

For people who prefer efficiency with flair. Plenty of well-planned space for five people and their luggage. Plenty of efficient power from your choice of our 225 Six or 318 V-8. All the advantages of Plymouth's years-ahead engineering you'll find in greater detail on page 22. And a tasteful line-up of colours and interior fabrics to please just about anybody. That's what we mean when we say there's a big difference between a small car... and a small car from Plymouth. Like our Duster Custom.

A basic clue to the Custom's space planning is its wide choice of interior seat designs and interior trim selection. But what you'll appreciate most are the major steps we've taken with the Duster to provide measurable driving economies. Like gas saving. Duster's two engines are noted for their dislike of gas station pumps and they both run on leaded or unleaded gasolines. In addition, we offer rear axle ratios designed to get the most efficient use out of your chosen engine transmission combination. A 2.76 ratio is standard with the 225 Six and the 318 comes with a 2.45. Since a low numerical ratio promotes greater fuel economy, you save from the time you start putting miles on your '75 Duster.

The toughest Duster is the Duster 360. On the outside, take note of the E70 x 14" tires and beefed-up wheels. Out of sight is the rest of the engineering that accompanies the 360 V-8 power source: dual exhausts, heavy-duty suspension and shocks, front sway bars and Torqueflite automatic transmission.





FURY WAGONS

While the new, mid-size Fury, Fury Custom and Fury Sport wagons are indeed only 225.6" long overall (and so park and maneuver easily), they are in no way short on essentials.

Take cargo space. It's essential it be useful space, yes? Well, our mid-size Fury wagons carry 4' x 8' materials (such as wall panelling) conveniently flat. Not tilted. And carry them with the tailgate closed. Not open.

Another essential, comfort. Our mid-size Fury wagons are built with the extra care in engineering Chrysler is known for; not for the comfort of 4' x 8' panels, but for passengers of all shapes and sizes in all kinds of driving conditions.

We also consider styling essential. So our new Fury wagons are a new, modern style. For instance, the front end has the clean, pure lines demanded today. And it will stay clean, rust-free, because the front end panel is fibreglass. In other words, our Furys are styled for a favourable first impression and a lasting one.

Underneath, your new Fury wagon is powered by an economical 318 V-8 coupled with Torqueflite automatic transmission. There is a point in people's lives which dictates the need, not only for a wagon, but a full-size wagon. And our Gran Fury Suburban, Gran Fury Custom and Gran Fury Sport wagons make that point a high point

To start with, Gran Fury wagons come equipped with standard features like: power steering, power window on the three-way tailgate, gate ajar warning light, heavy-duty front and rear shock absorbers, Torqueflite automatic transmission, power front disc brakes and steel-belted radial tires.

Now consider their appearance. Their length, breadth and width say full-size. But you'll see they are free from the fat of over-styling. Even the roof air deflector which helps keep the rear window clean leaves the flow of the roof undisturbed.

The interior of the Fury wagons include luxurious but hard wearing seating, colour co-ordinated floor covering and a modular instrument panel that is easy for servicing, because the gauges are removable from the front. Besides the storage trays along the sides of the cargo area and a concealed storage compartment under the cargo floor, a useful storage option is a lockable storage bin to keep valuables locked up tight. Full-floor sound insulation, a built-in step at the tailgate and full-volume foam seats . . . all this because life may dictate the need for a full-size
