

Lebaron GTS

This newest Chrysler is the American sports sedan that challenges BMW 528e, Mercedes 190E and Audi 5000S Turbo in United States Auto Club tests covering braking, cornering, slalom and acceleration.

The 1985 LeBaron GTS is a front-wheel drive four-door liftback sedan with sleek aerodynamic styling incorporating low-profile front end, sloping hood, and aero-wrap flush-mounted windshield.

LeBaron GTS's maneuverability is the combined result of such features as a road-touring suspension system that includes nitrogen-charged dual-path front Iso-Struts and rear shocks; fast-ratio, precision-feel power-assisted rack-and-pinion steering, and front-wheel drive technology.

LeBaron GTS is powered by the proven Chrysler-built 99-horsepower 2.2-liter engine with electronic fuel injection. For increased responsiveness, a 146-horsepower turbocharged version of this engine is optional.

The LeBaron GTS gives you four-door convenience plus a liftback for easy cargo-area loading. It features space, comfort and convenience. Interior features include low-back front bucket seats with recliners, storage in the front console, door and sun visor pockets, cup and coin holders, and more.

The instrument panel on the High Line version of the LeBaron GTS has electro-mechanical analog gauges. The Premium version has a full Electronic Instrument Cluster with digital readouts for speedometer, odometer and trip odometer, and graphic displays for the tachometer and functions such as fuel level, engine coolant temperature, voltage, and oil pressure.









LASER AND LASER XE

The Chrysler Laser and Laser XE are Chrysler's first true sports cars. Their distinctive front-wheel drive technology provides efficient stability and control. And their sleek shape with a low .35 coefficient of drag makes them effective performers. The standard engine is a 99-horsepower electronic fuel injected 2.2-liter Trans-4. It is coupled to a closeratio five-speed overdrive manual transaxle. For more power and response, a 146-horsepower turbocharged version of this engine is optional. The split-back folding rear seat provides room for larger luggage while also accommodating a rear seat passenger. You can realize savings on several optional equipment packages.



Town & Country wagon is powered by a standard 2.6-liter Silent Shaft engine, built for Chrysler by Mitsubishi Motors Corporation. This engine provides increased power, to handle the loads you can carry. For even more power specify the optional 146-horsepower turbocharged 2.2-liter engine.

LIMOUSINE

The 1985 Chrysler Limousine is the high-tech luxury car with advanced front-wheel drive technology. It has a full 131inch wheelbase providing seven-passenger capacity. The front-wheel drive design increases interior room and passenger comfort while providing stability and a smooth ride. Efficient power for the Chrysler Limousine is furnished by a standard Mitsubishi-built 2.6-liter Silent Shaft four-cylinder engine. Special Limousine construction involves strengthened structural assemblies and suspension components for durability. The Limousine, like all Chryslers and Plymouths, is built with extensive quality control procedures and corrosion-resistant provisions.
