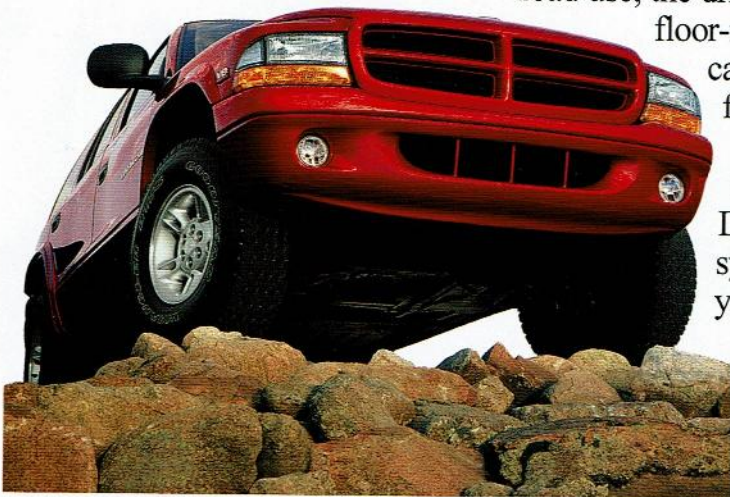

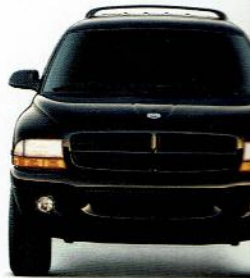
pleasing and cargo friendly, it also had to be equally good beyond the pavement.

And just as you knew we would, we got there. For all Durango's excellent road manners, towing ability, comforts, cup holders and storage, it can be a grizzly in the wild.

Durango makes you rough-ready with a choice of two proven four-wheel-drive systems. The first is a part-time system which enables Durango to be driven normally in conventional two-wheel drive. On poor road surfaces or in off-road use, the driver can shift the floor-mounted transfer case lever into four-wheel drive.

The second system is Durango's full-time system, enabling you to shift from two-wheel to four-wheel drive — and then leave your Durango in

four-wheel drive indefinitely. This system is suitable under all conditions because it allows both front and rear wheels to turn at appropriate speeds in four-wheel drive, eliminating undue tire wear or strain on the drivetrain in turns.

Both four-wheel-drive systems combine with Durango's powerful Magnum® engines, widest-in-class track, independent front and innovative rear suspension, robust power recirculating ball steering, and tough frame, to give you a genuine off-road machine.

Another Durango feature that works well for you: The largest-in-class 25-gallon fuel tank. So you can have extended adventure in the wild with fewer fuel stops in that other jungle we call civilization.

Our engineers cracked the
whip on "Crack The Whip."





Durango's S-shaped rear leaf spring suspension helps minimize the "crack the whip" effect vehicles experience in turns by allowing the rear wheels to steer slightly.

The rear of any vehicle in a turn is like the last skater in a "crack the whip" line — when the front of the line turns, the last skater's momentum wants to send that person in a straight line rather than through the turn.

Typically, sport utilities sit high off the ground for clearance over obstacles. This and their bulk tend to make their behavior in turns even more unwieldy than other vehicles. Dodge engineers insisted on giving Durango excellent

handling attributes, even with its high (among the highest-in-class) 7.9-inch ground clearance, so they created a unique suspension



combination that accomplishes this.

Our engineers gave Durango an S-shaped single-leaf rear spring that modifies this momentum shift and allows the rear wheels to steer ever so slightly to follow the front wheels through a turn. The slightly turning rear wheels reduce the tendency of the rear to go in a straight line, thus reducing body lean in the turns for greater stability.

This S-shaped single stage design also gives Durango a smoother ride over other sport utility vehicles that have multistage springs with less "give."

Dodge engineers combined this innovation with Durango's tried-and-true stable independent front suspension using torsion bars and a sturdy cast (not stamped) lower suspension arm, as well as front and rear stabilizer bars. Quick-ratio power recirculating ball steering contributes to Durango's athletic maneuvering in traffic and off-road.

Dimensions play a big role in Durango's performance and

stability. Wheelbase length positively affects ride and stability characteristics, and Durango's class-leading 115.9" wheelbase serves you well. Durango also has the widest track in its class. This also means increased vehicle stability in virtually all driving situations.

Beneath that tough exterior lies yet another tough exterior.

