Padded dash and full width sun-visors.



11 transistor manual or push button radio, entertainment and added relaxation while you drive. Power aerial, no outside adjustment is necessary, a fingertip control does it all. Laminated window, minimizes risk of stone

breakage. Also available with a tinted upper area to reduce summer glare and Power operated windows,

with individual fingertip controls on each door and a master control on driver's door to operate all windows. Floor console automatic gear shift, for those who prefer a floor change. (Available only with bucket seats fitted.) Special instrumentation,

containing tachometer,

water temperature gauges. (Fitment deletes clock.) Heavy duty front and rear springs, a worthwhile consideration for boat and caravan owners, also farmers who frequently travel over rough roads. Superlift rear shock absorbers, can be adjusted with compressed air, like your tyres, to match towing loads. Limited Slip Differential, makes light work of mud. sand and snow. Transfers power to the wheel with traction, not the one that's bogged. A must if you tow a boat.
