

Each gets its effect through great artists in color harmonies and fabric design . . . through skilled craftsmen whose expert handiwork lends character and loveliness to whatever it touches.





This new group comprises the largest, most powerful cars in the line, with 132 horsepower and 147-inch wheelbase. On this chassis there is also available a distinguished group of custom models, with bodies by Le Baron.

This group offers a wide range of brilliantly attractive body types on a 142-inch wheelbase. Interiors are exceptionally spacious and fitted with superb appointments. Outstanding performance is assured by the famous Pierce-Arrow straight eight engine which develops 132 horsepower.

Differing from its companion cars principally in dimensions, the new Group B offers the same basic design, the same detail of appointment, the same quality typical of all Pierce-Arrow cars at a substantially lower cost. It has a 125 horsepower engine and is available in 134-inch and 137-inch wheelbase.
