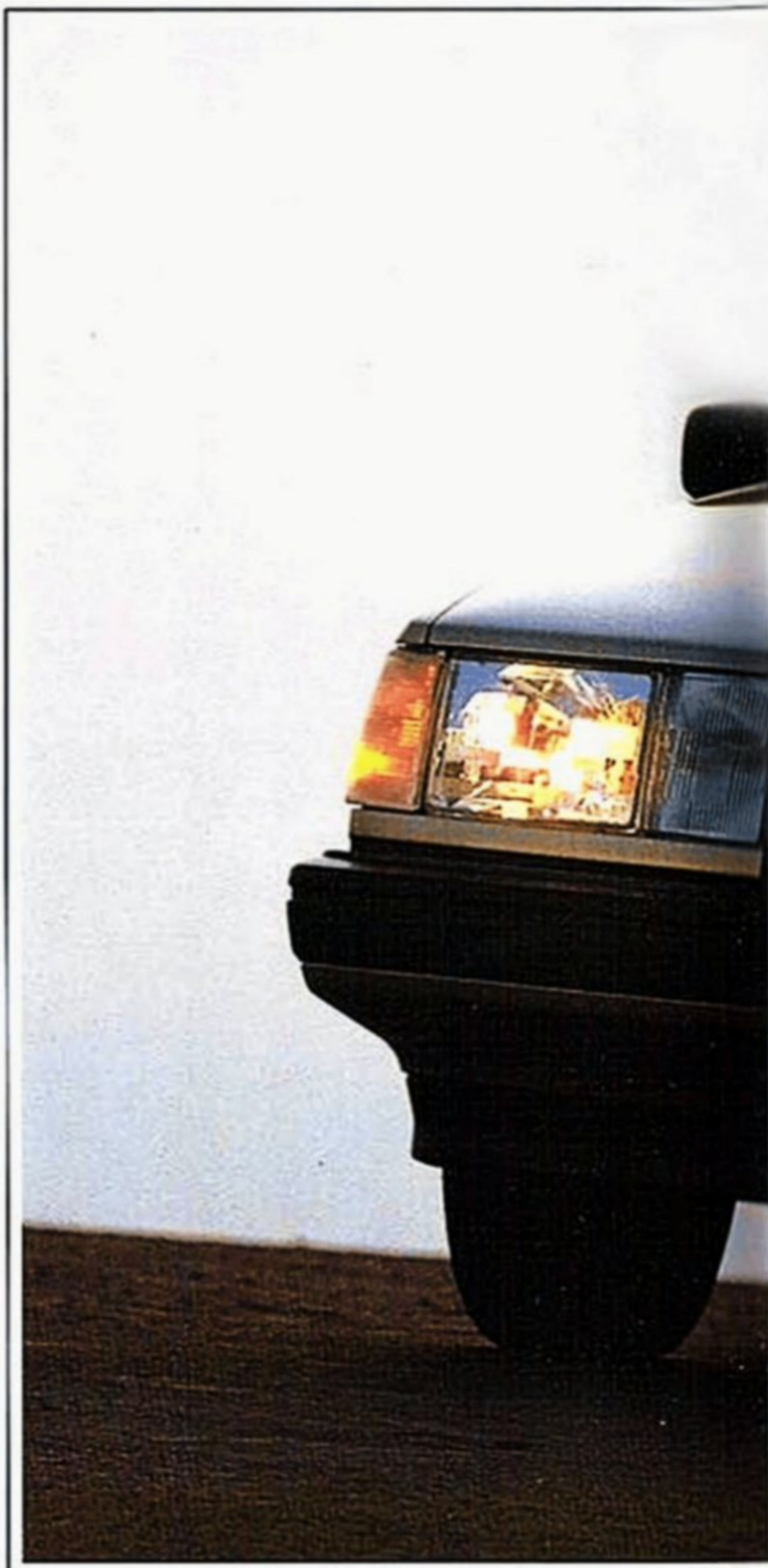

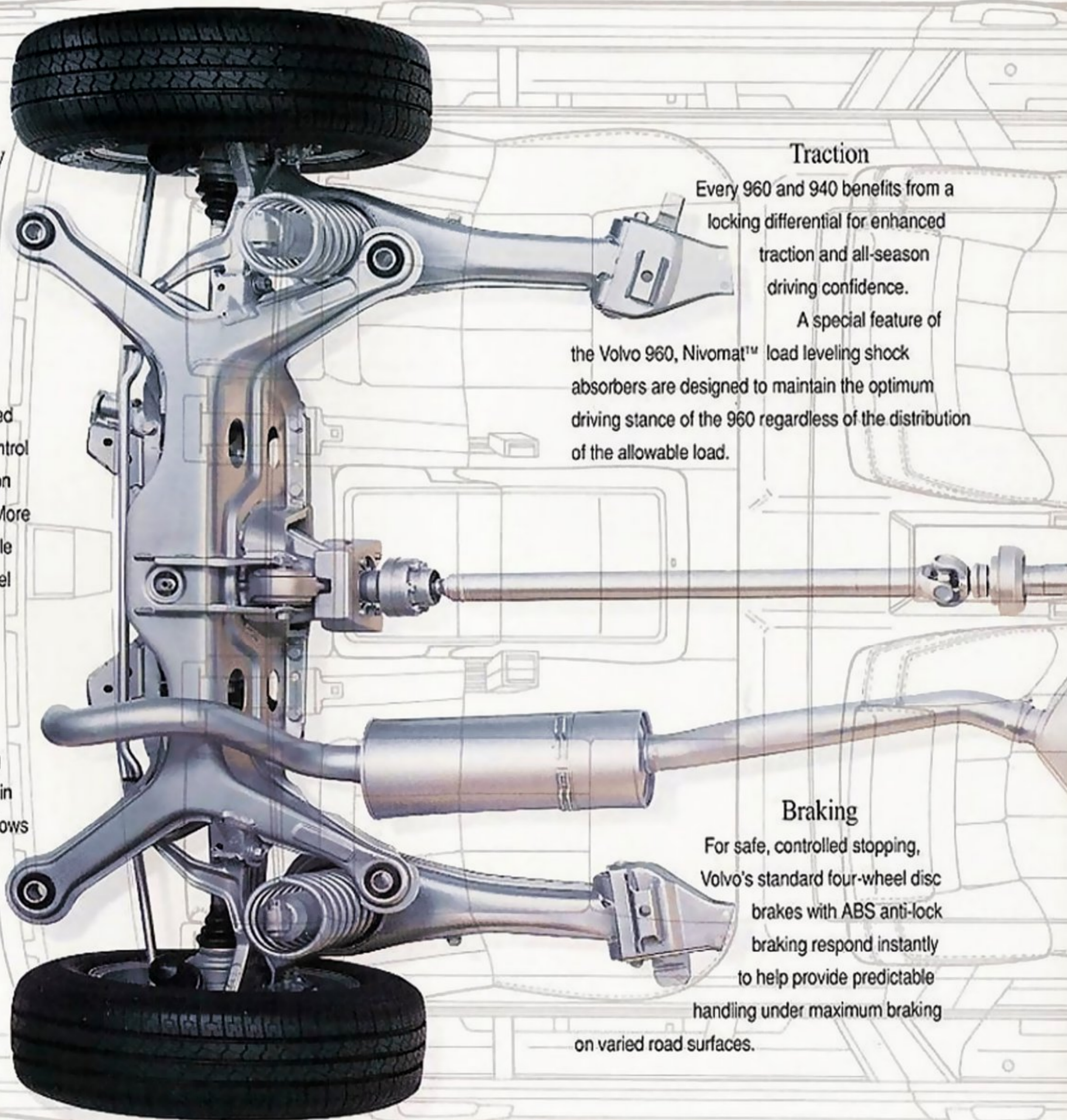

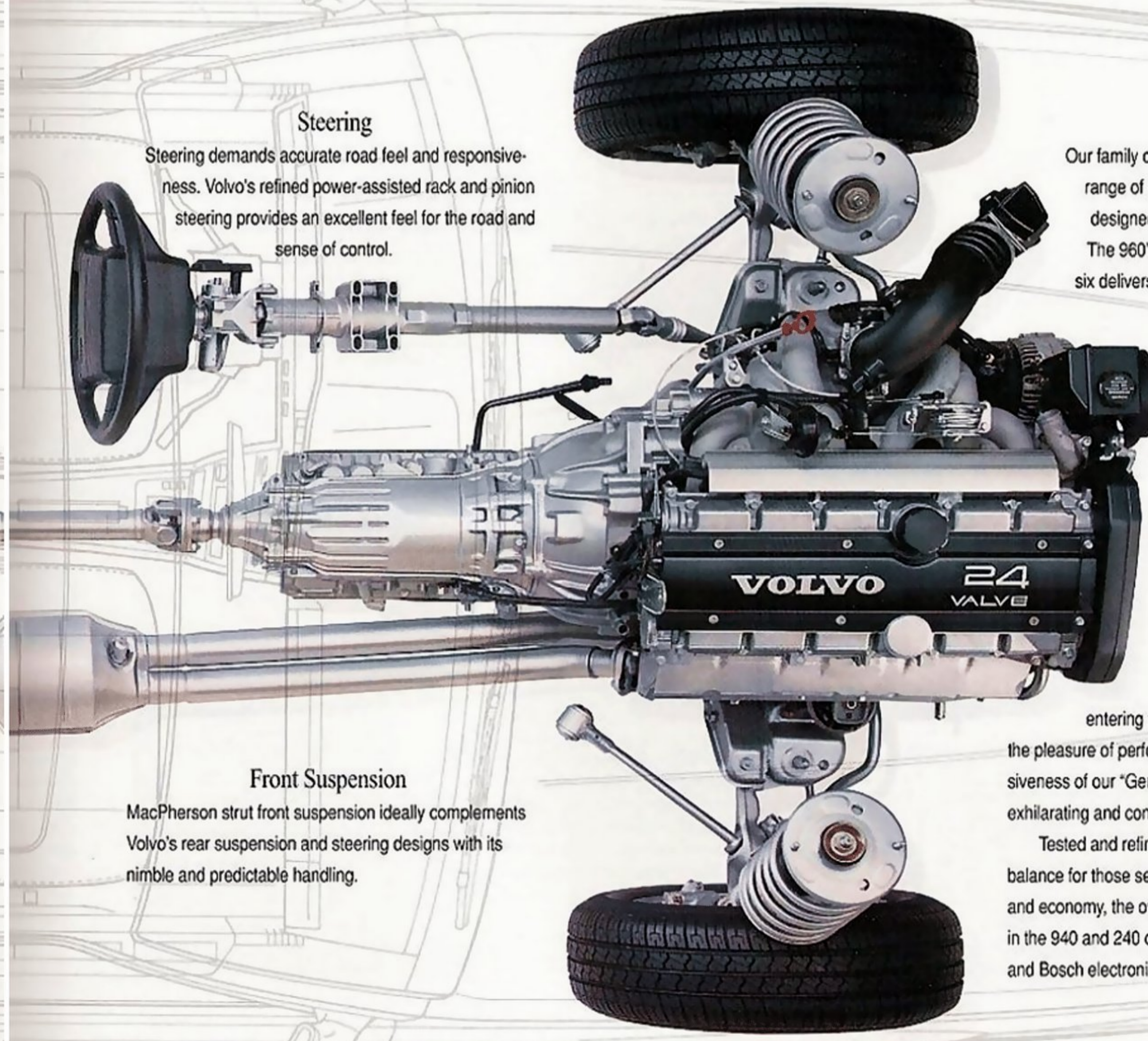

Volvo defines these two cornerstones of occupant protection engineering as Dynamic Safety - the ability to avoid a collision, and Passive Safety - the ability to prevent injury resulting from a collision.

