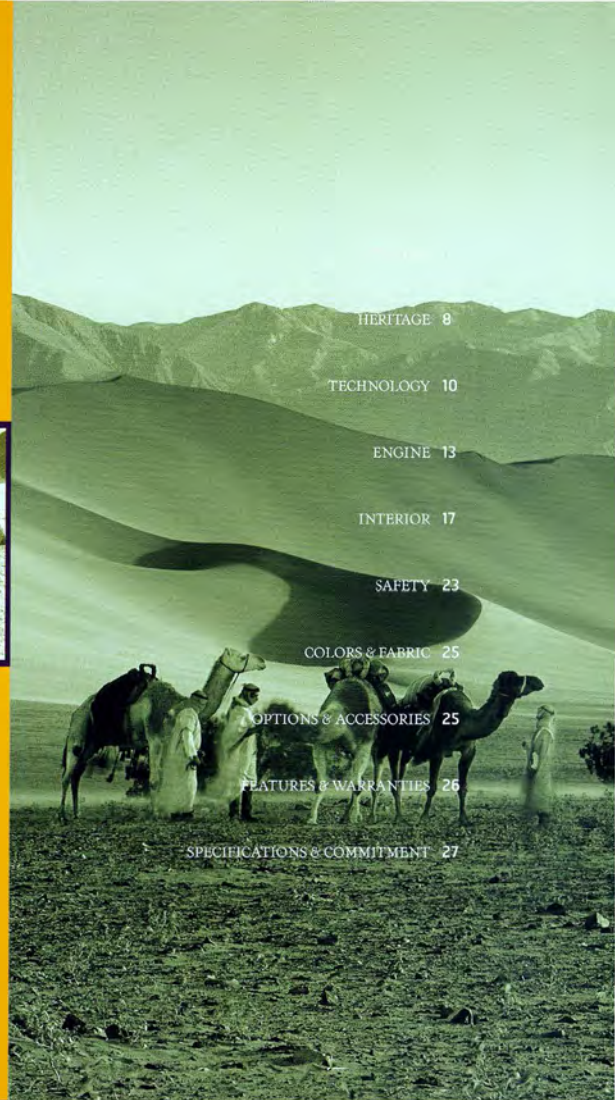

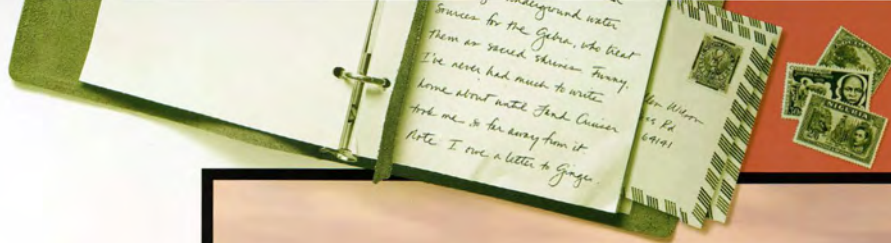

When I lost the aerial map, she said *Don't quit your day job*. Which is precisely what I plan to do. Last night, at the campfire, we talked seriously about staying, throwing in with Dave and his crew, guiding big game photo tours. Our friends, the nomadic Gabra, are all for it — they know every inch of the landscape and trust us to give back more than we take. We break camp at a leisurely pace, say our good-byes and head out at midday for the Ruwenzori Range — the Mountains of the Moon. We may have lost the map, but we are full of plans.

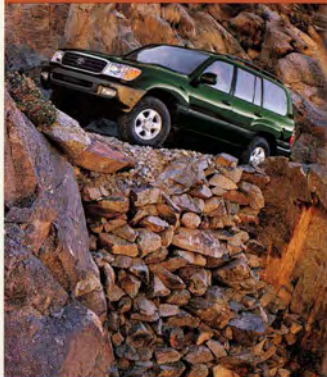


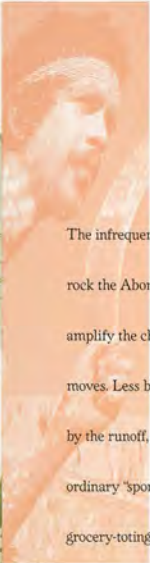


Since mid-century, Toyota Land Cruiser has been a unifying fact of life in some of the most remote and seemingly impossible locations around the globe.

At the Nepal-Tibet border, the only sound is the wind. The Tibetans call this huge Himalayan upheaval of folded rock the Mother of the World. One is reminded at every obstacle that when the going gets really serious, one must rely on an extremely serious vehicle. Toyota Land Cruiser has filled that bill since 1951, venturing well past the points where the road builders have shrugged and turned back.

Even more on top of its game, the current-generation Land Cruiser below is shown in Imperial Jade Mica, surmounting your expectations with ease.





The infrequent rainstorms create flashing cataracts off the rock the Aborigines call Uluru. Beautiful cascades that amplify the changing colors of the eroded rock as the sun moves. Less beautiful is the wheel-sucking muck created by the runoff, and I wouldn't want to encounter it in an ordinary "sport utility vehicle," one of those come-lately, grocery-toting, urban show ponies. I choose a rocky ford and cross easily. The Aborigines have immense respect for the individual, irrespective of age, gender or place of origin. We have hit it off well, and I'll pitch camp here in their beautiful backyard. I'll return with a Land Cruiser-load of colorful trade goods and remarkable stories of the power of their dreamtime.



Multi-reflector headlamps with parabolic reflectors and a concentrated beam source produce a clean, focused light pattern. The Automatic Light Control System turns lights on or off depending on outside light availability.

