Holden Monaro LS. For 'LS' read luxury/sport. And believe it. Your first impression will be of something very good-looking, very long, very low. With a pure thoroughbred line enhanced by four headlamps, a vinyl roof, and true coune styling.

Then open the door on an interior that couldn't be described as anything less than opulent. Supremely comfortable, supremely roomy, reclining front buckets richly upholstered in leather-grain vinyl (or with optional Royal Cord cloth trim

Luxurious loop pile carpet stretches from wall to wall. Full length luxury arm rests stretch along the doors. In front of you, a handsome burl walnut finish instrument panel. Behind you, the subtlety of a tinted rear window.

And a special luxury—flow-thru ventilation. Weather and noise are locked out, while fresh air flows through the car from individually controlled vents, to secret exit valves behind the doors Plus an 'airmix' heating/demisting system that allows fingertip warmth-control. But luxury is only one side of the Monaro 'LS' character. It stands steady on wheels a full five feet apart. With a big coil spring by every one of them to give you a 'iet-smooth' ride. And a front chassis frame with eight thick rubber mounts. So Monaro 'LS' has the silent smoothness of a big car, yet remains a delight to handle. And forwardmounted steering holds 'LS' tracking straight and true, even on rough surfaces.



Beneath the international 2 door style there's Australian strength, from a powerful '202' sixcylinder engine, to a choice of 3 supersmooth V8's—the 185 hp (138 kW) '253', 240 hp (179 kW) '308' and 275 hp (205 kW) '350' Transmissions range from 3 or 4 speed manuals, to 3-speed Tri-matic automatic transmission (Turbo - hydramatic on '350').