The thing about strength in a sport utility vehicle is that you need it *everywhere*. And Durango delivers everywhere, beginning with a very stiff frame. It is the only frame in its class made of boxed 35,000-psi steel with seven crossmembers. Some frame brackets are even fabricated of 50,000-psi steel for added strength. The frame is electrocoated through full immersion in a corrosion-resistant primer.



Competitors' frames receive a less durable hot wax coating.

All body panels except the roof are of galvanized steel, with key panels treated on two sides.

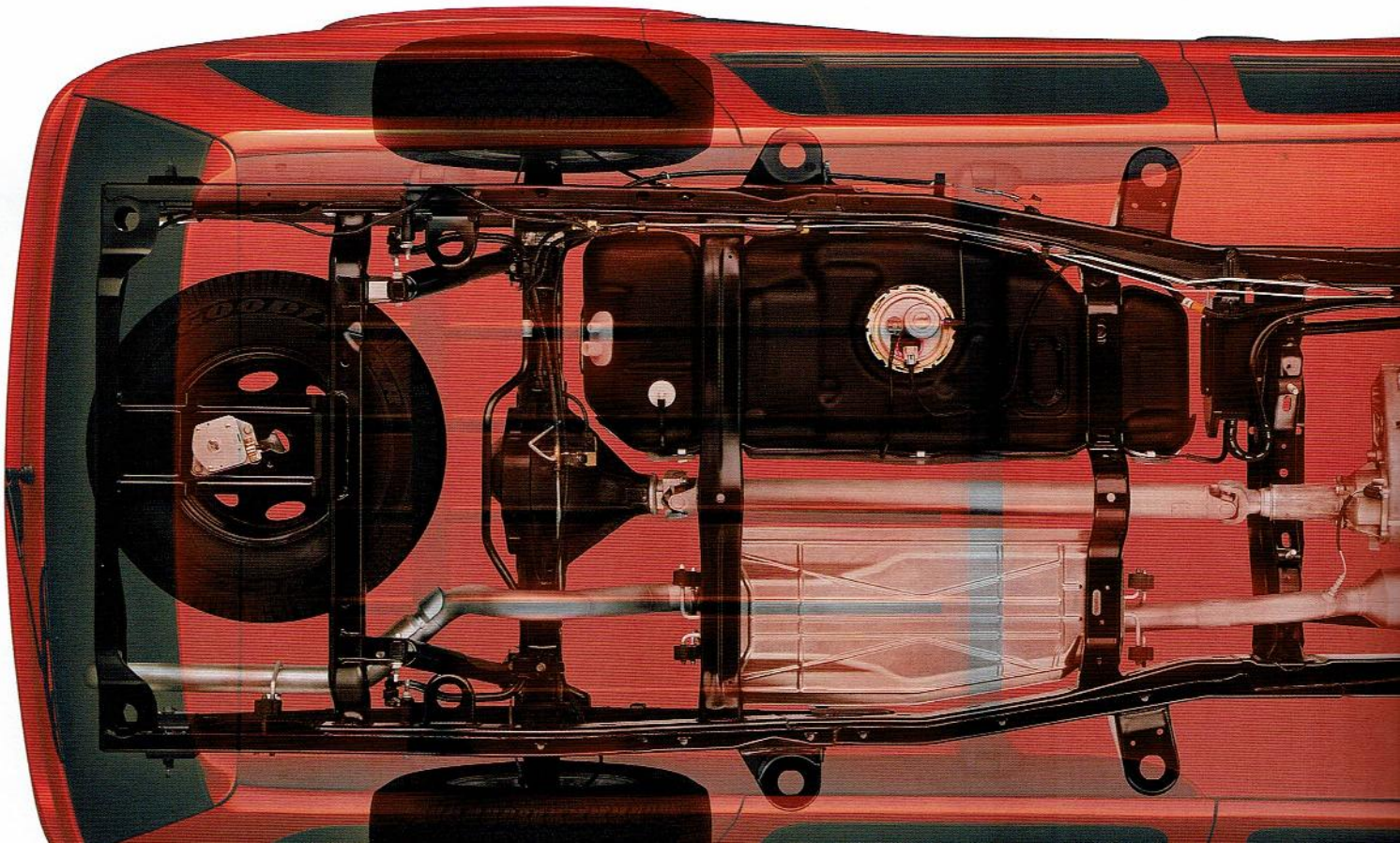
The body is electrocoated in a nine-step immersion process that first cleans it thoroughly, then covers it with corrosion-resistant phosphate coating.

