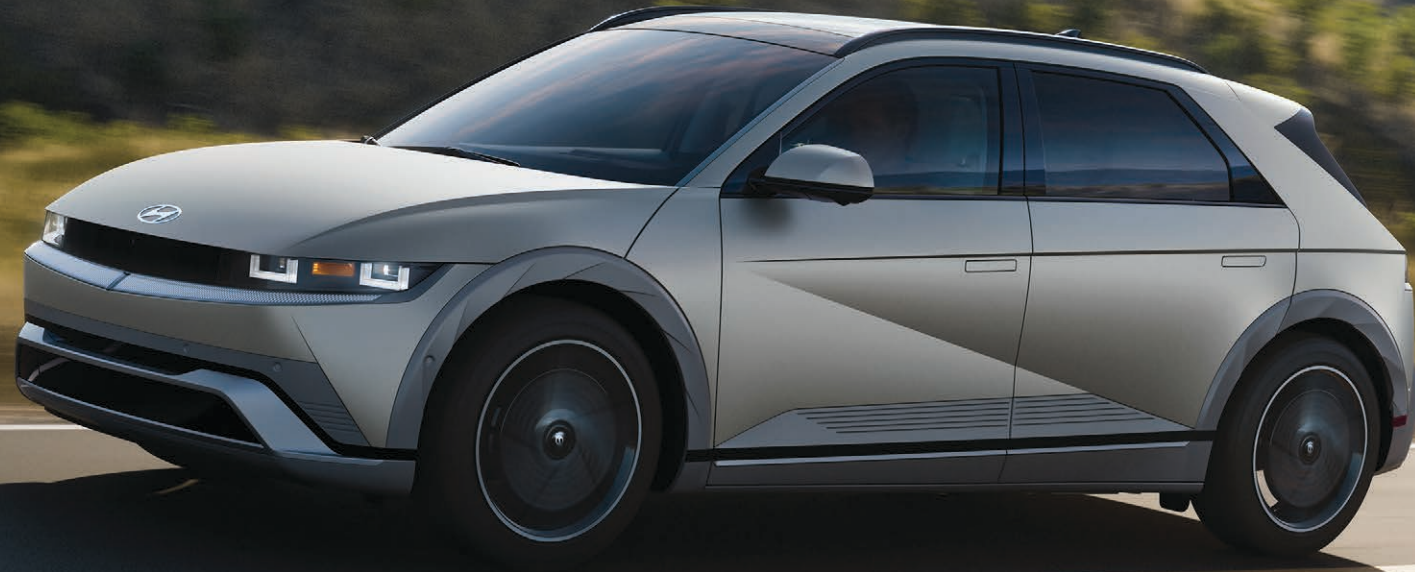

Choose from three ways to experience IONIQ 5 power and efficiency: A 168-hp Rear Wheel Drive powertrain, an extended range 225-hp Rear Wheel Drive, or available All Wheel Drive with a full 446 lb-ft of torque surging from a 320-hp dual-motor system.

You'll experience IONIQ 5's speed and flexibility in how you charge as well. Thanks to the included adapter, you can plug into a US 400V conventional charger, the growing NACS (North American Charging Standard) Network or a 350 kW DC Fast Charger that can help boost you from 10% to 80% charge in as little as 20 minutes.⁹ About the same amount of time it takes to order and enjoy your cup of coffee.⁷

What will you do with all of that range? How about a little more exploring? The rugged IONIQ 5 XRT trim lets you take the traction of IONIQ 5's All Wheel Drive even further with special Terrain modes that enhance its capabilities in mud, sand or snow. The XRT trim also comes equipped with a 23 mm higher ride height to clear rocky terrain, grippy all-terrain tires on 18-inch wheels and a body wrapped in protective cladding.

Using an integrated system of cameras, radar and ultrasonic sensors, SmartSense monitors your surroundings from nearly every angle to help avoid potential hazards.¹³

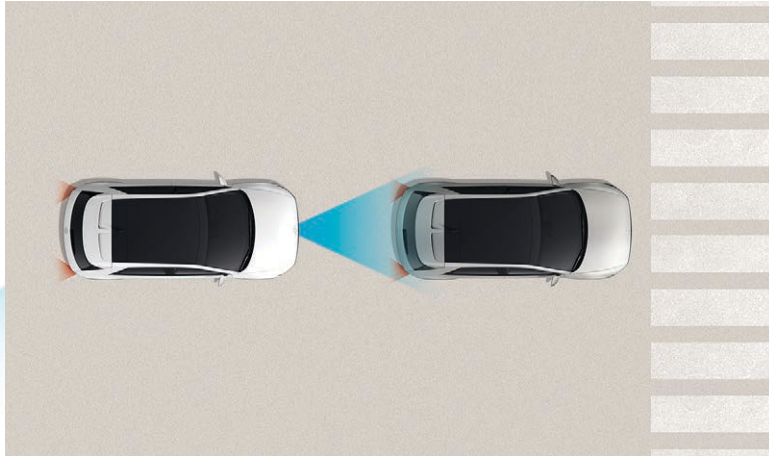
Yet IONIQ 5 is not only watching what's outside your vehicle – it's watching out for those inside as well. Forward Attention Warning¹⁴ helps alert you to signs of driver fatigue or distraction, while available Advanced Rear