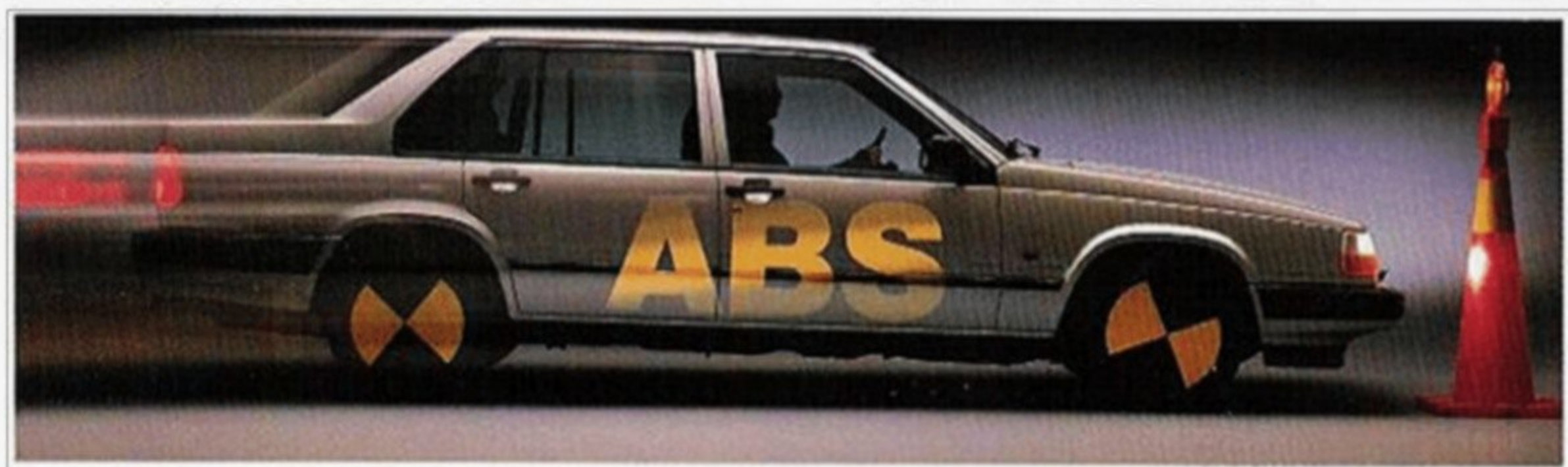
Certainly the best way to prevent accident related injury is to avoid the accident. Four-wheel power disc brakes with ABS, standard on all Volvos, equips the driver with exceptional stopping power and enhanced vehicle control during maximum braking. ABS helps assure controlled stopping, even when braking hard on a slippery road surface.



Predictability plays a crucial role in sound dynamic safety design. A vehicle that responds with sure-footed consistency gains the driver's confidence and sharpens the driver's ability to

react effectively when the unexpected occurs.

Volvo's power assisted rack & pinion steering faithfully communicates the feel of the road. MacPherson struts deliver precision tracking while complementing the reflexes of the rear suspension. The result is a nimble, responsive road car that confidently responds to driver input with reassuring consistency.



