

This is '64's most elegant Mercury, the Park Lane. Shown above is a Park Lane with exclusive Breezeway design. Park Lanes with racy Marauder styling are also available. Both offer the 4-barrel Marauder Super 390 cubic-inch V-8 as standard equipment, options up to 425 hp. To add to riding comfort, all seats are foam-padded with a special balanced spring design giving a more cushioned effect. An optional 6-way power-operated front seat is available. Luxury? There's nothing like it in the medium-price field. At the right you see a fine example . . . a Park Lane interior, with all-nylon face, biscuit design upholstery. This interior is trimmed in medium silver Caspian cloth and light silver crushgrain vinyl. Unusual items: cut-pile carpet, walnut-colored insets in door panels, custom-grip door handles, vanity mirror on right sun visor, red and white lower door courtesy lights, padded instrument panel. 


PARK LANE

Here's more of the unusual luxury, power and pure beauty that is Park Lane. Shown above are two more Park Lane models. Outside, Park Lane beauty is unmistakable. Full-length side moldings, deluxe wheel covers, wheel cutout moldings, special coachmark on front fender and hood ornament give a jewel-like perfection



to the car. And there's the convenience of flashing fender-sight directional signals on the front fenders (you can see them without taking your eyes off the road). More luxury and convenience inside, too. You can choose the special Park Lane Sports Package which includes form-contoured individual shell-design seats (shown at left), either consolemounted four-speed manual stick shift or console-mounted Multi-Drive Merc-O-Matic, plus metal-trimmed pedal pads and foam seat cushions. And more interior elegance is yours in every Park Lane...color-keyed padded instrument panel with low-reflection vinyl cover, color-keyed heater, and electric clock. Laminated 5-ply convertible tops, made up of layers of vinyl, butyl bond and fabric, give additional strength and flexibility. Also, there's a new glass—not plastic—rear window that stays clearer...and is easier to clean.



Montclair two-door hardtop with Breezeway design


MONTCLAIR

The Montclair, too, has more of what you buy a medium-price car for. In short, all the traditional Mercury extra value plus some exciting '64 additions. The Montclair is also available in either Breezeway design (as shown above) or Marauder styles. Outside standard luxury features include full stainless steel trim, deluxe wheel covers. Inside: electric clock and courtesy lights for ashtray, parking brake and glove box. And where you can't readily see, Montclair steps past the ordinary, too. Open the more spacious, fully lined trunk (17.1 cubic feet of usable space, 33.6 cubic feet of total volume—room for 12 suitcases). Raise the hood . . . a 390 cubic-inch Marauder V-8 engine is standard.

Montclair interiors are trimmed in pleated Honeycomb cloth and vinyl or pleated all-vinyl upholstery. Pleated door panels are accented with bright moldings. Every detail is there in Montclair: bright-metal rear seat ashtrays, anodized aluminum seat side shields, vinyl-covered sun visors, long armrests with bright-metal trim and integral paddle-type door releases. The interior shown is in red crush-grain vinyl.

Unusual luxury goes with this unusual car. The Monterey, lowest priced of all Mercurys, is available in both Breezeway and Marauder styles. In both, there's a flair starting right at the front that seems to whisper "luxury." Both have big power. A 390 cubic-inch Marauder V-8 surges smoothly as you step on the accelerator.




