


DOUDPE STATION WAGON IS REALLY BIG CARS IN ONE



















It has good looks to spare, as you can see by those graceful lines and that rich mahogany-finished outer panelling trimmed with contrasting genuine maple or birch framing.

This diagram visualizes the generous major dimensions of the load space provided when rear seat is removed, center "stowaway" seat folded down and tailgate lowered flush with floor.* This flat area actually totals 38.8 sq. ft. on one level. Tailgate has stout supporting arms which lock tailgate securely in the open position. Rear lift gate has sturdy support arm and special latching mechanism for convenient one-hand operation. If desirable to carry as many as four adults besides the driver, the rear seat may be removed and the center seat left in place. This still leaves 58.7 inches from back of center seat to tailgate, which space will hold a vast amount of luggage.


V-8 AND SIX ENGINE FEATURES: "Power Dome" combustion chambers; tin-plated Super-Fitted aluminum pistons, offset pins, 4-rings with chrome-plated top rings; "Rota-Quiet" valves; Quiet-Contoured camshaft; "Silent-Spin" fan; full-pressure lubrication; "Full-Flo" fuel pump; level-mounted "Deep Breath" intake manifold; "Cushion-Quiet" engine mountings; "Equa-Flo" cooling with positive-action type thermostats; "Loadomatic" ignition with Waterproof ignition system; dry type air cleaner; ** oil filter at extra cost.

CONVENTIONAL TRANSMISSION: selective gear type, 3-speeds forward, one reverse; helical gears.

OVERDRIVE: optional at extra cost; fourth-speed gear, ratio 0.70 to 1.

FORDOMATIC DRIVE: extra cost option with V-8 engine only; air-cooled single stage, 3-element hydraulic torque converter type with 3-speed automatic planetary gear train; 5-position, Semaphore Drive Selector with illuminated quadrant, on steering column.

POWER CUSHION SEMI-CENTRIFUGAL CLUTCH: dry, single plate; 9.5" outside diameter; ball type throwout bearing; oil impregnated, bronze pilot bearing.

DOUBLE-DROP FRAME: box-section side rails with 5 cross members.

CENTRAMATIC STEERING SYSTEM: symmetrical steering linkage; worm and roller steering gear with needle-bearing mounted, triple-tooth roller; 17.7 to 1 gear ratio; 23.2 to 1 over-all steering ratio.

INDEPENDENT FRONT WHEEL SUSPENSION: swinging link type with advanced "Hydra-Coil" springs; tubular, doubleacting "Viscous Control" shock absorbers; one-piece, rubber mounted stabilizer.

VARIABLE-RATE REAR SPRING SUSPENSION: tension type shackles; 9-leaf semi-elliptic springs, longitudinally mounted; rubber bushings at shackles and brackets and impregnated inserts between tips of upper leaves; tubular, double-acting "Viscous Control" shock absorbers, sea-leg mounted.

REAR AXLE: special heavy-duty, wide tread, semi-floating type; hypoid gears. Gear ratios: with conventional transmission 3.92 to 1 standard, 4.27 to 1 optional; with Over-drive: 4.27 to 1 standard; with Fordomatic Drive, 3.54 to 1 standard.

DOUBLE-SEAL KING-SIZE HYDRAULIC BRAKES: 4-wheel duoservo type; composite steel and cast iron drums; molded linings; 179.7 sq. in. total lining area.

WHEELS AND TIRES: five-stud, demountable steel disc wheels; black sidewall 7.10 x 15 6-ply super balloon tires

on 5" rims standard; white sidewall tires available at extra cost.

EXTERIOR DIMENSIONS: 114" wheelbase; 56" front tread; 60" rear tread; over-all length, with tailgate up, 208.9"—with tailgate down, 212.7"; over-all width 76.4" max.; height, without load, 70.8"; total glass area, 29.4 sq. ft.; height, open tailgate above ground, loaded, 23.7".

EXTERIOR COLORS: body side panels in grained mahogany finish with genuine birch or maple framing in natural color; all metal liftgate and tailgate finished to match side panels. Choice of 10 colors for balance of body—Sheridan Blue, Alpine Blue, Raven Black, Sea Island Green, Silvertone Gray, Mexacalli Maroon Metallic, Hawthorne Green Metallic, Hawaiian Bronze Metallic, Greenbrier Metallic and Culver Blue Metallic.

INSTRUMENTS AND CONTROLS: two-tone instrument panel with top-mounted radio grille; "Black Light" instrument cluster illumination; starter push button; combination exterior light and instrument panel light switch; interior light switch on left center pillar; head lamp beam control switch on toe board; windshield wiper control; ventilating duct controls; T-handle controls for hood latch and parking brakes; finger-tip gearshift lever.

STANDARD EQUIPMENT: Air-Wing steering wheel with Custom horn bar and full circle horn ring; Extra Power dual windshield wipers; twin horns with Weatherproof mounting; rear view mirror on windshield center bar; ash tray and locking-type glove compartment in instrument panel; two sun visors; dome light with door-jamb automatic switches and manual switch; stem-wound clock; cigarette lighter;

arm rests on doors; locks on doors, spare tire, liftgate, ignition and glove compartment operated by same key.

BODY FEATURES: real station wagon appearance with welded all-steel body; exterior panels in grained mahogany finish with laminated genuine birch or maple framing on sides; accessible spare tire storage on tailgate; torsion-bar type tailgate hinge; rugged tailgate support arms and latching mechanism; liftgate support arm with automatic release; flat, level-floor load space with flush tailgate; convenient fold-down center seat, easily removable rear seat, no tools required; "Picture Window" visibility; two-door design for greater strength and safety; front seat has Automatic Posture Control, non-sag springs and foam rubber pad; sliding type quarter windows with positive latches.

UPHOLSTERY AND TRIM: tops of seat cushions and fronts of seat backs upholstered in grained golden tan vinyl; cushion facings, tops and sides of seat backs and backs of front and rear seat backs in grained dark brown vinyl; back of "stowaway" center seat back and bottom of cushion covered with tan ribbed linoleum; headlining is golden tan artificial leather with sun visors in tan composition material bound with brown vinyl; door and body side panels are grained dark tan composition material; heavy black rubber mats are used in driver and passenger compartments; tan, heavy-duty ribbed linoleum covers the flat-level floor and inside of tailgate; wheel housings are covered with pebbled tan rubber. Upper portion of two-tone instrument panel together with door and window garnish moldings painted dark reddish brown; lower portion of instrument panel is grained dark tan finish.
