CRUISING.

You might make some clever assumptions about Wrangler. About how it can never be comfortable on road. Can never ride smoothly. Can never provide the creature comforts you want. Or the passenger/cargo carrying versatility you need.

Of course, you'd be wrong. In fact, Wrangler will begin to reveal its on-road character to you as you find yourself cruising the boulevard. Lights on. Soft top up. Headin' downtown, you and Jeep Wrangler never felt more at home. Certainly not what you'd expect. The reasons why were never more clear.

2WD/4WD PERFORMANCE.

First, Jeep's Command-Trac system lets you shift-on-the-fly conveniently from 4-wheel drive to the economy of 2-wheel drive. And back to 4-wheel drive again, if road conditions warrant.

Next, a standard 2.5 litre 4-cylinder engine with electronic fuel injection delivers high performance (117 horsepower @ 5,000 rpm) and fuel economy.* It's teamed with a standard 5-speed manual

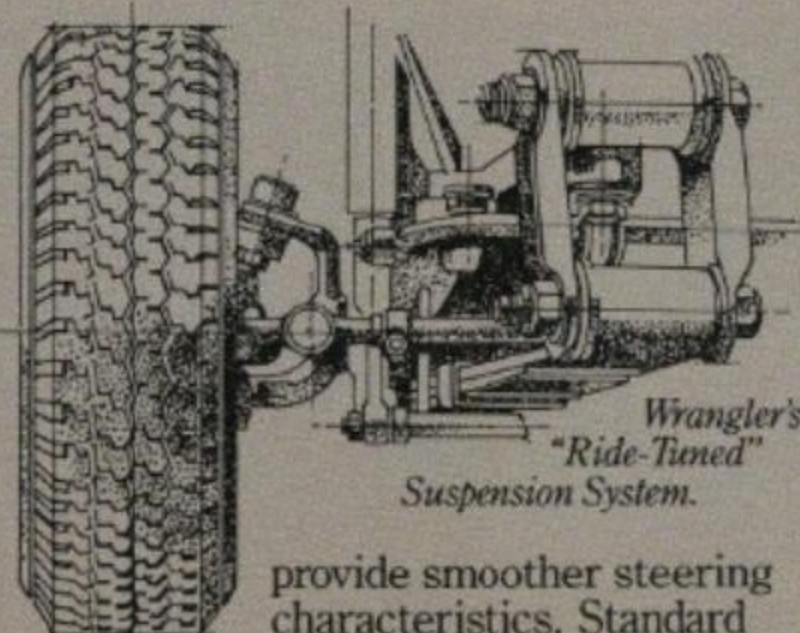
transmission with overdrive for maximum highway efficiency. Optional 4.2 litre I-6 and 3-speed automatic transmission are available. (Feel the power to cruise.)

RIDE-TUNED SUSPENSION.

It's what you *don't* feel that tells you about Wrangler's true character.

Like a jolt as you pass over bumps or the harsh ride of a too-stiff suspension.

Much of Wrangler's suspension philosophy was generated by our work on the highly successful Jeep Cherokee and Wagoneer models. Multi-leaf springs mounted to a solid axle minimize vehicle pitch. Front and rear track bars accurately control the axle position to ensure a crisp driving feel for all types of road conditions. A large front stabilizer bar helps control body movement and



provide smoother steering characteristics. Standard dual-action shock absorbers smooth the ride as they help keep control of the road in your hands.