Power rack-and-pinion steering provides turning ease from parking lot to passing lane. The energy-absorbing steering column features a breakaway plate and deformable shaft to help lessen collision effects.

The double-wishbone independent front suspension with torsion bar spring provides superb off-road drivability and control. Cruising comfort and steering response are balanced by the suspension at highway speeds.

16-inch aluminum alloy wheels with large P275/70R16 tires complete the power-to-surface package with surefootedness and grip.

The 9-member ladder frame helps provide torsional rigidity during off-road travel and when towing.

4-link, coil-spring rear suspension with heavy-duty shocks and stabilizer bar helps refine movement on highway and off.



The electronically controlled automatic transmission with intelligence (ECT-I) easily accommodates the high power output of the V8 engine, and helps reduce shift shock for smooth, effortless shifting. In snow or other traction-robbing situations, Land Cruiser features a second-gear start mode for increased traction.



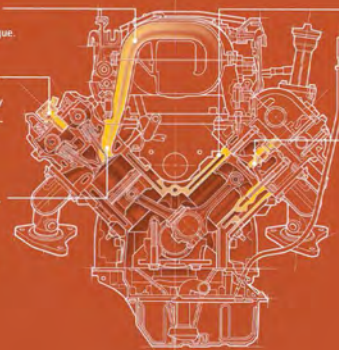
Power is of utmost importance in these dark mountains. The books told us it was extremely rugged here, that the awe-inducing peaks suddenly plunged seaward with little warning. We wished for a smoother descent — and got it, with the big V8 muscling us up and down the gorges. With 32 valves, dual overhead camshafts and nearly 300 cubic inches, the powerful 230-horsepower engine is one of the most sophisticated V8s in its segment, and gave our Land Cruiser confidence of movement that paralleled the mountain goat's.

The Toyota Direct Ignition (TDI) System improves timing accuracy and overall reliability by eliminating the distributor.

The vertical intake port strengthens combustion, providing a broad power band, increased performance and a high intake efficiency.



The durable cast iron cylinder block allows compact, steep valve geometry which results in more efficient burning of fuel and more power.

High performance ignition and longer life can be expected from platinum, iridium-tipped spark plugs.

Inside, Land Cruiser's abundant conveniences include (clockwise from top left): an overhead console with storage for a garage door/state gate opener and plenty of maplight illumination, a master control panel with illuminated buttons for power door locks and windows with driver's one-touch auto up/down with pinch protection, an outside temperature display and automatic air conditioning, close-at-hand cup holders and two-position heated front seats.



In the interior of this tropical rain forest alone, there are 2,500 species of trees. The good news is that, with such diversity, exploitation of any one species is uneconomical. Meaning it won't happen. More good news is that Land Cruiser's interior is going to be around a long time, too. Durability was at least as important as comfort to the designers — and, if you've traveled in a Land Cruiser, you know comfort was high on the list.



The convenient center console flows out of the instrument panel control cluster — plenty of storage for cameras and CDs, plus cup holders for all.







Handy cargo nets hold foreign phrase books, energy bars and road maps...for where there are roads. Up to nine cup holders serve a full Land Cruiser. Auxiliary power outlets in the center control cluster, center console storage and rear cargo area enable the use of equipment from photo strobe lights to refrigerators.

We've heli-skied the Bugaboos and backcountry British Columbia, but frankly, we were unprepared for this huge snow dome of a country. Amend that — we were quite well prepared, actually, with our Land Cruiser. We just had different notions of what "Greenland" meant than the Inuit who inhabit the place. Only 50,000 people (and their sled dogs) live on the largest island in the world. It's a massive ice cap. And a heck of a lot of fun in a Land Cruiser, especially with the confidence that 4-wheel disc brakes with ABS provide, even in low-range operation.

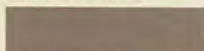

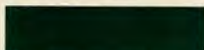

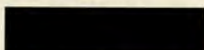

#### WARRANTIES\*

Every Toyota Car and Truck has excellent warranty coverage. However, given Toyota's worldwide reputation for quality, reliability and dependability, you may never find out just how good our new vehicle warranty really is. But, should you ever need it, we've definitely got you covered.

**Basic Coverage:** All components other than normal wear and maintenance items are covered for 36 months/36,000 miles.

**Powertrain Coverage:** Your engine, transmission or air-brake front-wheel drive, rear-wheel drive, seatbelts and air bags are covered for 60 months/50,000 miles.

**Rust-through Coverage:** Corrosion perforation of sheet metal is covered for 60 months/unlimited miles.

**Federal Emission Coverage:** Components under the federal emission defect warranty are covered for 36 months/36,000 miles and specified major emission control components are covered for 8 years/80,000 miles. Specified major emission control components under emission performance warranty are also covered for 8 years/80,000 miles. In addition, emission performance warranty is applicable for 24 months/24,000 miles in states and local jurisdictions that require a periodic EPA-approved inspection and maintenance program.<sup>†</sup>

**California Emission Control Coverage:** In California and any other state that adopts California emission warranty provisions, performance warranty and defect warranty

coverage is applicable for 36 months/50,000 miles and specific control devices are covered for 7 years/70,000 miles.<sup>†</sup> Accessory Warranty: Toyota-approved accessories are covered for 12 months, regardless of mileage, or for the remainder of any new vehicle warranty (except for car covers, which are covered for 12 months).

In addition, there may be times when we will establish a special policy adjustment which will further defray repair costs. For complete details of Toyota's warranties, please refer to the Owner's Manual Supplement.
