthracite and matt chrome effect and the structural design of the **18 inch 'Canyon' alloy wheels** with 225/45 R18 ContiSeal (self-sealing) tyres make each, and every one of your trips, even more stylish.

**04** The Passat Estate Alltrack is instantly recognisable by its **'Gloss Black' radiator grille with matt chrome louvres**, as well as matt chrome detailing on front fog light surrounds, door mirrors, roof rails, window surrounds and underbody protection. **05** The 2.0 litre TDI 177 PS DSG engine features **XDS, an extension of the well-known Electronic Differential Lock (EDL) function**. # The Passat Estate Alltrack.

The Passat Estate Alltrack comes with the addition of four wheel drive 4MOTION and increased ground clearance giving it greater agility off-road, while body enhancements provide some protection from scrapes when covering rough terrain. Inside, a tyre pressure monitoring system alerts you of any change in tyre pressure. These features endow the Passat Estate Alltrack with the practicality of an estate car and much of the versatility of a conventional SUV.

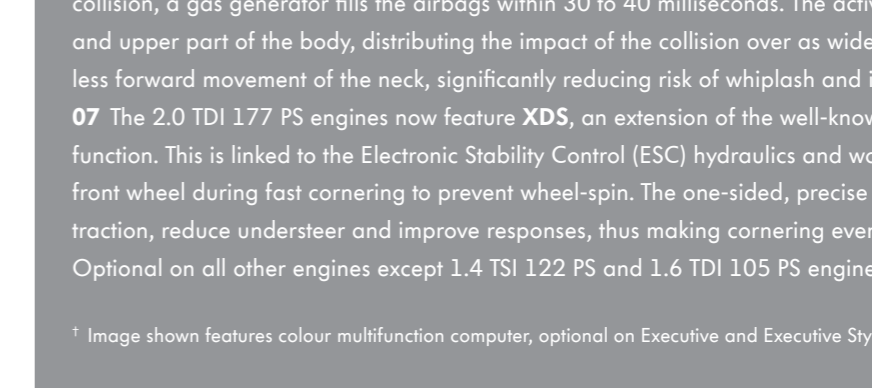
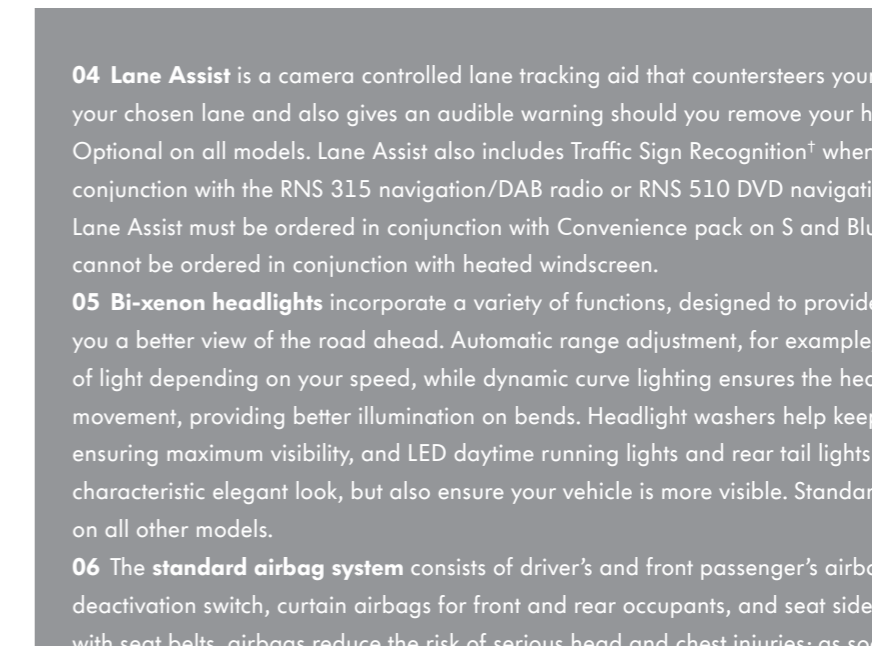
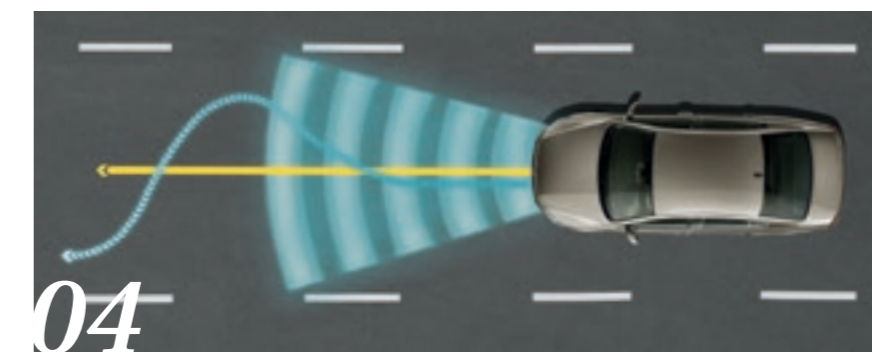