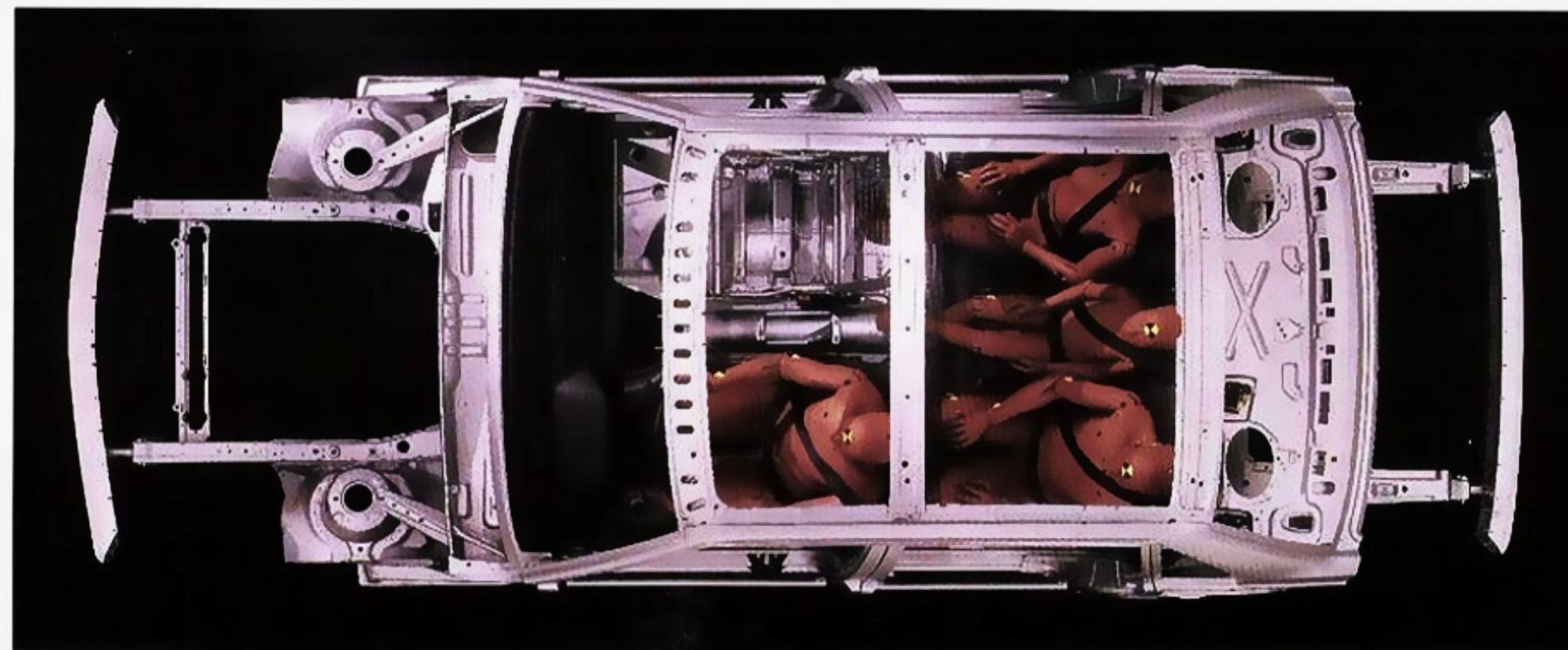
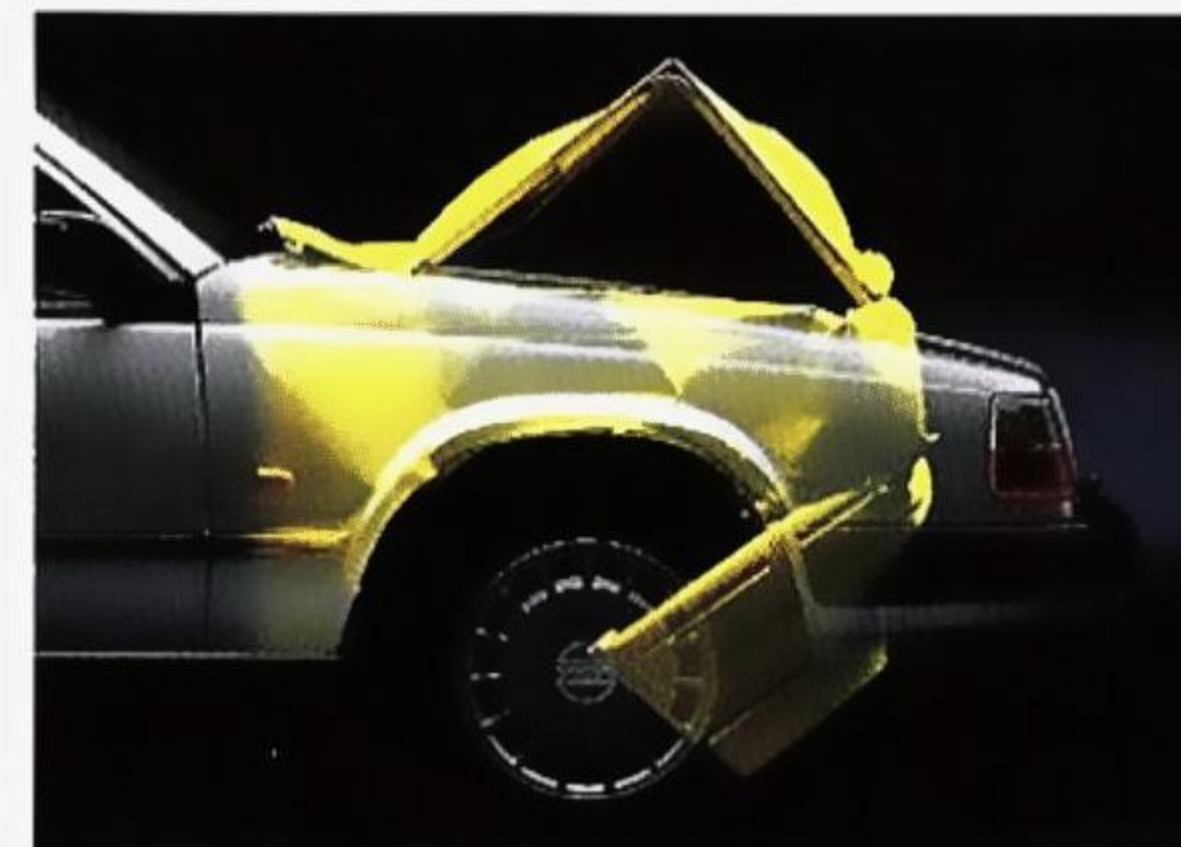
Passive Safety Features

For our suspension to deliver such predictability, a chassis of noteworthy integrity and structural rigidity is essential. Indeed, at Volvo, chassis engineering is viewed as the heart of passive safety design.