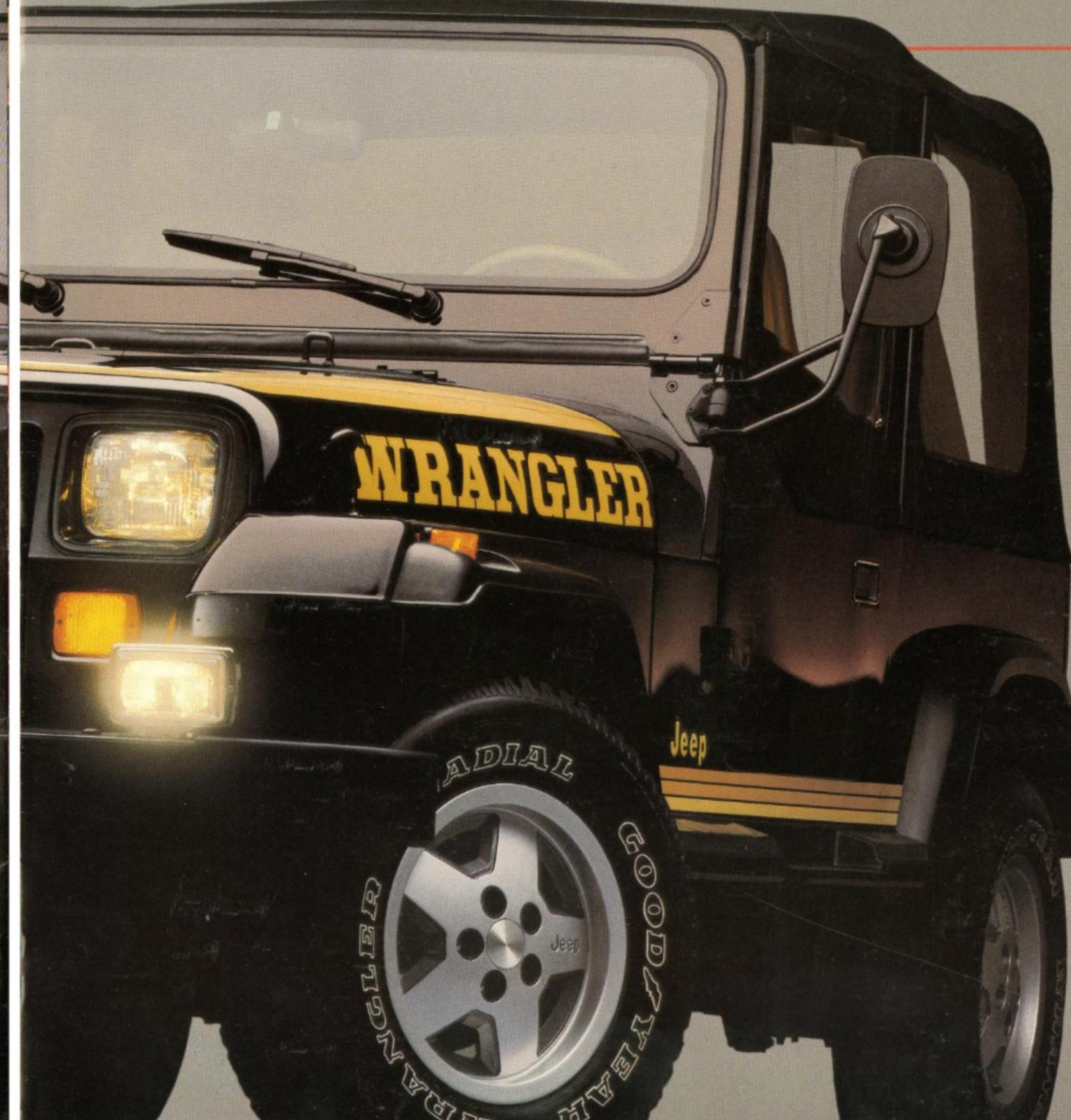
ROAD HANDLING.

Road control is the idea behind Wrangler's standard full-size 15" x 7" wheels and

Goodyear Wrangler® all-terrain steel-belted radial tires. Power brakes are standard, too, with front discs and rear drums featuring a proportioning valve mechanism to balance braking according to the load you're carrying. All for smoother, more secure stops.



NEW SOFT TOP.

Yet, for all the hardware that makes Wrangler a street-legal dream, we have a little software to offer: Wrangler's newly-designed standard soft top. It incorporates a sophisticated system of refinements. Adjustable snaps fit snugly around side rails and soft upper/hard lower half-doors. Velcro fasteners help seal out dust, wind, and road noise. Side and rear windows zipper in and out with ease. In fact, the only thing easier than putting on the top, is popping it back off again. When you're ready. As you find yourself cruising the boulevard. Lights on. Soft top up. Headin' downtown...

length instrument panel. Recessed gauges are easy to read. Full instrumentation keeps you well-informed of speed, rpm's, engine coolant temperature, oil pressure, volts, fuel level, time, and trip miles. Fingertip controls let you adjust the inside temperature and sound levels with ease. A handy glovebox holds the essentials.

ENVIRONMENT.

Included as part of the panel design are integrated defroster ducts and heat outlets. You'll soon find Wrangler's large heater core pumps all you'll need to keep people warm. And windows clear. Wrangler's advanced windshield washer system offers dual fluidic washer