**01** Driver fatigue is a major cause of road accidents, accounting for up to 20% of serious accidents on monotonous roads, such as motorways, in Great Britain. Fatigue related crashes are often more severe than others because the driver's reaction times are delayed or they have failed to make any manoeuvres to avoid a crash. With these facts in mind, Volkswagen has developed the **Driver Alert system** which gives an early warning of when you need to take a break on long and tiring journeys, making motorway driving safer. The system works by monitoring driver behaviour closely, noting any erratic steering wheel movements and lane deviations. If the system detects an erratic or unusual driving pattern, it will alert you with a visual display on the dashboard and an audible warning sound, and if you haven't taken a break within 15 minutes, it will repeat the warnings. The Driver Alert system is just one of a number of Volkswagen's innovative driver assistance systems, designed to make driving easier, more comfortable and, above all, safer. Standard on Executive, Executive Style and Alltrack models. Optional on all other models as part of cruise control or as part of Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC) on S models.

**02** The **Electronic Stability Control (ESC)** recognises critical driving situations and reacts in milliseconds by targeting brake and management systems, controlling the speed of individual wheels and helping to bring the vehicle under control. As a result the vehicle achieves maximum directional stability. Standard on all models.

**03** Optional **Side scan** makes motorway driving safer by helping to prevent accidents when you want to change lanes. The radar system monitors the areas to the left and right of the car and up to 50 metres behind it, and should it detect a potentially hazardous situation, it warns you by means of flashing warning lights in the door mirror housing. Optional on all models. Side scan must be ordered in conjunction with Convenience pack on S and BlueMotion models.

The activated airbags then cushion the head and upper part of the body, distributing the impact of the collision over as wide an area as possible and ensuring less forward movement of the neck, significantly reducing risk of whiplash and injury.

**07** The 2.0 TDI 177 PS engines now feature **XDS**, an extension of the well-known Electronic Differential Lock (EDL) function. This is linked to the Electronic Stability Control (ESC) hydraulics and works by applying pressure to the inner front wheel during fast cornering to prevent wheel-spin. The one-sided, precise brake pressure helps to maximise traction, reduce understeer and improve responses, thus making cornering even more sporty, safe and accurate. Optional on all other engines except 1.4 TSI 122 PS and 1.6 TDI 105 PS engines.

Now, Volkswagen are building on this established reputation with a range of highly innovative, technological advancements, designed to meet your every expectation, and make a real difference in terms of quality, refinement and luxury. The latest TDI engines, for example, are equipped with common rail technology, ensuring high torque along with low fuel consumption. TSI petrol engines follow the downsizing principle, using low capacity, highly sophisticated turbocharging and precise direct injection to deliver maximum power and exceptional fuel economy. When utilised with BlueMotion Technologies such as the Start/Stop function, which momentarily switches off the engine when the vehicle is stationary and in neutral and starts it again as you depress the clutch and battery regeneration, which recuperates energy under braking and acceleration to boost the alternator – both fuel consumption and CO<sub>2</sub> emissions are further reduced dramatically.

**01** TDI are three letters that have acquired legendary significance, symbolising high torque, low consumption and quiet performance. TDI diesel engines utilise common rail technology and are fitted with a Diesel Particulate Filter (DPF) which filters out exhaust elements that are harmful to the environment, significantly reducing diesel emissions as a result.

**02** Volkswagen's technologically advanced TSI engines combine excellent driveability with impressive fuel economy. The combination of direct fuel injection and intelligent turbocharging technology allows petrol engines with TSI technology to work particularly efficiently, offering such advantages as high performance, high torque and reduced fuel consumption.

**03** Externally, Volkswagen's 'BlueMotion' and 'BlueMotion Technology' badging identifies the cleanest, most energy-efficient cars in our range. So when you see this badge you'll know we're talking about ways to cut emissions and the cost of your motoring.