Body panels receive an anti-chip base of epoxy polyester powder, followed by an anti-chip

primer which bonds with finish coat to resist destruction from road debris.

The anti-chip coat is applied in powder form, then melted in an oven to bond with the base coat.

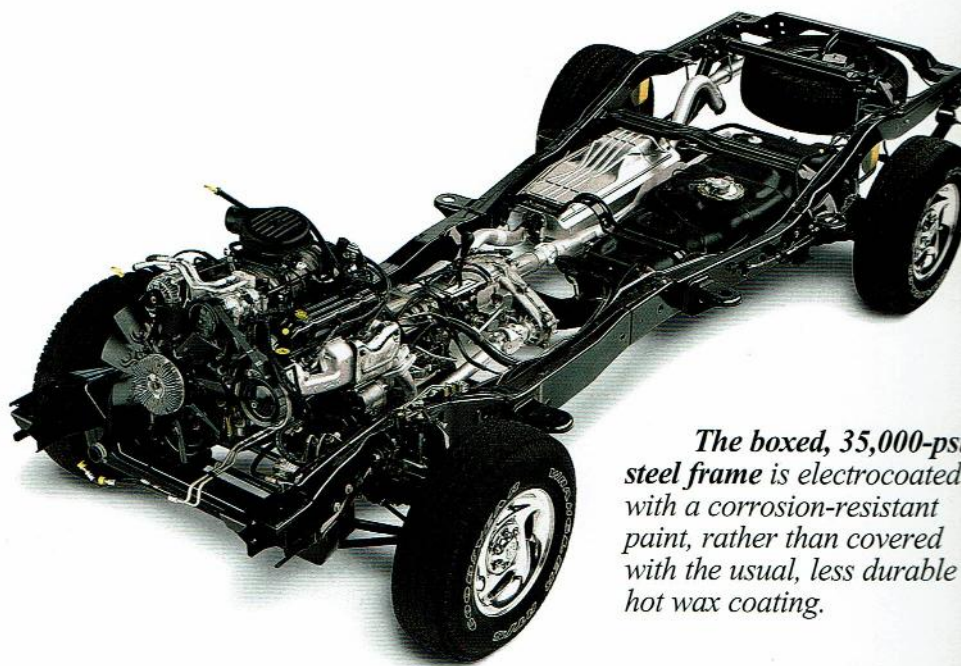
The clever property of the anti-chip coat is that it flexes when struck sharply to bend rather than break, and this is how it helps control paint chips and nicks. It even helps prevent peeling or delamination by the finish color and Clear Coats caused by the sun's ultraviolet rays.



