Audi has always used the letter S to denote its unrelenting quest for sportiness, whether in Motorsport or in series production. The mighty Audi S1 was the forefather of all S models and became one of the most successful rally cars of all time, even winning the notorious 'Pikes Peak' race in Colorado three times in succession.

Continuing this impressive pedigree, the new Audi S6 now represents the pinnacle of the A6 range. From first impressions to lasting reality, the new S6 is undoubtedly an extraordinary vehicle, offering a driving experience beyond compare.

Beneath the bonnet of the S6 breathes a potent 5.2-litre V10 FSI direct fuel injection engine. This is the first time in Audi's history that a V10 engine has been used in a production saloon and its massive 320kW of power and 540Nm of torque are available all the way from 3,000 – 4,000 rpm. The S6 offers a superb blend of unparalleled power and refinement in abundance, accelerating from 0 – 100kmh in just 5.2 seconds, reaching a governed top speed of 250 kmh.

The S6 has been developed with Audi's new quattro® permanent all-wheel drive system with asymmetric/dynamic torque split. An integrated Torsen centre differential distributes power to the front and rear of the car at a ratio of 40:60. At any given moment, up to 85 percent of the available power can be diverted to the rear wheels, and up to 65 percent to the front wheels thanks to this dynamic new system. The result is instant traction, precise handling and improved safety when you need it most.

The refined sports appeal of the S6 is elegant yet retains a touch of aggression. It is unmistakably sporty, yet still contemporary. The eye-catching Audi single frame grille with aluminium-look double vertical struts and S6 badge give the face of the S6 a very dynamic expression. The front bumper is a pioneering development in terms of road safety and style, and the design also features a stunning horizontal array of five LED daytime running lights which illuminate the face of the S6 to create a distinctive character exclusive to this model.
