For 1982, Starlet retains all the sound, sensible features that have been refined over years of development and proved in millions of owner-driven miles worldwide.

The new Starlet's peppy 1.3 liter 4-cylinder engine is designed and built for reliability and maximum fuel efficiency. Its 5-speed overdrive transmission lowers engine rpm in high gear to provide greater fuel

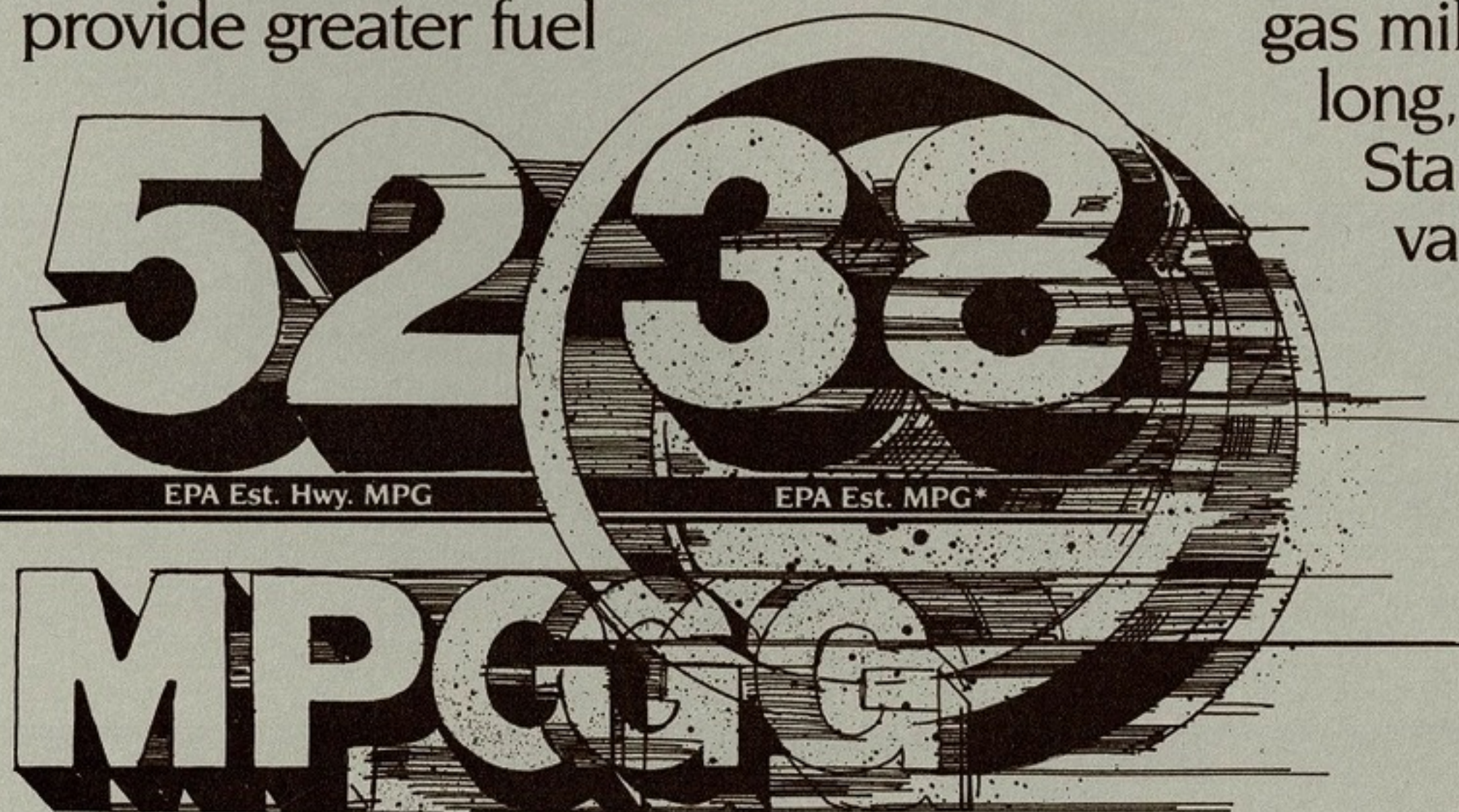
efficiency and to reduce engine wear.

Starlet has power-assisted front disc brakes for fade-resisting stopping, and is standard-equipped with steel-belted radial tires for sure-footed roadability.

Rack-and-pinion steering provides responsive handling for better driving control. MacPherson strut suspension with coil springs helps provide a smoother ride. Starlet's body design includes rounded corners and a rear roof lip that properly directs the airflow to help improve mileage even more.

And to further help lower the cost of ownership, Starlet also provides a number of maintenance-reducing features, including a self-adjusting clutch and rust-inhibiting front fender liners.

Small can be beautiful, too. Starlet's clean-lined shape, highlighted by handsome grille and taillight styling, is enhanced by styled steel wheels, sporty side stripes, and dramatic new color choices for 1982. From its exceptional gas mileage and durable design, to its long, long list of standard features, Starlet adds up to incomparable value for 1982.

