Suspension

All Dart models (except Demon 340) have regular torsion bars and ball joints in front, asymmetrical leaf springs in the rear, and Oriflow shocks at each wheel. The Dart Demon 340 comes equipped with Rallye Suspension which includes: HD torsion bars • Firm Ride shocks • Sway bar • and HD rear springs. An optional Handling Package is offered on other Dart models. This includes: Sway bar • and HD springs. In addition, as a separate option, Firm Ride shocks are also available.

Transmissions

Four transmissions are offered for Dart models.

- Three-speed manual (column-mounted shifter), standard with 198 Six, or 318 V8. Clutch 9½—198 Six 10½—318 V8
- Three-speed fully synchronized manual (floor shift), standard on Demon 340. Optional with all other Dart engines.
- Four-speed synchronized manual (floor shift), optional on Demon 340, N.A. other engines.
- Torqueflite three-speed automatic transmission (selector, column-mounted except on optional console—and bucket seat equipped models), is optional on all Dart models.

Rear Axle Ratios

A number of rear axle ratios are offered, at extra cost, with each Dart engine and transmission team. Standard ratios have been carefully chosen to provide a balance of performance and economy. However, for more specialized applications,

Fresh-air • Mounted on dash panel inside car, contains heater case, a centrifugal fan, air control doors and defrosters.

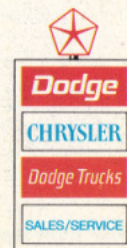
Body Design Features

Unitized body construction combines maximum strength with minimum weight. Rustproofing protection includes 7-stage deep dip treatment, splash shields beneath front fenders, galvanized sill panels. Acryluster exterior paint finish assures new car look longer. Low trunk sill makes for easy loading and unloading of family luggage. Spare tire is out of the way under the floor of the trunk. Big 14.2 imperial gallon fuel tank. Doors are weather tight, yet close easily. Each door has a two-position door check. Safety-designed inside door handle is easy and convenient to operate, works in much the same manner as the buckle of a seat belt, and is a preventative against accidental opening. Road noise is effectively isolated with liberal use of sound deadening materials.