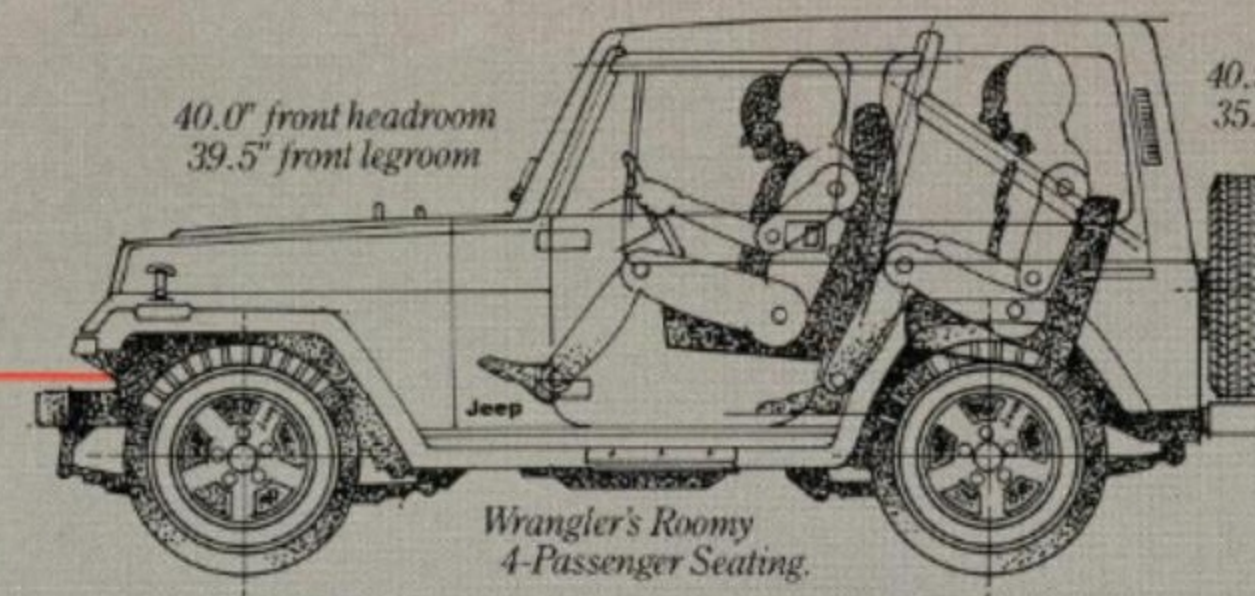

MORE CHOICES.

Among those items available as options on Wrangler (and standard with Laredo) are: center console, leather-wrapped steering wheel, dual outside mirrors, front and

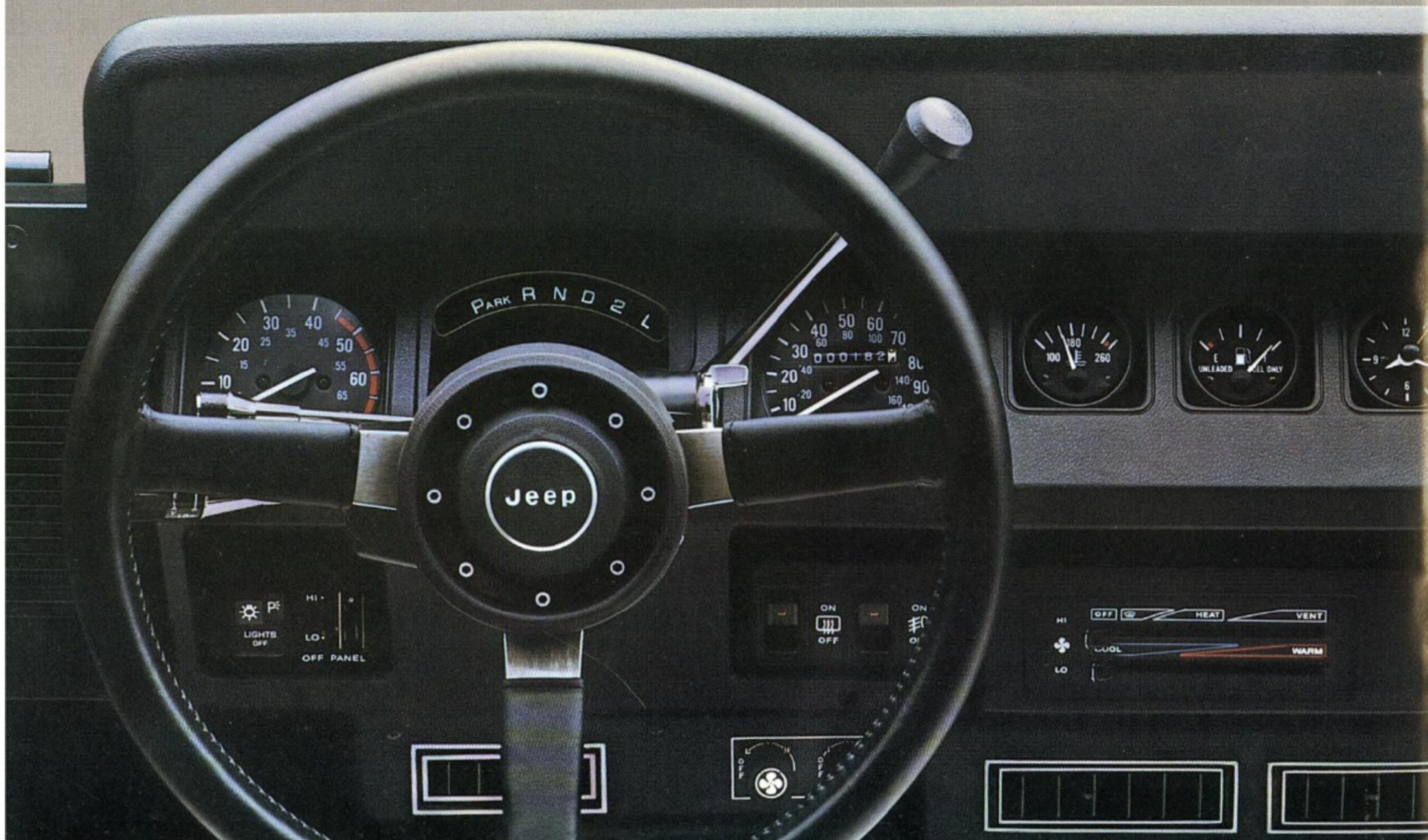
rear carpeting, extra-quiet insulation (with hard top), and Convenience Group (including courtesy light, glove box lock, engine compartment light, and intermittent wipers).

