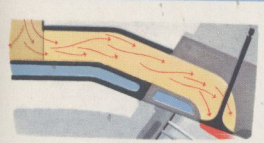

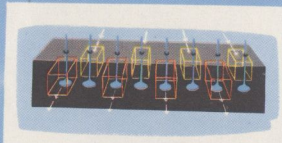
1. NEW IN-BLOCK COMBUSTION



2. NEW 3-STAGE COOLING SYSTEM

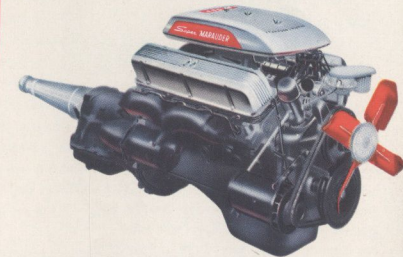


3. NEW WATER-FLOW INTAKE MANIFOLD

SUPER SPRINGING ACTION

Specially designed Full-Cushion Shock Absorbers are an important element of Mercury performance. They provide fast, super-effective control of spring action on rough and average roads alike, at all speeds—give you a smooth, jolt-free ride.



EASIER HANDLING

The lower suspension arms of the Ball-Joint Front Suspension are swept back slightly so that front wheels are "pulled" over bumps instead of being "pushed" into them. You get a softer, smoother ride, plus better control under all driving conditions.



BRAKES ADJUST AUTOMATICALLY

Here is another important Mercury safety and convenience feature. Large, Super-Safe Self-Adjusting Brakes help prevent swerving, provide surer, safer stops. Brakes are always in correct adjustment—they *automatically* compensate for lining wear.

ENGINES

MONTEREY AND COMMUTER MODELS: 312-hp, 383 cubic inch displacement. Torque rating, 405 lb.-ft. Compression ratio 10.5 to 1.

MONTCLAIR, VOYAGER AND COLONY PARK: 330-hp, 383 cubic inch displacement. Torque rating, 425 lb.-ft. Compression ratio 10.5 to 1.

PARK LANE SERIES: 360-hp, 430 cubic inch displacement. Torque rating, 480 lb.-ft. Compression ratio 10.5 to 1. Dual exhaust. Assembled with Multi-Drive Merc-O-Matic. Also, optional at extra cost for Turnpike Cruiser models.

SUPER MARAUDER: 400-hp, 430 cubic inch displacement. Compression ratio 10.5 to 1. Three 2-barrel carburetors. Available as special order option with Multi-Drive Merc-O-Matic for Park Lane and Montclair Convertibles, Turnpike Cruisers and Station Wagons.

BASIC CONSTRUCTION: One-piece V-8 block. In-block combustion chambers. Water-cooled intake manifold. Cool-Power Design eliminates hot spots. Aircraft-type low-friction pistons. Cylinder bore, 4.3 in. Piston stroke 3.3 in. for 383 cu. in. engines and 3.7 in. for 430 cu. in. versions.

FUEL SYSTEM: Low-silhouette 4-barrel Thermo-Matic carburetor. Dual temperature-controlled carburetor air intakes. Dry-type carburetor air filter.

ENGINE LUBRICATION: Full-pressure lubrication with simplified oil line pattern. Internally mounted rotor-type pump. Capacity, 4 quarts. Forced-air crankcase ventilation.

ELECTRICAL: 12-volt system. High-capacity dual-drive generator with low cut-in speed. High torque "Folo-Thru" starter. Combination centrifugal-vacuum spark advance control. Front-mounted distributor. Battery sizes—66-plate battery for vehicles with conventional or overdrive transmission; 78-plate battery with Merc-O-Matic transmission.

OVERHEAD VALVES: Free-turning, rotating type valves. Intake valve-head diameter 2.08 inches with 383 cu. in. engines; 2.14 inches with 430 cu. in. versions. Exhaust valve-head diameter 1.77 in.

MAJOR SPECIFICATIONS—1958 MERCURY

COOLING SYSTEM: 3-stage cooling with 17½ quart capacity (with optional heater). 3 thermostats adjust cooling capacity to needs.

EXHAUST SYSTEM: Center-outlet exhaust manifold with extra-large passages. Dual exhaust standard on Park Lane models.

POWER TRAIN

MERC-O-MATIC TRANSMISSION: Combination of fluid torque converter and 3-speed planetary gear train. Mechanical Keyboard Control drive selector. Multi-Drive Merc-O-Matic (standard on all models except Monterey and Commuter Station Wagons) affords choice of low-gear or intermediate-gear starts. Oil capacity 8½ quarts.

CONVENTIONAL TRANSMISSION: Selective gear type with three speeds forward, one reverse. All gears helical. Constant-mesh second gear. Overdrive with 4th forward speed (.72 to 1 ratio) optionally available for Commuter models.

REAR AXLE: Hypoid gears with straddle-mounted pinion gear. Rear axle ratio is 2.69 to 1 with 312-hp and 330-hp engines, and 2.91 to 1 with 360-hp and 400-hp engines. All air conditioned vehicles have 2.91 to 1 rear axles. With conventional transmission or overdrive, the rear axle ratio is 3.56 to 1.

CHASSIS

FRAME: Ladder-type with outward curved side rails, and 5 cross-members. Side rails internally and externally reinforced. Extra-strength x-member for convertible frames.

FRONT SUSPENSION: Independent ball-joint front suspension with swept-back design. Permanently lubricated threaded bushing for upper suspension arms. 10-coil front springs. Full-cushion hydraulic shock absorbers. Rubber-mounted, linkless front torsional stabilizer bar.

REAR SUSPENSION: Splay-mounted leaf-type rear springs. 55-inch long springs all models, except Park Lane, 60 inches. Compression-type shackles. Full-cushion shock absorbers.