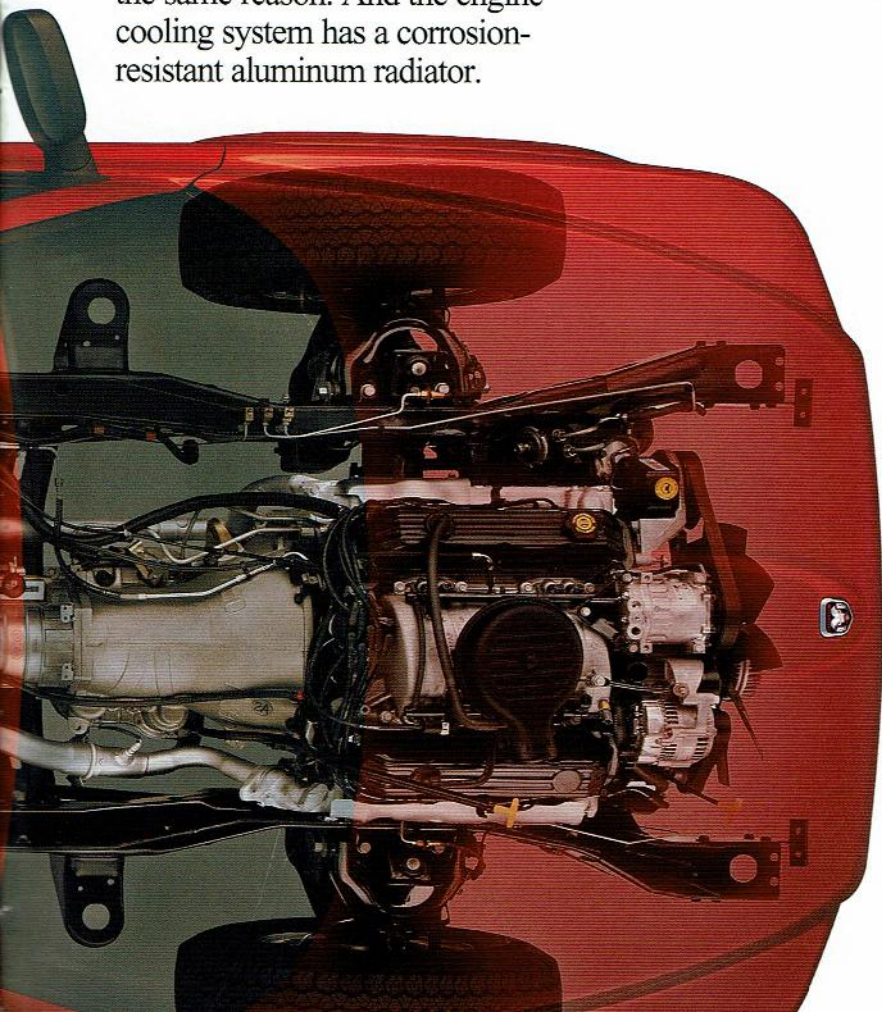

Two color coats, water-based to reduce harmful petrochemical emissions, are sealed with a Clear Coat specially formulated to resist etching from acid rain, bird droppings, and degradation from sunlight.

The corrosion-, puncture-, heat-resistant and biggest-in-class plastic 25-gallon fuel tank is mounted securely between the frame rails ahead of the rear axle. Fuel lines are nylon to resist corrosion. The exhaust system is stainless steel for the same reason. And the engine cooling system has a corrosion-resistant aluminum radiator.



The boxed, 35,000-ps steel frame is electrocoated with a corrosion-resistant paint, rather than covered with the usual, less durable hot wax coating.



Doors are built to stay rigid through computer design and laser-welded inner panels. The result: a stronger door structure that is less likely to sag over time.

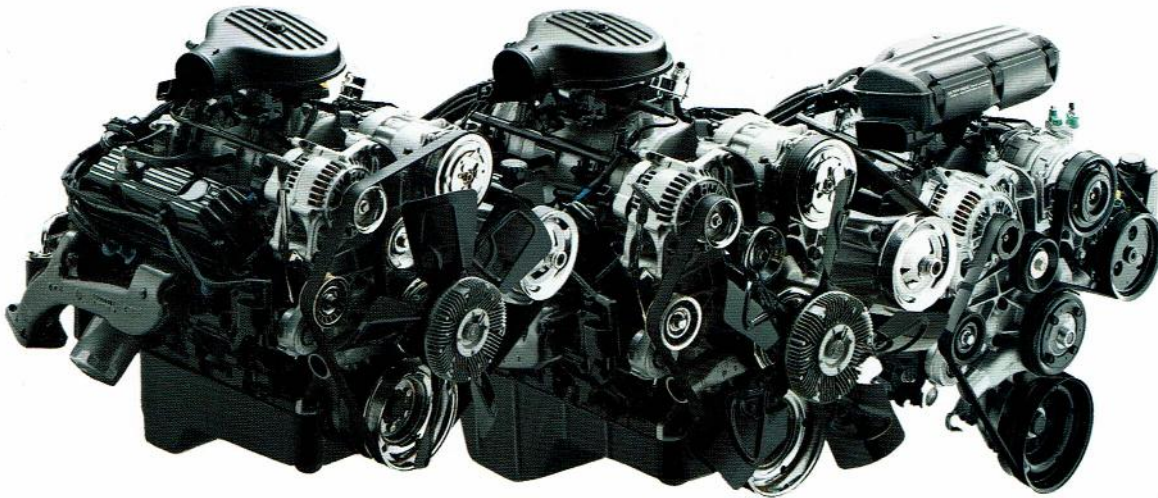

Magnum engines are the powerhouses among Durango's very capable features. They give Durango a wider range of power than its competitors, letting you go and do more. This wider range of compact sport-utility power leads off with the standard 3.9-liter 175-horsepower Magnum V6 (late availability) and is followed by the well-respected 5.2-liter 230-horsepower Magnum V8, and the king-of-the-hill 5.9-liter 245-horsepower Magnum V8.