NEW HARD TOP.

The centerpiece of this easy-access design is the durable new hard top, available as an option on Wrangler and standard with the Laredo Package. Side and rear windows with flush-fitting tinted glass have large openings to give you the big picture. Dual outside mirrors provide the view from behind. Even the airflow inside is enhanced by styled side vents. Tight fitting full doors open easily to reveal something special:

convenient side steps to support your every move. Fully integrated with the front fender flares, they function as mud guards and combine with rear fender flares to protect you and Wrangler from road debris.

PRACTICAL REAR DESIGN.

Convenience by design applies to the rear as well. A handy liftgate with flush tinted glass lets you store items easily behind the fold-and-tumble rear seat.

Integrated side step and full-length mud guard (standard on Laredo) provide convenience and bodyside protection.

(An electrically-heated rear window defroster is also available.) The spare tire carrier is mounted outside the tailgate to preserve precious cargo area. In fact, Wrangler's new vertically-hinged tailgate swings out to allow you clear access to 43.2 cubic feet of cargo space... or the maximum capacity of 53.2 cubic feet with the rear seat removed. The tailgate also includes an integrated "hold-open" feature to keep your hands free, and a locking latch to keep security in your hands. Even the spare wheel locks for an extra measure of protection (standard on Laredo).

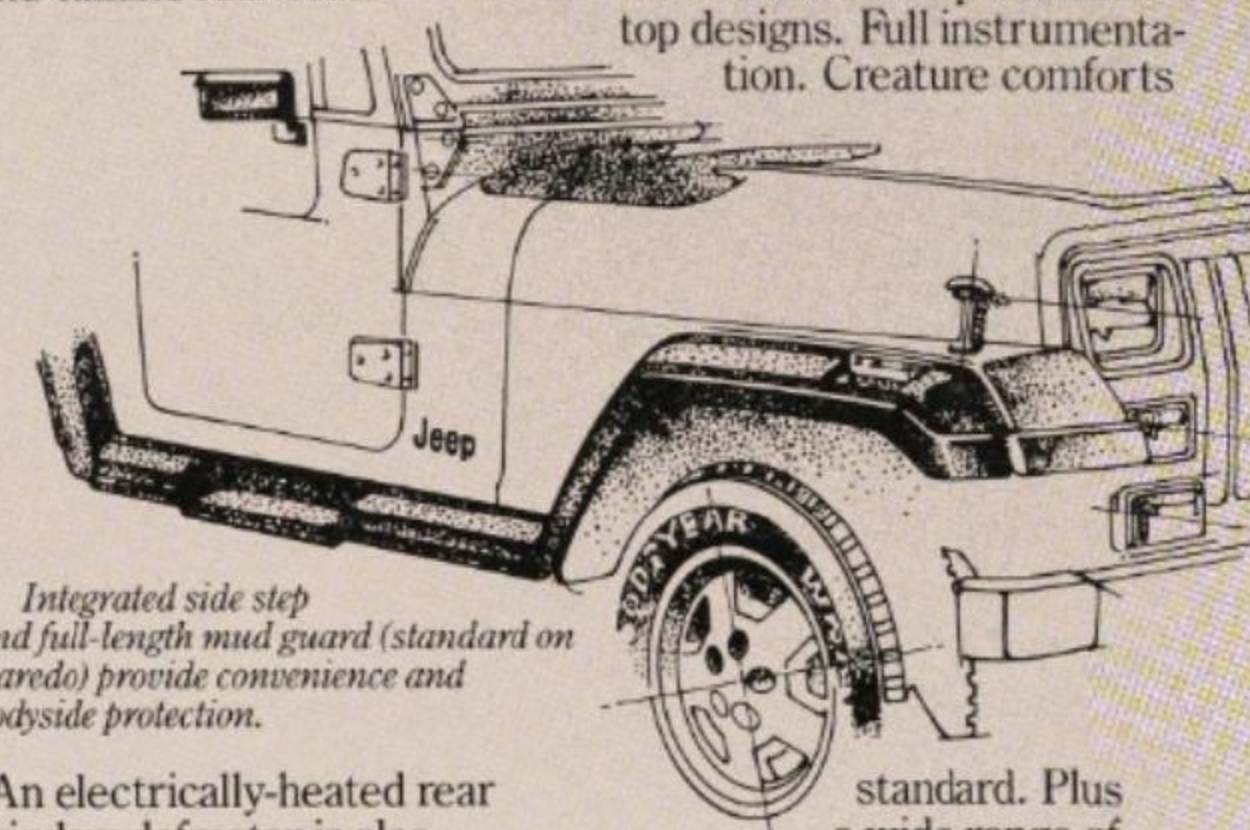

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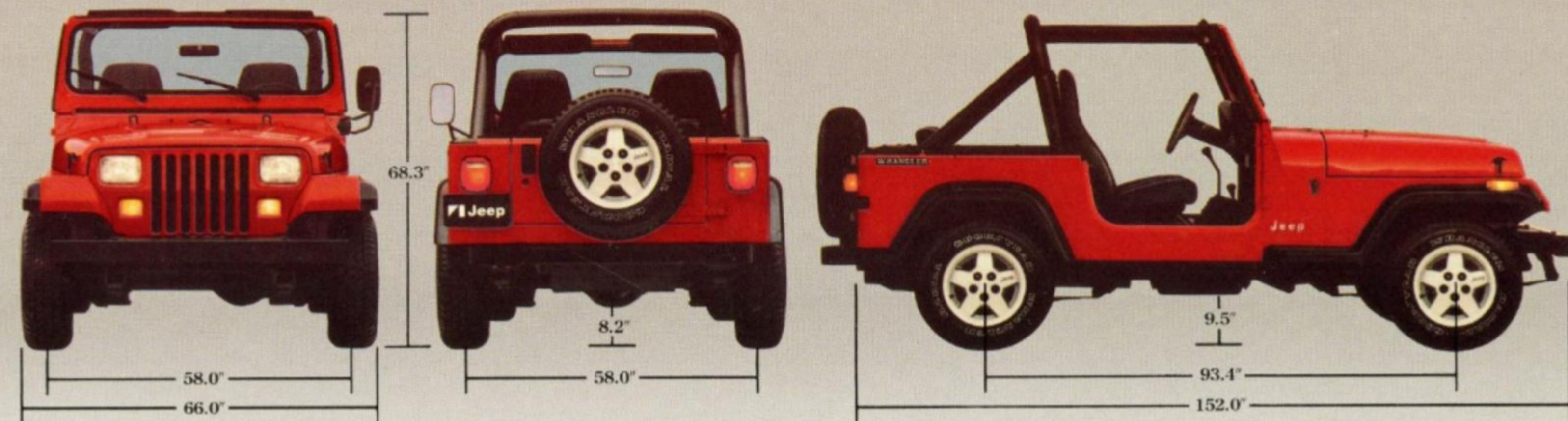

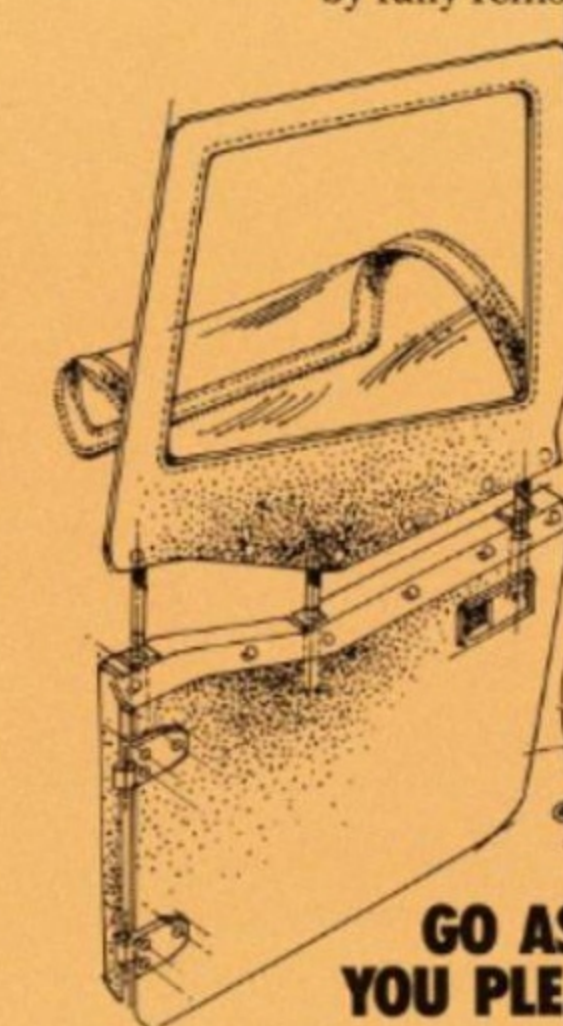

A rear seat fold-and-tumble feature that provides instant space for hauling your gear around. Or by fully removing the rear