Occupant Alert helps look out for your little ones with super-sensitive radar that warns the driver if a sleeping child has been left in the 2nd-row seats.¹⁵

To match that safety with convenience, parking assistance features on XRT and Limited trims offer proximity sensors to the front, side and rear that help you confidently navigate crowded parking areas. The Parking Collision-Avoidance Assist – Reverse/Forward/Side feature can even hit the brakes if an object is detected.

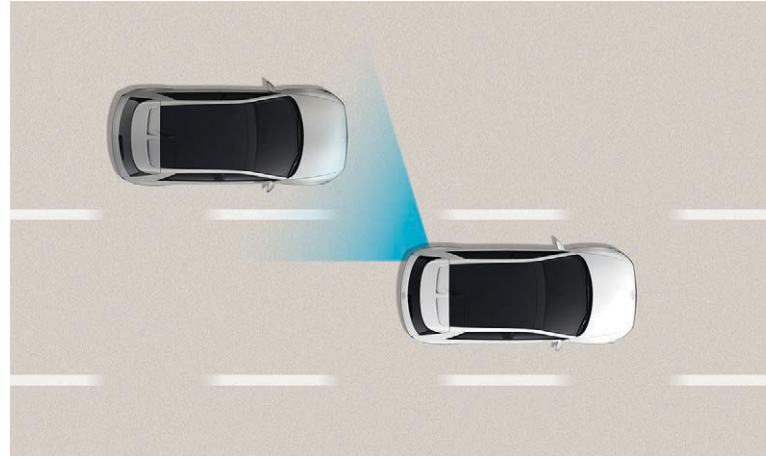

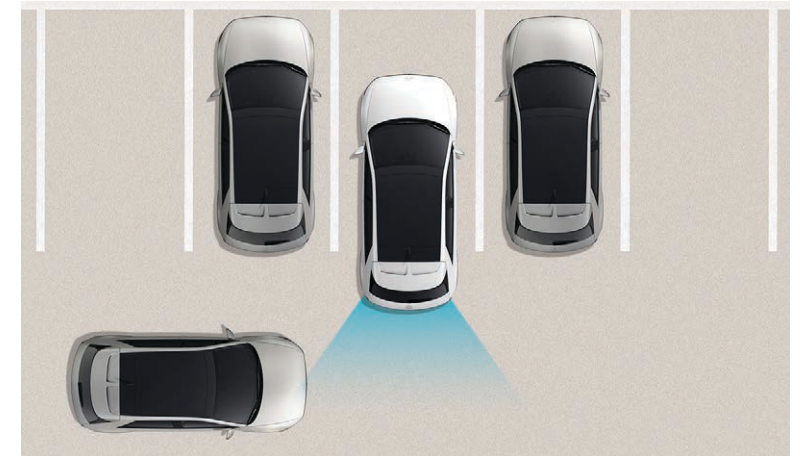
1. Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist

When the front-facing camera and radar detect a vehicle, pedestrian or cyclist in your path – or an oncoming car when turning left in an intersection – your Hyundai warns you of a potential collision. If necessary, the system may automatically apply emergency braking to help avoid a collision.¹⁶



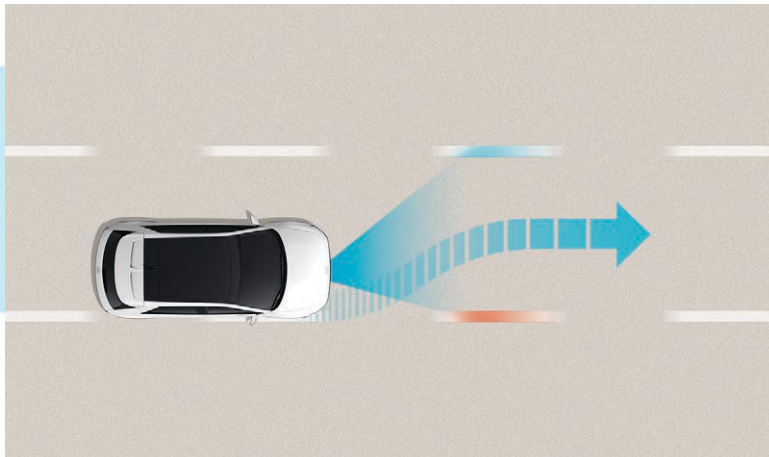
2. Blind-Spot Collision-Avoidance Assist