Magnum engines gulp huge amounts of air to improve combustion and increase horsepower through smart technology like sequential multipoint fuel injection for more immediate throttle response. A progressive-bore throttle body increases combustion force, and horsepower, by accelerating airflow. Similarly, a high-flow aluminum intake manifold increases inbound air volume.

High-flow exhaust manifolds then move exhaust gases out quickly for better combustion efficiency.

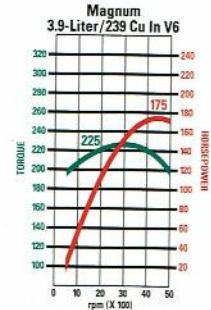
Magnum durability is engineered through features like powdered metal valve rocker arm fulcrums to increase valve train life and extra-thick rocker arm covers with silicone gaskets for better sealing against leaks and improved noise control. The serpentine belt accessory drive with automatic tensioner also helps control noise while decreasing maintenance requirements. Dodge engineers even included a starter override switch to promote starter longevity and prevent you from trying to start an engine that's already running.

As with everything else in Durango, power application is specially engineered for real-world use. Unique Durango standard four-speed automatic transmissions are mated to each Magnum engine's requirements and characteristics.

Durango's specially engineered exhaust system provides optimum performance while keeping it quiet in the rear passenger area. Even the specially finned, corrosion-resistant aluminum radiator and fan cooling were reengineered and give you

designed to cancel out engine vibration and movement.

Durango is an action vehicle, designed specifically to help you do things other than just go to and from. Powered by the optional 5.9-liter 245-horsepower Magnum V8 and equipped with the optional Trailer Tow Group, Durango gives you the largest-in-class gross combined weight rating of 12,200 pounds to carry people and gear, plus tow a trailer to any adventure you choose. And speaking of towing, that big Magnum V8 gives you a hefty, best-in-class towing maximum of 7,300 pounds of boat, camper, motorcycles or do-it-yourself stuff.

Driver information and feedback are Durango traits because of its many smart features like the switches — they're all backlit for easy identification — and located logically by priority. So are the quick-read analog gauges and warning lamps on the single-plane instrument cluster.

In developing Durango, we really thought of everything, even fine-tuning the speedometer to read the speed 8,000 times per mile for exactness and smooth operation.

We think you'll really appreciate features like seats designed especially to reduce fatigue on long trips on or

off the road, body-mounted mirrors for clearer images and reduced air stream noise. And to give you greater hindsight, a standard liftgate glass defroster covers the entire rear glass surface. You'll also enjoy the one-touch-down driver's window with standard power windows, and

steering wheel-mounted controls on Durango's standard cruise control, including a "tap" feature to increase the controlled speed in two-mph increments. A 12-volt accessory plug provides you with a command-

post communications link for cell phones and laptop computers.

Start up Durango and three extremely smart computers go to work instantly. One controls Magnum® engine performance, from ignition timing to fuel and air intake. Another controls the braking system.

A third, called the CTM, or Central Timer Module, manages things like the optimum shift



points for the standard four-speed automatic transmission, operating the starter override, controlling windshield wiper speed, and even turning interior lamps on and off for you. The CTM also manages the wipers so that when they're set on intermittent, it senses when Durango's speed falls below 10 mph and increases wiper speed for safe, clear vision.

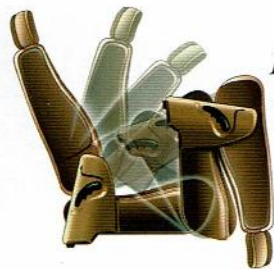

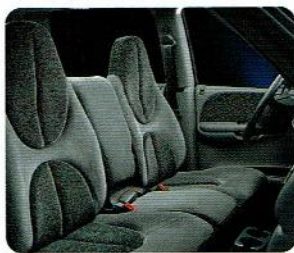

Since a really good sport utility can't have too much room for people and their stuff, Dodge engineers used electronic imagery and simultaneous exterior/interior design to maximize Durango's roomy interior.

Durango offers seating capacity for five, six, seven and eight persons (with the optional front 40/20/40 bench seat, and optional third row

rear bench). In any configuration, Durango has been people-engineered for ease of entry and exit.

Durango's roof has been raised to provide more head room and theater-style raised seating for second- and third-seat passengers. The standard Fold-and-Tumble™ 40/20/40 second seat and the optional third seat fold

quickly and easily with one-hand operation, and lie nearly flat for largest-in-class 88-cubic-foot cargo area. Leave the second seat up and you still have 51 cubic feet of cargo space. There are four tie-down provisions to keep cargo from shifting.