Each component is engineered to complement every other component to help maximize occupant protection.

Volvo's steel safety cage construction surrounds the occupants with a rigid protective enclosure designed to maintain its structural integrity in the event of a collision.

In a frontal collision energy absorbing structures are designed to deform to absorb a portion of the energy of impact.



Passive Safety Features

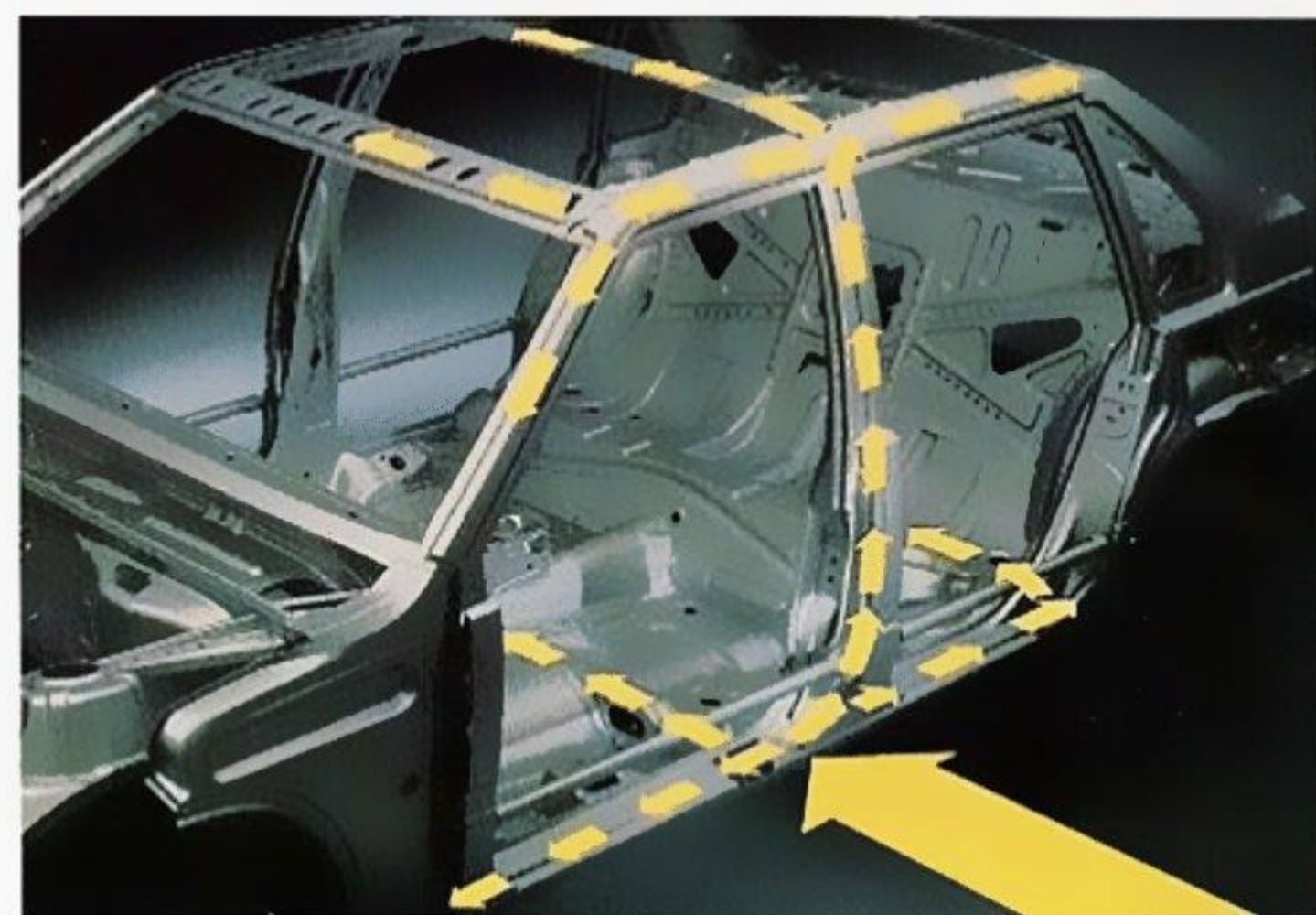
Volvo developed the concept of the three-point seat belt which, today, is the accepted industry standard. All Volvo 900 series models protect with a three-point seat belt and padded head restraint for all five seating positions including the center rear. In addition, both front seat belts include a pretensioner that automatically takes up any slack in the belt during a frontal impact. The 240 provides three-point seat belts and head restraints in the four outboard seating positions, and a traditional lap belt for the center rear.