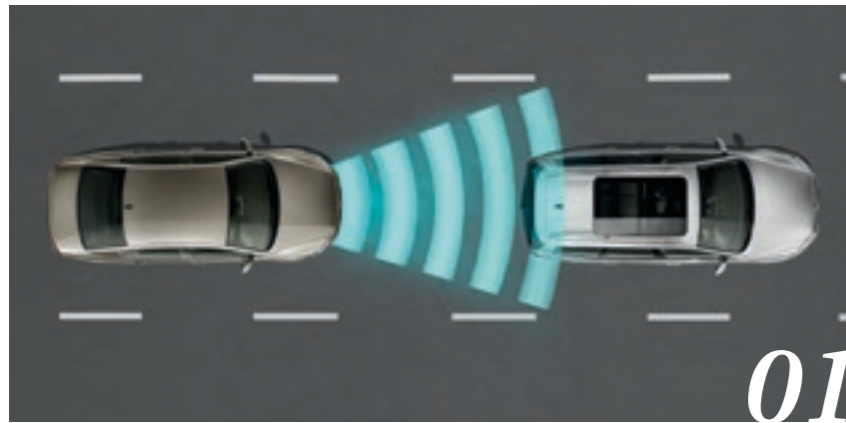

**01 Adaptive Cruise Control (ACC)** and the radar sensor controlled Front Assist system adapt your speed to that of the vehicle ahead and maintain a constant distance set by the driver. If Front Assist detects you are getting too close to the vehicle in front, it will warn you in two stages: visually and acoustically, and will then automatically start braking, to a standstill if necessary. Optional on all models except BlueMotion. S models include **Driver Alert system**.

**02 The Keyless entry system** enables you to enter your vehicle and even start the engine using a button in the centre console, without taking the key out of your pocket. **04 Bi-xenon headlights** feature dynamic curve lighting and automatic range adjustment providing better illumination of the road ahead, on bends and when turning. **05 Volkswagen's Park Assist system** has long made parallel parking significantly easier. However, this system combines conventional Park Assist with the added functionality of reverse parking into a space at 90° to the kerb. The driver activates the system by pressing a button on the centre console. Using ultrasonic parking sensors, Park Assist will detect a large enough parking space for either reverse or parallel parking and the assisted parking process can begin. Having put the vehicle into reverse, all the driver has to do is operate the accelerator, clutch and brake, while keeping a good lookout.

The Passat then takes care of the steering into its chosen space. Further improvements mean Park Assist can now parallel park in particularly small spaces only 0.8m longer than the vehicle. Optional on all models.

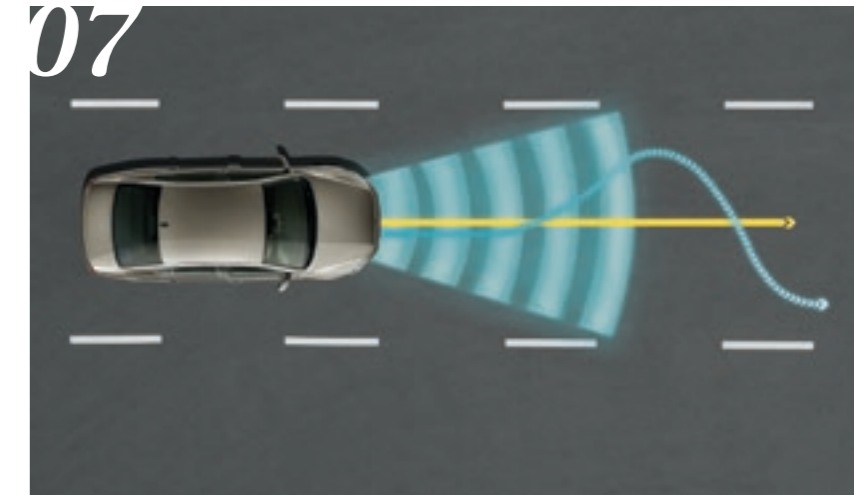

- Oil change service – After 1 year or 10,000 miles (15,000km), whichever is soonest.
- Inspection service<sup>2</sup> – First after 2 years or 20,000 miles (30,000km), then every one year or 20,000 miles (30,000km), whichever is soonest.

The Flexible Service is recommended for vehicles with daily mileage of more than 25 miles where the vehicle is driven regularly mainly on longer distance journeys. The vehicle is driven mainly at a constant speed with minimum vehicle and engine loading, minimal towing and driven in an economical manner. With the Flexible Service the vehicle can cover anywhere between 10,000<sup>3</sup> and a maximum of 20,000<sup>3</sup> miles or 24 months (whichever is soonest) between oil changes.
