For the first time in automotive history, a driver can see beyond mere headlamps. With available Night Vision in DTS or DHS, you'll know what's ahead...and be able to react to it sooner


than ever before. The key to this visual magic is infrared sensing technology, first developed

for defense applications. In DeVille, Night Vision cuts through the glare of oncoming headlamps and allows you to see up to five times farther than your low-beam headlamps can reach. But what you see isn't through the windshield, it's on it. Permit us to explain. What Night Vision "sees" is the infrared energy being radiated by objects directly ahead. Virtually everything in the world absorbs and gives off infrared energy. A special sensor in DeVille's grille collects this energy and translates it into a black-andwhite video image. This is projected onto the inner surface of the windshield through Head-Up Display technology. When viewed from the driver's seat, the Night Vision image appears to float near the front of the hood and to the left of center. With use, it quickly becomes a natural checkpoint, much like your rearview mirror. With the system activated, Night Vision comes on automatically, along with your headlamps. But it helps you see a world beyond their reach.

beyond them. In a nutshell, Northstar computer-orchestrates every aspect of DeVille's driving dynamics through a network of sensors and advanced mechanical engineering. At the heart of it all is DeVille's 32-valve DOHC Northstar V8. For 2000, this powerplant has been re-engineered, inside and out. As proof, we point to enhanced combustion for power and efficiency. In great part, this stems from larger intake valves for better "breathability" and smaller exhaust valves for more flow velocity. In addition, a new central-feed intake plenum provides near equal-length air induction paths for all eight cylinders. This helps to reduce noise under the hood. Inside, the re-engineered Northstar V8 is equipped with roller lifters plus specially hardened and ground camshafts. These improvements cut valvetrain friction by up to 50 percent and put more power to work for you. And since simple is better, engineers have eliminated the spark plug wires from this Northstar V8. In their place, you will find eight individual coils, one above each spark plug. These coils fire the plugs directly with up to 130 percent more energy. To reduce noise and vibration, engine-driven accessories are now mounted directly to the engine block. This includes the power steering pump, AC compressor and generator. All these improvements add up. And the bottom line is the expression on your face every time you tackle the road ahead.





StabiluTrak has been called one of the most important safety advances since four-wheel ABS. And for 2000, the newly enhanced StabiluTrak 2.0 System is standard on DTS and available on all other DeVilles. StabiluTrak has one basic value:

to help you maintain control during sudden maneuvers, especially in low-traction conditions. How? Suppose you swerve abruptly to avoid an obstacle. In an ordinary car, you might feel that a skid or "fishtail" is about to occur. Well, StabiliTrak's sensors realize the same thing. They read the steering wheel position, the amount of lateral force in play and the car's response to the steering wheel input. All this data is fed into the on-board computer and a cyber-decision is made. If StabiliTrak detects a difference between your steering wheel input and DeVille's response, it automatically applies a precise amount of pressure to one of the front brakes to help keep DeVille on track. This correction can be so subtle that you may not know it's happened. What you will know is that you've negotiated the situation with aplomb. But there's another important advantage to StabiliTrak's intuitive technology. StabiliTrak 2.0 also gives you the freedom to accelerate to avoid danger. It's the only stability enhancement system in the world that provides you with this critical edge. And when the situation demands, this instinctive StabiliTrak technology means that you can pull out, pass under adverse conditions, then return to your traffic lane safely and in control. All thanks to instinctive StabiliTrak technology.



BODY & SOUL

With inputs based on real-world data, engineers determined which structural parts needed improvement. Such "virtual testing" resulted in an automobile of impressive dynamic stiffness and integrity. For example, DeVille has a cast magnesium beam that runs from side to side, behind the instrument panel. This adds substantial body stiffness. So does a strong, tubular steel beam that arches from front to back over the front side doors. In addition, an internal safety cage and side door beams help maintain the integrity of the passenger compartment while front and rear "crush zones" work to help absorb and dissipate collision forces. By any analysis, this is the most highly engineered DeVille in history.

Imagine hearing a bell before it is rung. Or crossing a bridge before it's built. Fantasy? Not really. Engineers did just this kind of thing before cocking in the structural design of the DeVille 2000. They used powerful design analysis computer programs to simulate and test the strength of virtually every body component before it was finalized.



SAFE & SOUND

New dimensions in safety engineering help place

DeVille in the forefront of its category. For

example, there are four standard air bags* designed into the front passenger cabin. The front air bags for the driver and right front passenger are discreetly mounted in the steering wheel and under the upper dash pad. Driver and right front passenger side-impact air bags deploy from the outside bolsters of each front seat to help provide added protection in side-impact collisions. Optional rear seat side-impact air bags emerge from the outboard edges of the rear seat cushion to help provide added protection for outboard rear-seat passengers, too. In addition, DeVille's front outboard safety belts are now equipped with automatic "pretensioners" that help snug the belts in the case of a frontal collision where air bags deploy. It's good to know you're cared for.






With "eyes in the back of your head," backing up in an automobile would be easy. Now DeVille offers you something even better: available Ultrasonic Rear Parking Assist.

This system can warn you of certain stationary objects within about five feet of your rear bumper and tell you how close such an object is. This could be the front of another car, a parking barrier...or even a child's bicycle. Ultrasonic Rear Parking Assist can help you realize it's there, before it's too late. How does the system work? Very much like radar. Four sensors mounted in the rear bumper transmit ultrasonic waves anytime your DeVille is in reverse and traveling less than 3 mph. These waves are reflected from a stationary object directly behind the car, received by the sensors, and the distance to that object is calculated. The space between your DeVille and the obstruction is then translated into a visual and audible warning. Three LED lights mounted above the rear window illuminate as you draw closer: first one amber light, then two amber lights and finally a red light. When you're about 12 inches away, all three lights flash. At each stage, chimes also sound.