Seats are designed to work in conjunction with seat belts to maximize seat belt effectiveness. Volvo's anti-submarining seat design and seat belt placement help prevent occupants from sliding down and forward in the event of a frontal collision.



Volvo's Side Impact Protection System represents a major advancement in the protection of occupants involved in vehicle to vehicle side impacts. Standard equipment on all 960 and 940 models, this innova-

tive system of reinforced body elements is designed to help absorb the energy of side impacts through structural members in



the sills, floor, pillars, roof and doors.

All Volvos are equipped with a driver's-side air bag. The 960 provides a passenger-side air bag, as well. The air bag is designed to deploy in the event of certain frontal or front angular impacts. Each is engineered to inflate in milliseconds to help dissipate the energy of the occupant's forward momentum.

An air bag system is often referred to as a Supplemental Restraint System. The word supplemental calls attention to the important fact that an air bag does not, by itself, make a car safe. An air bag should be considered one part of a total safety system, a system in which seatbelts play a fundamental role.

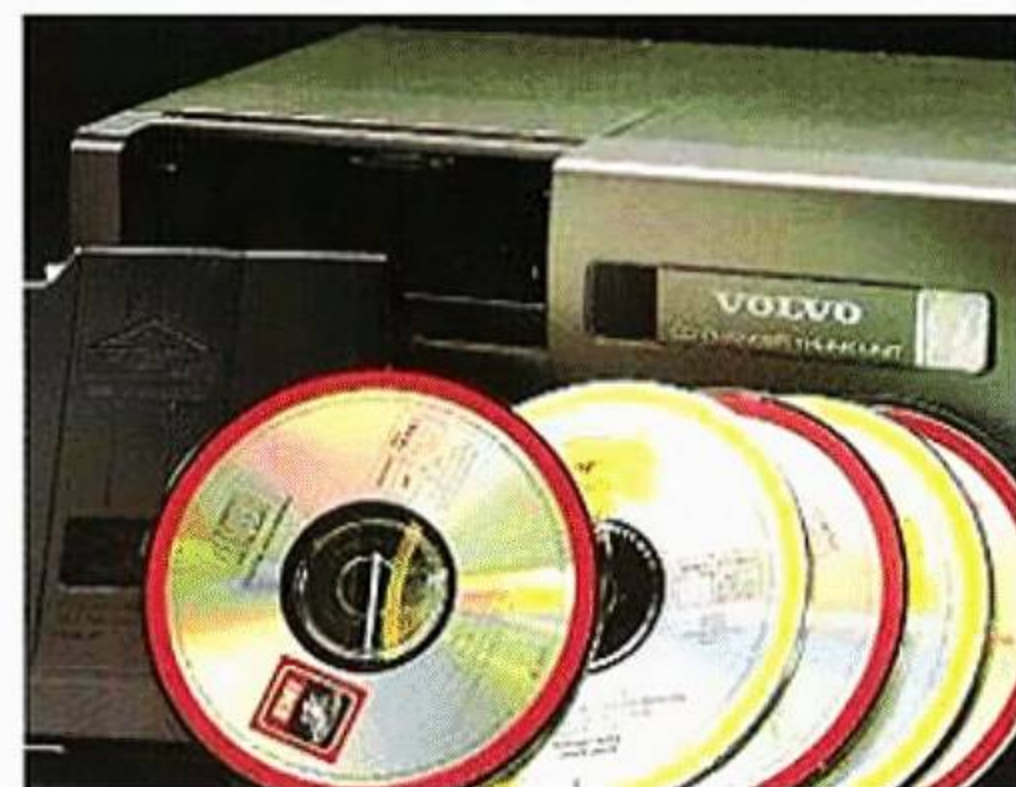
