SPACE AND COMFORT


The headlamp interlock system reduces the chance of a flat battery from leaving your headlamps on by automatically switching them off with the ignition.

combines the precision of rack-and-pinion steering with the smoothness of the recirculating ball system, takes all the effort out of driving.


Braking is positive due to power assisted front disc brakes. The proven suspension system provides road holding and handling which, even under adverse conditions, are unsurpassed

The problem with Australia's climate is that it can be so temperamental. On a given day it can be unbearable, then the temperature can change several degrees.



Mitsubishi's filtered air recirculation system provides clean air all year round. Since it's fully integrated the temperature inside your Sigma can be fine-tuned quickly and accurately.

Unlike cheaper after-market systems a Genuine Mitsubishi Motors Air-conditioner is manufactured to exacting standards to deliver maximum performance, especially in very hot weather, without overloading the engine.

Genuine Mitsubishi Air-conditioning incorporates a special solenoid which adjusts the engine idle speed to eliminate the risk of stalling while stationary with the air-conditioning running.


TOW BAR: Available with flush or surface mounted electrical connectors this is the only Tow Bar designed and approved by Mitsubishi for your Sigma.



INSECT SCREEN: Easily installed or removed for cleaning, the screen prevents insects clogging the radiator or air-conditioning condenser.




MUD FLAPS: Protect your Sigma's paintwork from mud, slush and debris.