If your Hyundai detects a vehicle in your blind spot while the turn signal is on, this available feature alerts the driver and automatically applies opposite steering before you change lanes to help avoid a collision. It can also detect vehicles up to two lanes over to help prevent collisions when exiting a parallel parking spot.¹⁷



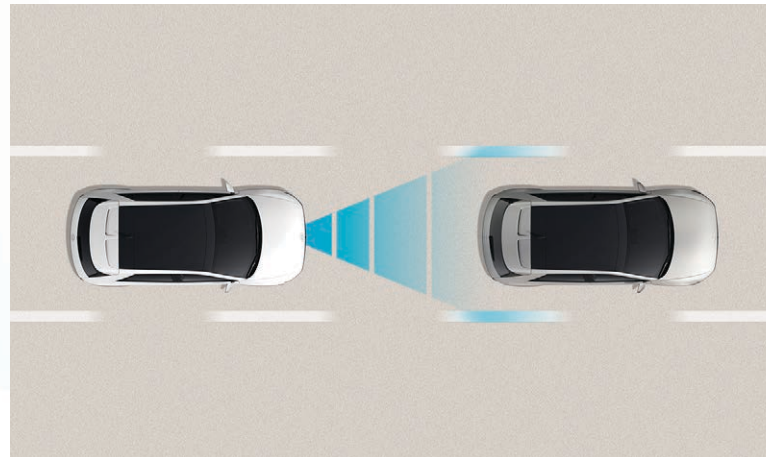
3. Rear Cross-Traffic Collision-Avoidance Assist

Backing out of a parking space and wondering whether there is cross traffic coming your way? This feature can help warn you of another vehicle approaching from the side. If necessary, your Hyundai may automatically apply braking to help prevent a collision.¹⁸



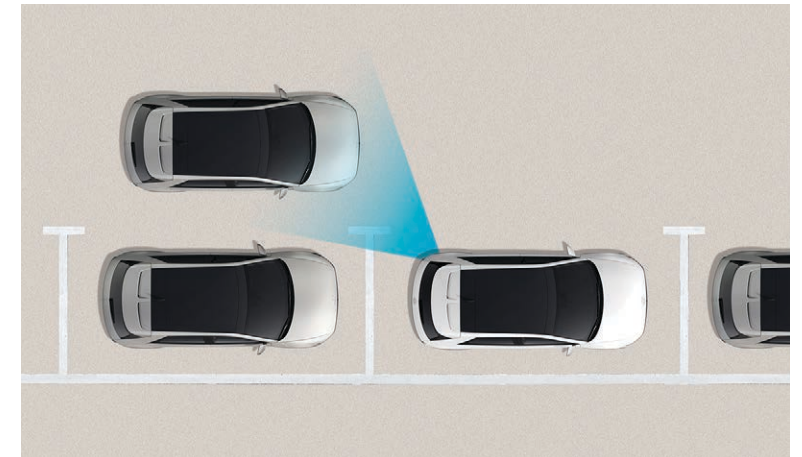
4. Lane Following Assist

Using the vehicle's front-facing camera to detect lane markers on the road, this feature assists the driver's steering to help keep you centered in your lane. It can even help determine a virtual path based on the movements of the preceding vehicle.¹⁹ Meanwhile, haptic feedback through the steering wheel helps remind you to keep your hands on the wheel.



5. Highway Driving Assist 2

Acting as your copilot on freeways, this available feature helps keep you centered in your lane while also maintaining a set speed and distance from the vehicle in front. It can use navigation map data to automatically adjust for changing speed limits and reduce your speed when it detects you're approaching a curve in the road. The system can even respond to vehicles that drive too close in the adjacent lane and assist in making lane changes.²⁰



6. Safe Exit Assist | Rear Occupant Alert

After you park, Safe Exit Assist issues an alert when another vehicle is detected to be approaching from behind, letting the driver know it may not be safe for passengers to open the street-side door.²¹ The available Advanced Rear Occupant Alert feature can help remind the driver to check the 2nd-row seats for kids or pets after turning off the vehicle.¹⁵

Enter your IONIQ 5 using the available Digital Key 2 Premium on your compatible smartphone or wearable device, and your radio and navigation system presets are automatically restored using your Bluelink personal profile.⁵ Apple Wallet,[®] Google Wallet[™] and Samsung Pass[®] let you share your digital key with trusted friends and family members²⁴ – as the primary driver, you control when a shared key can be used. You can also pause or end shared-key access at any time.
