Use the SR-5 Long Bed Sport Truck as a versatile pickup, or use it as a sporty, personal-size car; either way, you've got a winner. There's a hefty 1,400 lb* payload edge to work with, and no telling what all you can fit into that 7-foot bed. Then, when it's time for fun, slide into that new cab with its full headlining, wall-to-wall plush pile carpeting, and Hi-back buckets. Sit back and enjoy the rich sound of the standard AM/FM radio. Toyota even includes (at no extra cost, of course) power-boosted Flo-thru ventilation, plus urethane padding on the sport steering wheel and shift knob. A nice touch.

Under that stylish hood lies a 2.2 liter SOHC engine with enough load-moving torque to handle the toughest jobs. There's a 5-speed overdrive transmission to help hold down fuel consumption and lessen engine wear. Up front, fade-resistant, power-assisted disc brakes; at the rear, husky drums, with a new G-sensing proportioning valve to help control light load rear brake lock-up. "Including occupants cargo and equipment.





The Toyota SR-5 Sport Truck. This heavy hauler gives you the same tough truck features, years-ahead styling and luxuries as its Long Bed kin, but in a more compact, easy-to-handle package. For 1979, Toyota's SR-5 Soft Ride rear suspension delivers a smooth, comfortable car-like ride. At the same time, the Sport Truck's six-foot bed is strong enough to take on a weekend camper shell. Its 5-speed overdrive transmission and torsion bar front suspension offer a sporty-car feeling, while the standard steel-belted radial tires and power-assisted front disc brakes produce sure-footed, fade-fighting slowing.

Meanwhile, up front, there's a sports car cockpit masquerading as a pickup cab. The all-new upgraded interior – standard on all SR-5 Sport Trucks for 1979 – includes Hi-back bucket seats with knitted vinyl inserts, full console with storage tray, and plush wall-to-wall carpeting. Full door panel trim includes carpeted lower section and storage pocket. The padded sport steering wheel and shift knob are extra touches that don't cost extra.

Also standard: the tachometer, resettable trip meter and intermittent windshield wiper control. An AM/FM sound system serves up beautiful music, while power-boosted Flo-thru ventilation delivers a breath of fresh air. All these niceties and more, plus fresh styling and Toyota toughness. That's the SR-5 Sport Truck for 1979.

Shown with optional Western-style mirrors, CB antenna, rear step bumper and custom camper shell modification. (Similar shells available at many Toyota dealers.) There's more to this pickup than just tough truck features; there's an array of comfort, convenience, styling and driveability features that are built into *all* 1979 Toyota SR-5 pickup trucks.

It starts with the sweep of a handsome simulated woodgrain dashboard with easy to read instrumentation and glare-reducing padded top. That AM/FM radio is a nice extra; what makes it even nicer is that it's standard equipment. Both the sport steering wheel and the 5-speed shift knob are padded to enhance the sporty look and feel of the SR-5 interior.

Under the hood lives a classic 2.2 liter single overhead cam engine for big-truck pulling power. It's mated to an easy shifting 5-speed transmission that combines the versatility of load-matching low-end ratios with the fuel-stretching benefits of an overdrive top gear. A typical Toyota no-extra-cost extra is the fully transistorized ignition system that ends points or condenser replacements. Among the options we knew you'd want: those big, bold Western-style outside rear view mirrors.

Put 'em all together, add such standard equipment as a tachometer, full linted glass, power-assisted front discs, steelbelted radials, and important features like torsion-bar front suspension and Soft Ride rear suspension, and you've got that king-of-the-road feeling without paying a king's ransom.



The Toyota Long Bed Deluxe. One glance at that new Long Bed at the right tells you that here's a truck with the flair that says 1979. Still and all, underneath it's what you'd expect from Toyota: tough.

Some big things make the Toyota Standard Deluxe or Long Bed Deluxe your kind of truck. Things like the Toyota Long Bed's 7-foot cargo bed. And a high-torque 2.2 liter single overhead cam engine that gets going when the going gets tough. There's newly-designed torsion bar front suspension for a smoother ride. And power-assisted front disc brakes. They're all standard in both Long Bed Deluxe and Standard Bed Deluxe trucks for 1979.

But don't forget the little things that make your Toyota truck easier to live with. Like a fully transistorized ignition system that puts an end to points and condenser replacements. Also at no extra cost: a sporty, fuel-saving 5-speed gearbox; or you can order the optional 3-speed automatic* for greater convenience. And if you like a little music to fill your workaday world, there's an optional AM/FM radio. But if you're looking for an asterisk to explain the costly-looking white sidewall tires shown in the photographs, you won't find it. They're standard on our new Long Bed and Standard Bed Deluxe half-ton pickups for 1979. After all, who says a pickup truck has to look stodgy?