seat, you get the maximum use from 53.4 cubic feet of cargo capacity.* With Wrangler the smart moves are all yours.



GO AS YOU PLEASE.

Removable soft upper half-doors (with zip-down windows) attach securely to hard half-doors.

Choice is another distinctly American freedom.

And choice lets you do what the off road demands you must do: "Be prepared." Wrangler offers you the flexibility to prepare for travel as conditions or your mood warrant. Standard hard half-doors (see below) with a removable soft upper half can be quickly

OFF-ROAD EQUIPMENT.

Designed to accommodate this flexible system is Wrangler's standard roll bar.



Zip-in, zip-out side and rear windows combine with standard soft top to protect against the elements.

It is fully integrated, with side bars and padding for extra protection. A standard tinted glass windshield helps fight glare. And to brighten your way are optional bumper-mounted halogen fog lamps and auxiliary light bar with off-road lights (a Genuine Jeep Accessory available from your Jeep dealer).

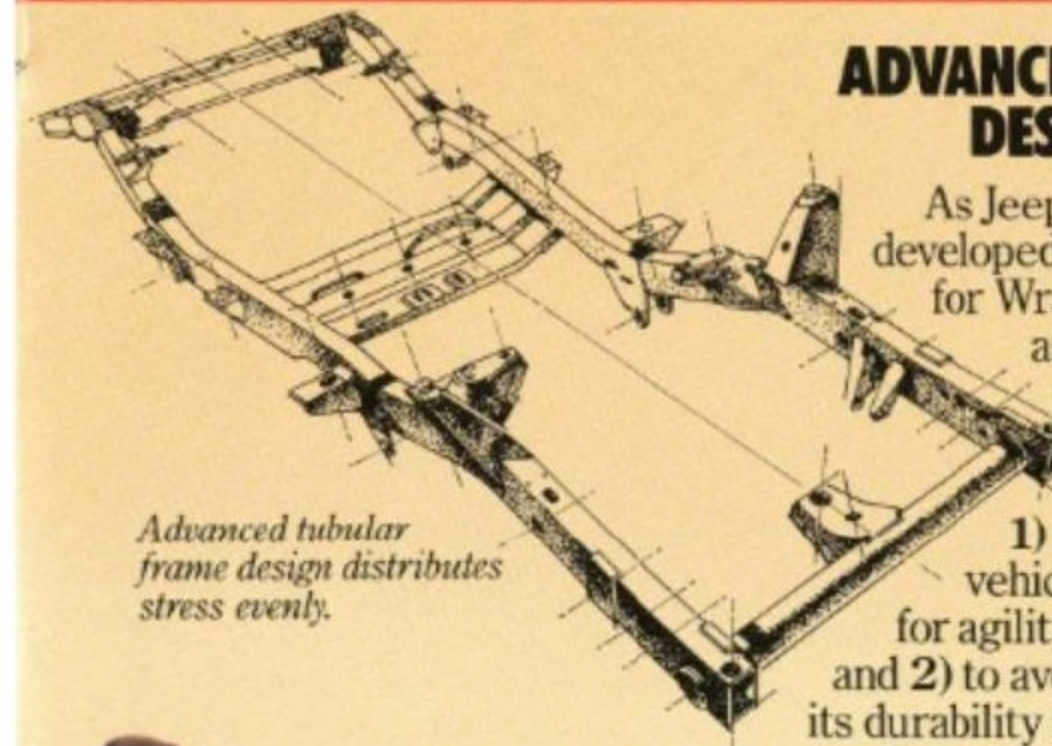


STRENGTH.

There are two measures of a vehicle's strength.

First, how it stands up under the stress of its own active weight, freight and

speed. Second, its ability to withstand the damaging effects of time and environment. Wrangler gets high marks on both counts.

ADVANCED FRAME DESIGN.

As Jeep engineers developed the design for Wrangler's frame assembly, they insisted it meet two vital criteria: 1) to keep the vehicle lightweight for agility and efficiency; and 2) to avoid sacrificing its durability in off-road situations.

