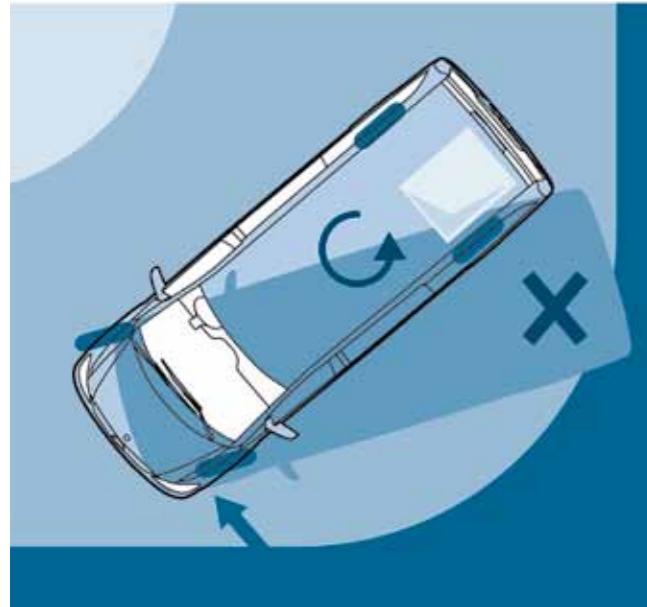

As you'd expect, world-class safety technology is built into every Mercedes-Benz Sprinter. We were the first to equip our vans with comprehensive safety features such as Electronic Stability Program (ESP®) and a range of additional airbag options.



ADAPTIVE ESP®

Our ADAPTIVE ESP® is standard on all Sprinters, so you can stay on the straight and narrow, no matter what sort of road conditions you run into. As does ABS braking (It should, we invented it), 16 inch wheels and four wheel disc brakes.

All of which is concealed within a high-strength, safety cell that is designed to absorb impact and transfer it away from the driver and passenger.

Every Mercedes-Benz Sprinter is fitted with a driver's airbag as standard with the option of including a passenger airbag, side window airbags and thorax airbags.

Even the smaller details are carefully designed to contribute to a safer journey. Bi-Xenon headlights don't just show the way clearly with extra illumination at the sides, they have an automatic adjustment to prevent oncoming traffic from being dazzled.

Electric mirrors

Heated electric mirrors incorporate a wide angle lens and indicators to allow excellent all round visibility, helping to improve safety in all weather conditions.



Cruise control with SPEEDTRONIC – variable speed limiter

Cruise control allows the driver to set a desired cruising speed. SPEEDTRONIC assists driver in adhering to speed limits by setting a maximum speed.



ADAPTIVE ESP®

The ADAPTIVE ESP® Electronic Stability Program helps ensure your vehicle remains steady and on course even when the road surface or your load changes.



Driver airbag

When triggered, the airbag deploys within fractions of a second and in conjunction with the seatbelt pretensioners, helps provide a high level of protection.



Adjustable steering wheel

The steering wheel is adjustable for both height and reach. This helps ensure the most comfortable position can be achieved by drivers of all heights.



Remote central locking

This allows for convenient and easy access to the vehicle and helps provide maximum security and peace of mind.



Entrance assist handles

The passenger airbag, window airbags and thorax airbags provide a comprehensive level of protection and greater peace of mind.



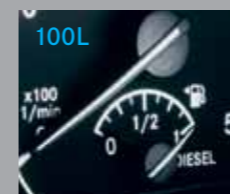
Swivel seats

Long range fuel tank

A 100-litre fuel tank is available to help extend the operating range, meaning fewer fuel stops and more time exploring.



PARKTRONIC (Van models only)

PARKTRONIC is a highly advanced system that helps make parking even easier. Visual and audio warnings are provided upon detection of obstacles at the front and the rear.



Heavy duty stabilisation for high bodies (Chassis models only)

This modified suspension package has been designed by our engineers for vehicles that have a higher than normal centre of gravity (like a Motorhome) to help reduce body roll and improve stability.