Another smart feature about the Fold-and-Tumble™ second seat is that it can be folded in segments to accommodate one or two persons.

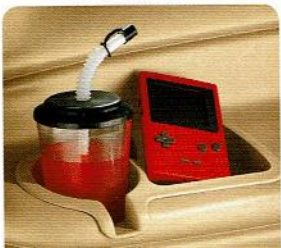
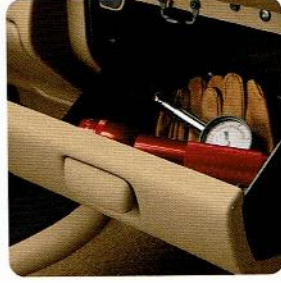

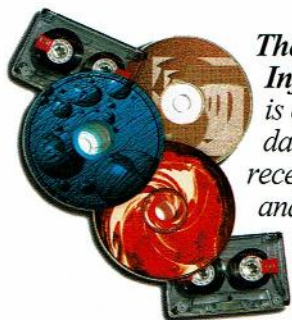

The eight-speaker Infinity® sound system is optional on the standard AM/FM stereo receiver/cassette player and the optional AM/FM stereo receiver/cassette/CD player.

Even with all seats up, there are 10 or more storage places in Durango. They include the largest-in-class glove box, a tray on the four-wheel-drive shift bezel, divided door map pockets, optional overhead sunglasses and door-opener storage bins, covered floor storage bins and storage trays in the rear trim panels. One of the covered floor storage bins, ahead of the rear liftgate, contains the jack, tire-changing tools and spare tire access.

With standard front bucket seats, you get a full center console with large storage bin, CD/cassette racks and a tissue holder. Choose the optional 40/20/40 front bench seat and you get a folding center armrest with a mini-console.

For the thirsty ones, Durango features up to nine cup holders in strategic locations throughout.

Durango's interior climate is extremely people friendly. There are numerous fresh air outlets (even more if the optional rear overhead air conditioner is specified — front

heater/ventilator/air conditioning is standard) and cabin air exhausts cleverly hidden throughout to get rid of old air without letting noise and dirt in.

The rear liftgate is people friendly too. Lift it and you can picnic or change into or out of waders and gear sheltered from the rain. Six-footers can find shelter without bumping their heads. It has two handles and temperature-sensitive gas lifting cylinders so it operates easily in both cold and hot weather. The liftgate has a spoiler so the airstream keeps the rear window clean. It also has a dedicated washer for the wiper with a nearly one-gallon capacity.

Silence is another Durango strength. The passenger cabin is shielded extensively from road and mechanical noise, and from dust, dirt, moisture and drafts. All four doors are triple-sealed and have special weather stripping to cancel out noise and block wind and water intrusions. Large-diameter spool-type engine mounts minimize vibration. Passengers are isolated from intrusive road noise and shocks by 12 body mounts, each designed for its specific location.