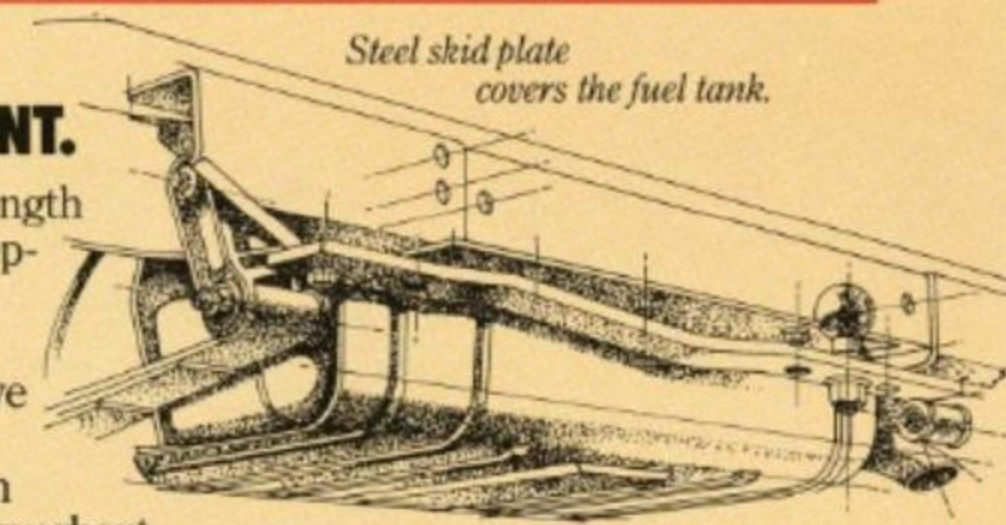
The result came from making use of rectangular-shaped tube side rails, rather than the 3-sided "C" channels used by many domestic manufacturers on their smaller pickups. And because it distributes stress more uniformly, this tubular design was judged better-suited for off-roading than traditional ladder-type frames.

In fact, Jeep engineers designed Wrangler for strong off-road performance. Everything from reinforced body mounts and integral front bumper to protective skid plates for both the transfer case and fuel tank.

BODY TREATMENT.

Part of this strength is Wrangler's exceptional protection against corrosion.

There's extensive use of two-sided galvanized steel on exterior panels throughout the vehicle. All body surfaces receive a multi-part treatment of cleaning (in a phosphate bath), priming and sealing prior to the application of paint. Body components such as hood, windshield frame, front fenders, doors, and tailgate are fully immersed in a dip tank which electrostatically binds the primer coat directly to the sheet

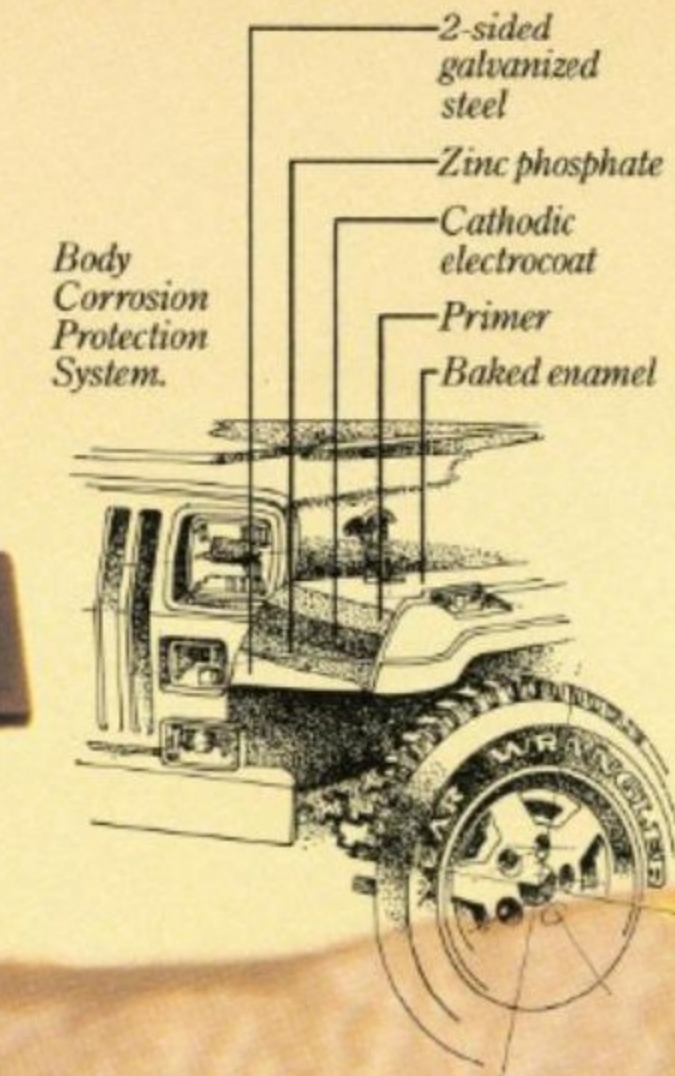


Steel skid plate covers the fuel tank.

metal. After assembly, the full underbody is sprayed with an added layer of protection. A final color coat of enamel leaves Wrangler with a rich, hard-nosed finish.