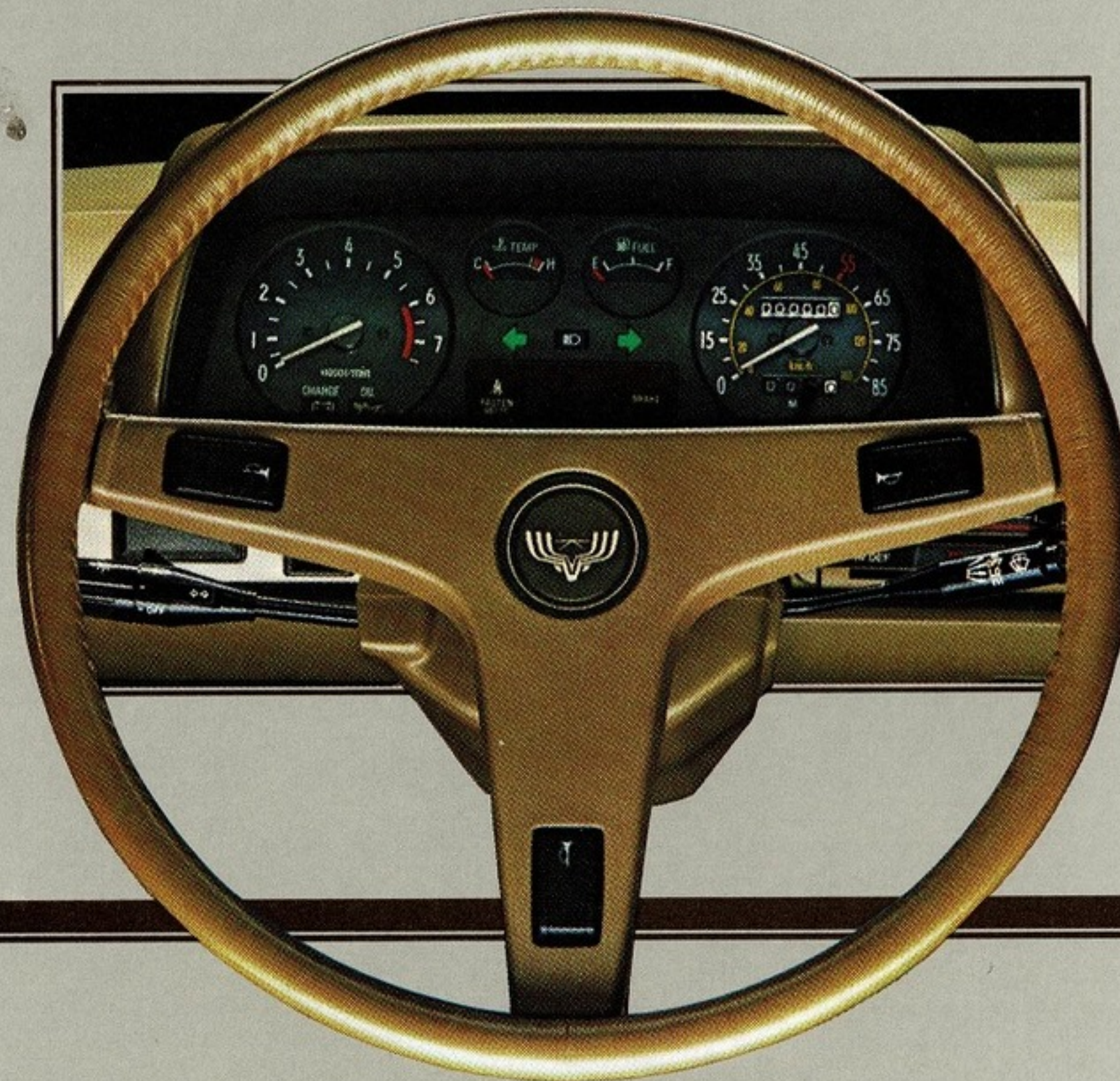
Loading luggage or groceries is made easy by Starlet's wide-opening rear door with its twist-lock release. Want still more cargo area? Flip down

## STARLET FEATURES & OPTIONS

Like every Toyota, the 1982 Starlet boasts a long list of standard features. Included are power-booster Flo-thru ventilation, side window demisters and an electric rear window defogger. Also included are steering column-mounted lighting and windshield wiper controls; you can turn the headlights or parking lights on or off, flash the high beams, and control the windshield washer and wiper cycles—all without moving your hands far from the steering wheel. For security, there's an inside hood release. To help keep maintenance down, Starlet has a transistorized ignition system (no points to adjust), a self-adjusting clutch, an electric engine cooling fan, and a low maintenance battery.

Most of what you want in a car is already built into your new Starlet, but you can still tailor Starlet to your lifestyle with options like air conditioning, rear window wiper/washer or a stereo sound system. 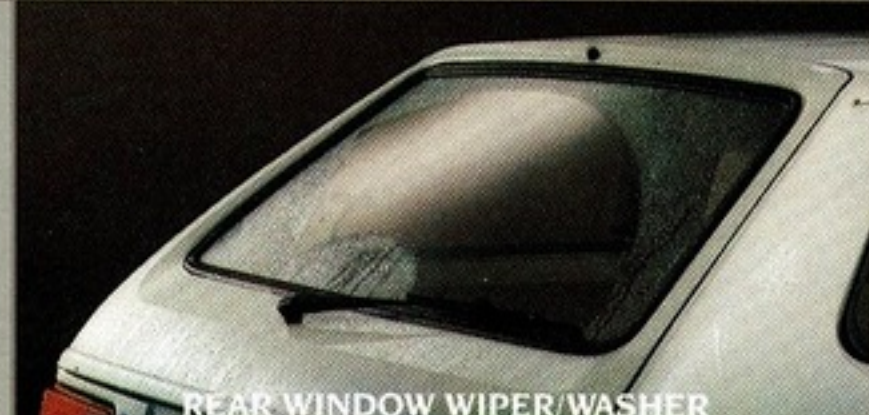
