THE 1982 LAND CRUISERS

The 1982 Land Cruisers are your kind of 4-bys if you measure the worth of a 4x4 vehicle by its ability to get you through villainous terrain.

The 4.2 liter 6-cylinder engine develops 200 ft-lbs of torque at only 1800 rpm. With that power going to the Land Cruiser's 4-speed transmission and 2-speed transfer case, you've got a 4-wheel drive with terrific climbing power. The Land Cruiser's semi-elliptical leaf springs and double-acting shock absorbers front and rear provide a dependable suspension system for challenging rugged terrain. Power-assisted brakes give you stopping power when you need it.

What's more, you can have your Land Cruiser plain or fancy.

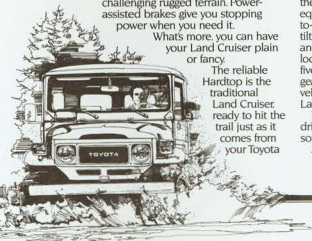
The reliable Hardtop is the traditional Land Cruiser, ready to hit the trail just as it comes from your Toyota

dealer. Equipment that's usually optional on most 4x4s is standard on the Hardtop: steel skid plates under the transfer case and gas tank; front tow hook; tinted glass; padded roll bar; front/rear heaters; heavy-duty radiator, battery, and alternator; a steering stabilizer; and a plug-in socket for a trouble light. Everything about it is off-road rugged.

If you prefer to do your boulder crawling and cactus dodging in the lap of luxury, take a look at the Land Cruiser Wagon. The Wagon has most of the heavy-duty features found on the Hardtop, and comes standard-equipped with cloth upholstery, wall-to-wall carpeting, power steering with tilt wheel, AM/FM/MPX radio, mud and snow tires and free-wheeling/locking front hubs. The Wagon can carry five adults plus a good-sized pile of gear into places where the only other vehicle you're likely to see is another Land Cruiser.

When you drive a Land Cruiser, you're driving a legend. It can get you into some of the world's worst places.