PROTECTION THROUGHOUT.

Wrangler's fight against corrosion even extends to the selection of plastic liners for the rear wheelhouse to resist water entry into body seams. To high-grade finishes on all fasteners and latches. 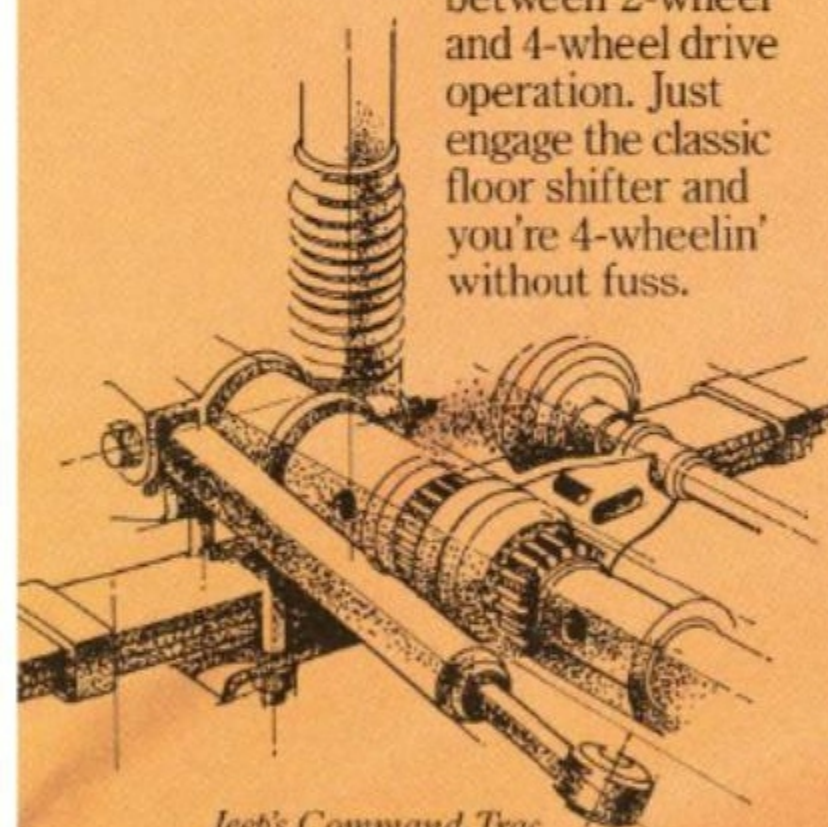

Wrangler's off-road credentials start with Command-Trac, Jeep's part-time 4-wheel drive system. Its synchronized transfer case allows on-the-fly shifting

between 2-wheel and 4-wheel drive operation. Just engage the classic floor shifter and you're 4-wheelin' without fuss.



Jeep's Command-Trac 4-wheel drive system lets you shift-on-the-fly between 2WD and 4WD at any speed.

WHEELS, TIRES & SUSPENSION.

Wrangler takes the power to move you and applies it to full-size 15"x7" wheels—widest standard wheels in its class.

For the serious enthusiast, Wrangler offers an optional Off-Road Package. This includes the extra grip of P225/75R15 Goodyear Wrangler® tires as well as high-pressure gas charged shock absorbers. The high-pressure gas fights both foaming and overheating of the shock's viscous fluid, adding to vehicle ride and stability as well as to the longevity of the shocks themselves.



Off-Road Package includes high-pressure gas shock absorbers and P225/75R15 Goodyear Wrangler® OWL tires.

THE LONG RUN.

Key to the off-road challenge is to keep from getting hung up on obstacles along the way. Wrangler provides excellent ground clearance due to its high placement of differential and transfer case.

Wrangler also helps keep you from running low on fuel. With an optional 20-gallon fuel tank (15 gallons are standard), Wrangler gives you

a potential range of 400 miles* and the chance to push the adventure a little farther, a little longer, until you've found the path you're after.

POWER.

Wrangler gives you a choice of powertrains. There's the standard 2.5 litre 4-cylinder with electronic fuel injection matched to a five-speed manual overdrive transmission. Or you can select an optional 4.2 litre I-6 with the highest torque rating in its class. Up to 210 ft. lbs. at only 2000 rpm! Team up the I-6 with the standard 5-speed or, if you prefer, an optional 3-speed automatic transmission.