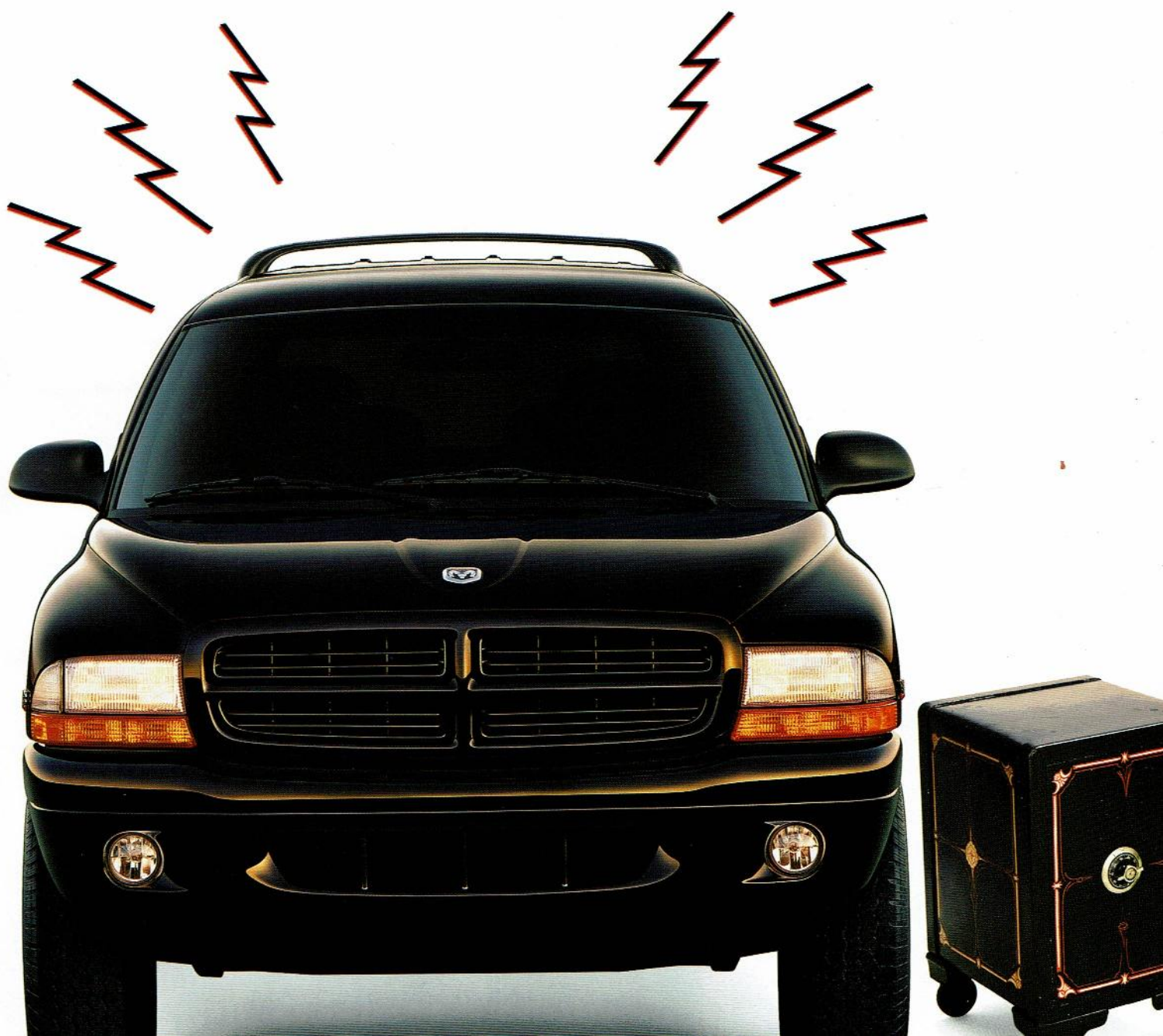


The optional rear overhead air conditioning unit is mounted so it doesn't obstruct visibility. With four independently adjustable vents and a dedicated four-speed blower, it is designed to pull air from the front seat area and re-cool for the rear area. Exhausters prevent "pooling" of the cooled air in the rear.

Hit the panic button on the key fob with the standard remote keyless entry system and the horn sounds and headlamps flash for a three-minute interval. Keyless entry also enables you to open only the driver's door first.

When called upon, this Dodge hero can get noisy. The optional vehicle theft alarm sounds off loudly and blinks the lamps if your Durango is tampered with after you set the device. The standard remote keyless entry system allows the driver to unlock only the driver's door first and also comes with a panic alarm. Press the panic button on the key fob and the horn sounds and the headlamps blink for a three-minute interval.

Standard power door locks may be dealer programmed to lock automatically when Durango's speed exceeds 15 mph. A standard Enhanced Accident Response System (EARS) turns on interior lamps and unlocks doors if the air bags* deploy and the electrical system remains intact.



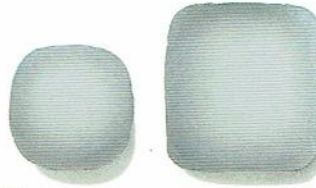
Height-adjustable shoulder belts are standard on Durango's first- and second-row outboard seats for increased safety and comfort.

Durango's impressive list of safety features includes standard Next Generation driver and front-passenger air bags.* The height-adjustable shoulder belts for front and second-row outboard passengers feature front-row traveling anchors and buckles to further adjust to people of different sizes. Headrests on all outboard seats also help protect passengers.

All four side doors have steel beams to help protect passengers in side impacts. Front seats are designed to resist impacts. Durango's frame and body structure are designed to manage energy during a collision for driver/passenger protection.

Finally, standard antilock rear brakes contribute to your security in Durango by helping you avoid trouble, better enabling you to steer safely when braking on slippery surfaces. Four-wheel antilock brakes are optional.