Which transmission do you prefer?

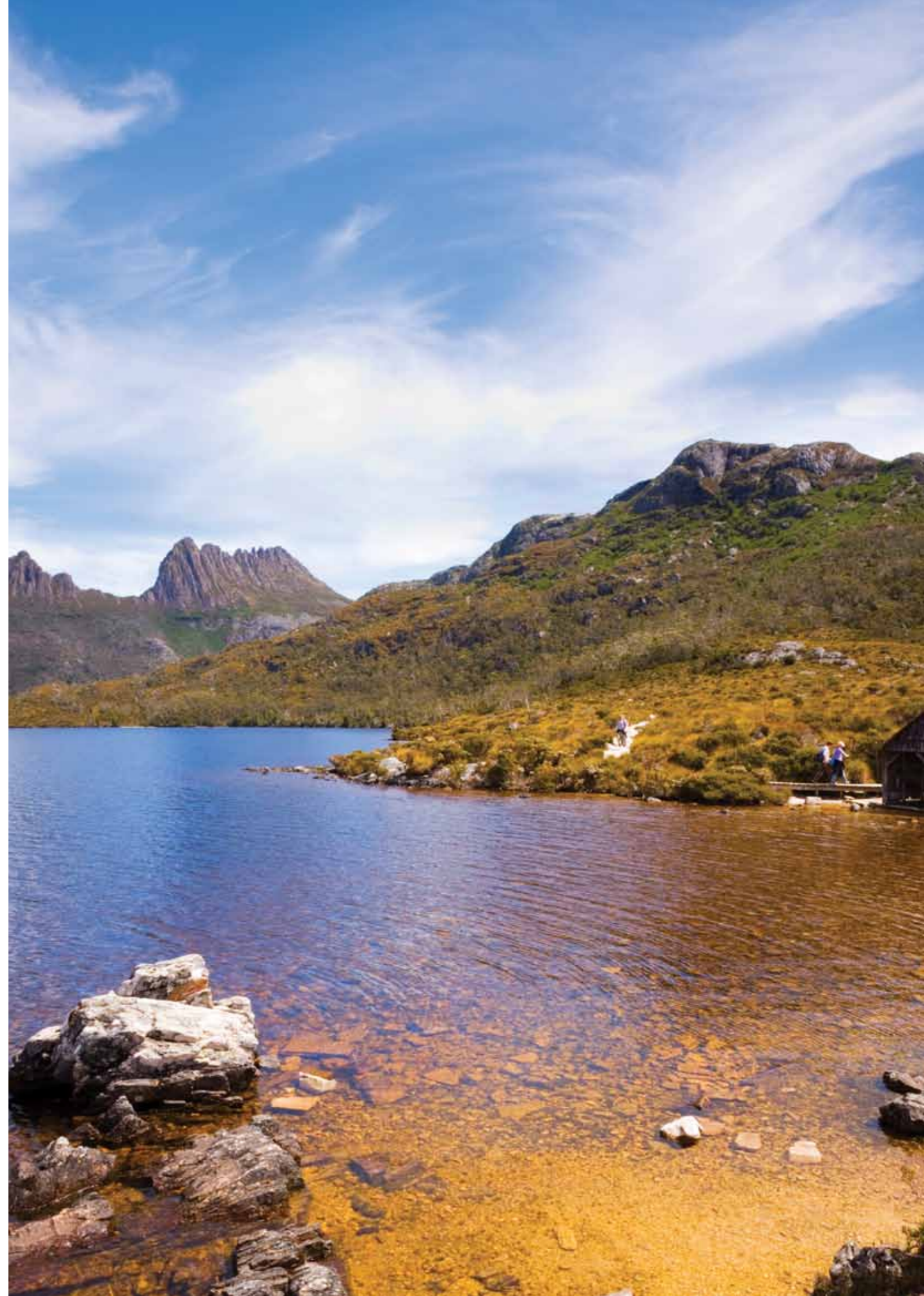
- Six speed manual
